Home Accessibility Program

Northwestern Illinois Community Action Agency (NICAA) has been selected to participate in the Illinois Housing Development Authority Affordable Housing Trust Fund Home Accessibility Program (HAP).

The Home Accessibility Program can assist senior citizens (over 60 years of age) and disabled people (with a physical or mental impairment) who have a documented need for accessibility modifications in their home. Eligible applicants may receive up to \$25,000 in assistance as a five year forgivable loan.

To qualify for this program, households must have annual income equal to or less than the following income guidelines:

The following documents are required to apply for assistance:

- Proof of gross income for all members of the household including paycheck stubs, SSA/SSI/SSD current benefit letters, pension/retirement statements, child support, unemployment benefit reports, TANF/AABD/Township assistance notices, self employment reports, and any other income received;
- Social Security Cards for all members of the household;
- Proof of homeowners insurance;
- Pre-application form.
