Receives \$192,600 in Grant funds for Stephenson and Jo Daviess Counties

Northwestern Illinois Community Action Agency was recently awarded \$192,600 in grant funds for the HAP (Home Accessibility Program) from the Illinois Housing Development Authority Trust Fund to be used for Accessibility issues and Home Repairs. Each Grant is a \$15,000 Grant and will assist 12 eligible homeowners in making home repairs aimed at addressing accessibility and health and safety concerns in the home. This grant is for income eligible persons who are 65 and older or have a disability. A preliminary inspection of the home will also be done to determine eligibility for this program.

Initial projects for this two year program have been selected. Those selected will be contacted by Nate Dale to schedule a preliminary inspection.
