This event is open to residents of Stephenson County only. There will be a \$20 CASH charge (**correct change only accepted**) per vehicle and only seven (7) items total are allowed per vehicle. Of those seven items, only the following items can be accepted. If anything else is brought it will not be accepted. This is an IEPA approved event and we must follow their guidelines to be in compliance.

Computer Monitors

Televisions

Printers, FAX Machines & Scanners

DVD Players, DVD Recorders & VCRs

Video Game Consoles

Digital Converter Boxes, Cable Receivers & Satellite Receivers

Electronic Keyboards, Electronic Mice & Portable Digital Music Players
