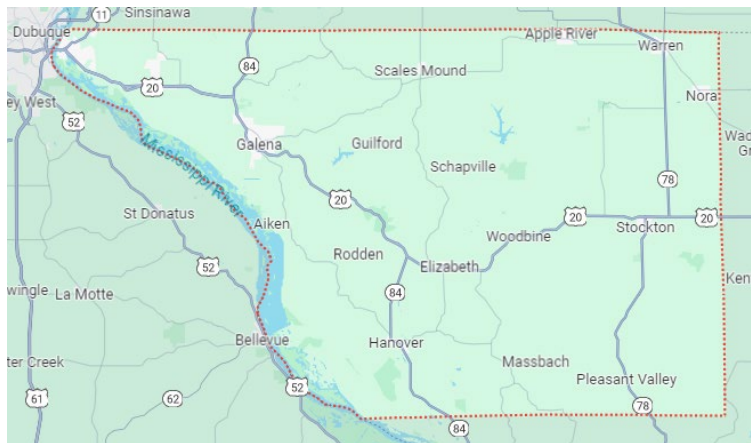
Map of Illinois:



Population

The population of the State of Illinois, according to the U.S. Census Bureau estimate is 12,821,813. The population of the counties in Northwestern Illinois Community Action Agency's (NICAA) service area, Jo-Daviess with 21,995, and Stephenson County is 44,817 respectively.

Map of Jo-Daviess County:



Jo-Daviess County is the northernmost and northwesternmost county in Illinois. Jo-Daviess is a very rural county, and its total area is 600.92 square miles; of which 582.92 square miles is land and 18 square miles is water.

The population of Jo-Daviess County is 21,995. 47% of Jo-Daviess County's population resides in villages and towns within the county, and 52% that live in the 2 cities. The remaining 1% live

rurally or in unincorporated villages.

Jo-Daviess County borders the state of Wisconsin on the Northern side, Carroll County on the Southern side, Stephenson County on the Eastern side, and the state of Iowa on the Western side. The most northwestern city in Jo-Daviess County is East Dubuque. East Dubuque is ¼ mile from Dubuque, Iowa (just across the Mississippi River bridge) and ½ mile from the Wisconsin border. The town Warren is one of the northernmost towns on the Eastern side of Jo-Daviess County and is a mile from the Wisconsin line. The smallest town and easternmost town in Jo-Daviess County is the Village of Nora with a population of 118 people.

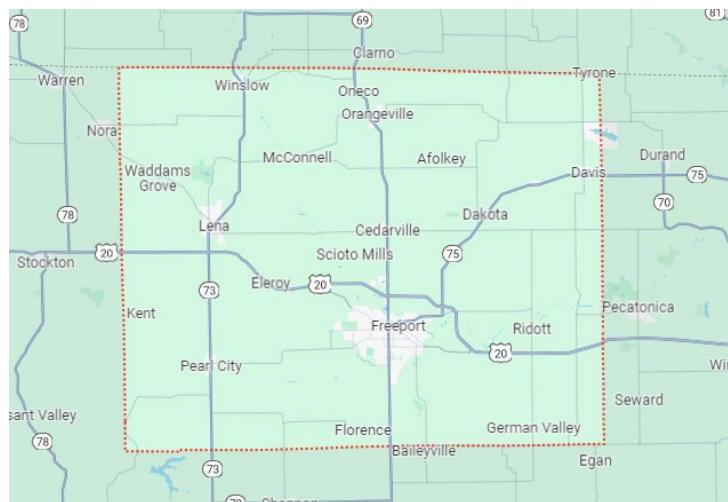
The Village of Scales Mound, with a population of 435, and is located 12 miles from Galena on the historic Stagecoach Trail. It is the home to “Charles Mound”, the highest natural point in the State of Illinois.

The city of Galena has a population of 3,240 and is the most populous city in Jo-Daviess County. It is located 12 miles from the center of the county and is the Jo-Daviess County seat.

Jo-Daviess County has 2 cities: East Dubuque and Galena and eight villages: Apple River, Elizabeth, Hanover, Menominee, Nora, Scales Mound, Stockton, and Warren. Jo-Daviess County is also divided into 23 townships and 14 unincorporated communities. Each township has its own form of governing bodies.

Jo-Daviess is mostly agricultural with pockets of retail and especially in Galena, a tourist destination; retail and hospitality industries generate the most income and employment base.

Stephenson County, Illinois has 564.25 square miles of land area and is the 43rd largest county in [Illinois](#) by total area. Stephenson County, Illinois is bordered by [Winnebago County, Illinois](#), [Ogle County, Illinois](#), [Carroll County, Illinois](#), [Jo Daviess County, Illinois](#), [Lafayette County, Wisconsin](#), and [Green County, Wisconsin](#).

Stephenson County according to the 2021 United States Census, has a population of 44,817. Its county seat is Freeport.

Sites to see when in Stephenson County are:

The Soldier’s Monument – A Civil War Memorial

Designed by General Smith D. Atkins and erected in 1871 the Soldiers’ Monument – an 83-foot tall, limestone obelisk monument – is an American Civil War Memorial. A statue of Victoria – the Roman goddess of victory – originally topped the monument but was destroyed by lightning in 1960. The statue was returned to her pedestal after an absence of 55 years in 2015 after several years of fundraising. Marble tablets at the base listing the names of Stephenson County’s Civil War casualties were reversed and covered by bronze plaques to allow space for all of the county’s Civil War veterans in 1924. Four 7-foot statues at the corners of the base, also replaced in 1924, represent soldiers from each major branch of the Union military: The Infantry, Cavalry, Artillery and Navy.

Black Hawk Monument

The second of two Lincoln points of interest in Stephenson County is the Blackhawk Monument that honors those killed in the Black Hawk War, including the final Illinois battle of 1832 in what is now known as Kent. After serving as captain of the Illinois militia, Abraham Lincoln returned to help bury five of the slain men.

All Veterans Memorial Park

All Veterans Memorial Park is dedicated to honoring and remembering the veterans of Stephenson County. A Gold Star Family Memorial is dedicated to those who have given their lives for our freedom.

Silver Creek Museum + Antique Steam Train

All aboard the Silver Creek and Stephenson Railroad Antique Engine Steam Train in Freeport! This historic train is equipped with a 36-ton 1912 Heisler steam locomotive, three passenger flatcars and an antique red caboose – reported to be the oldest in the state.

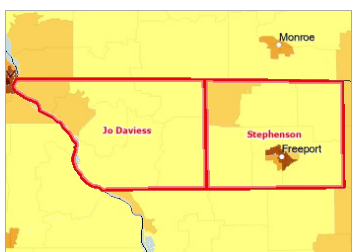
Demographics

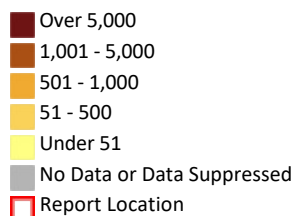

Population, Density (Persons per Sq Mile) by Tract, ACS 2017-21

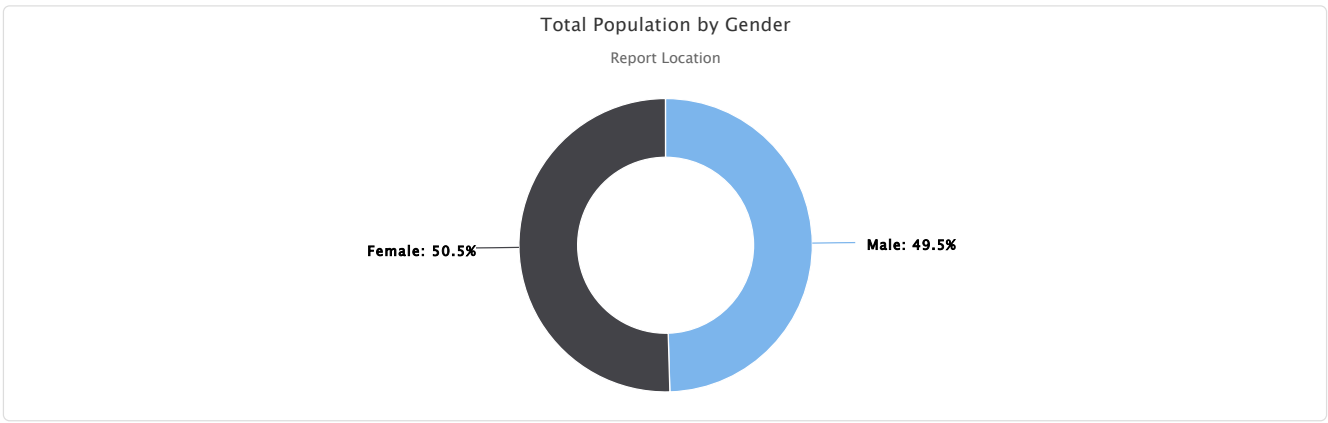

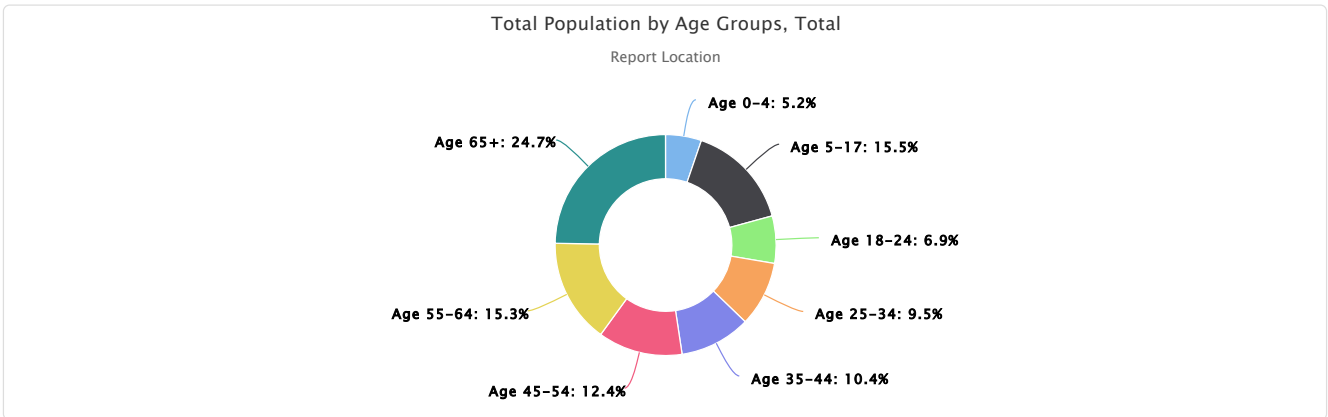

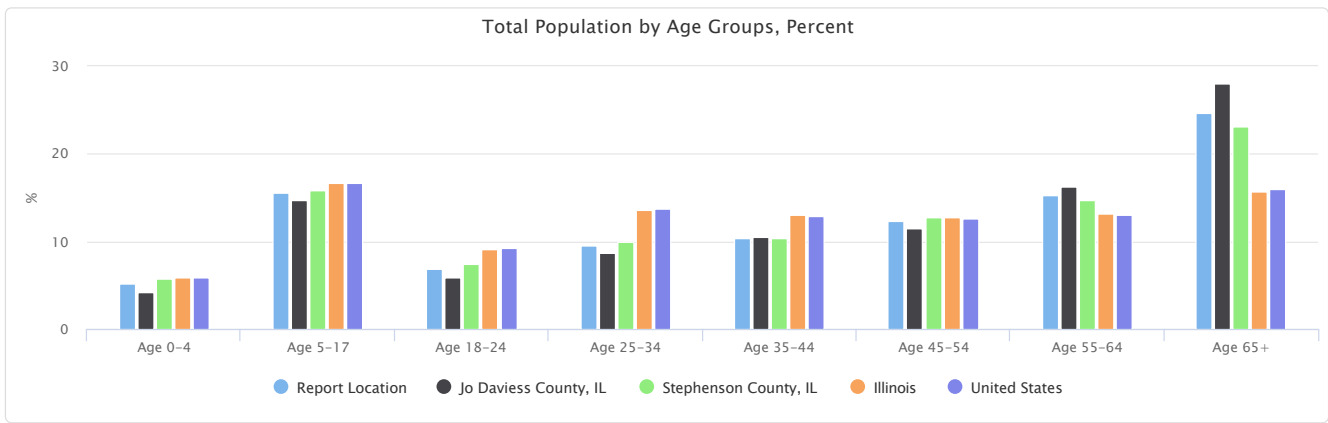

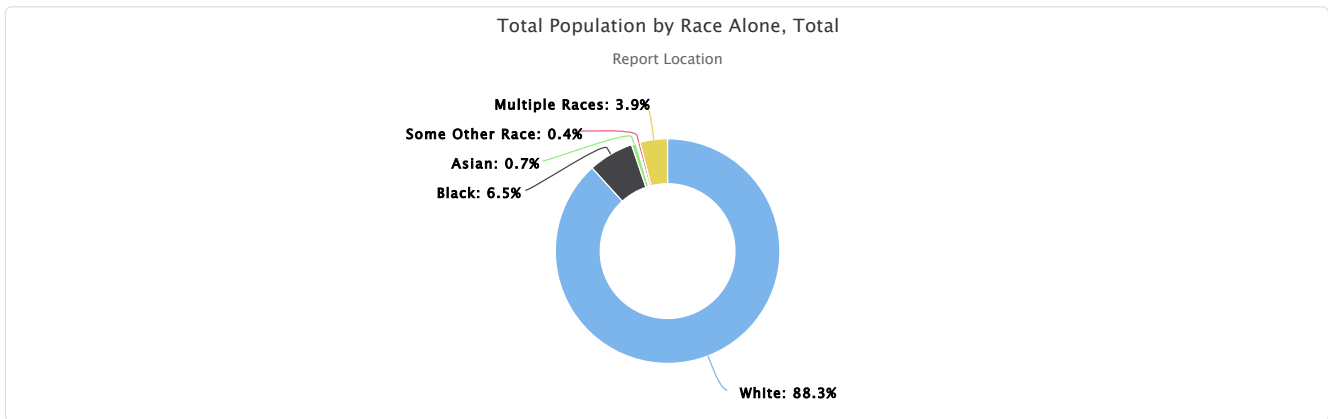

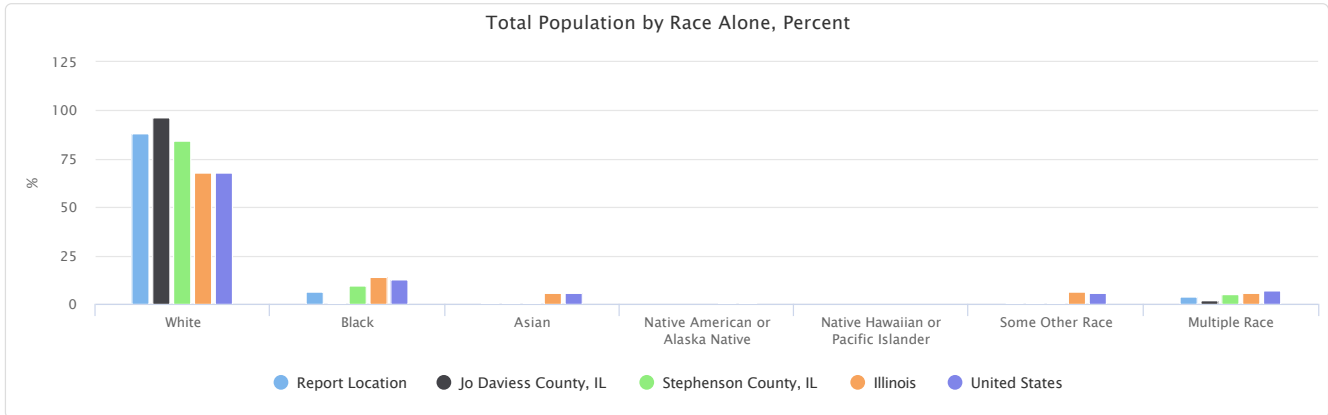

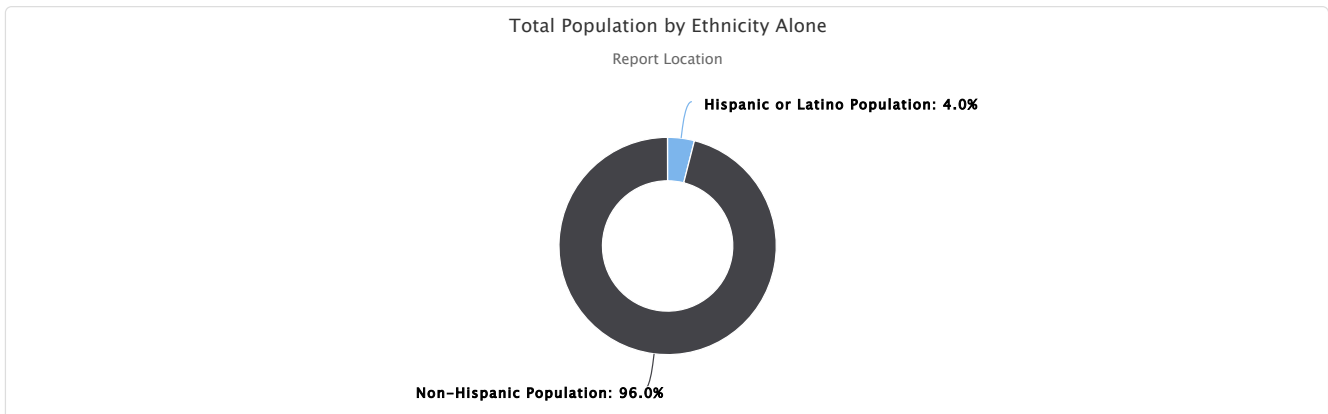

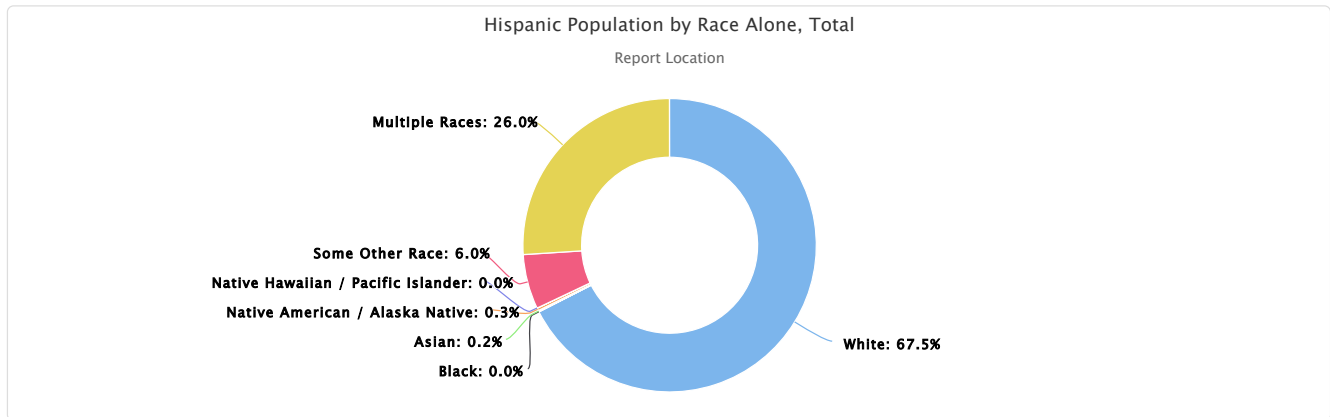

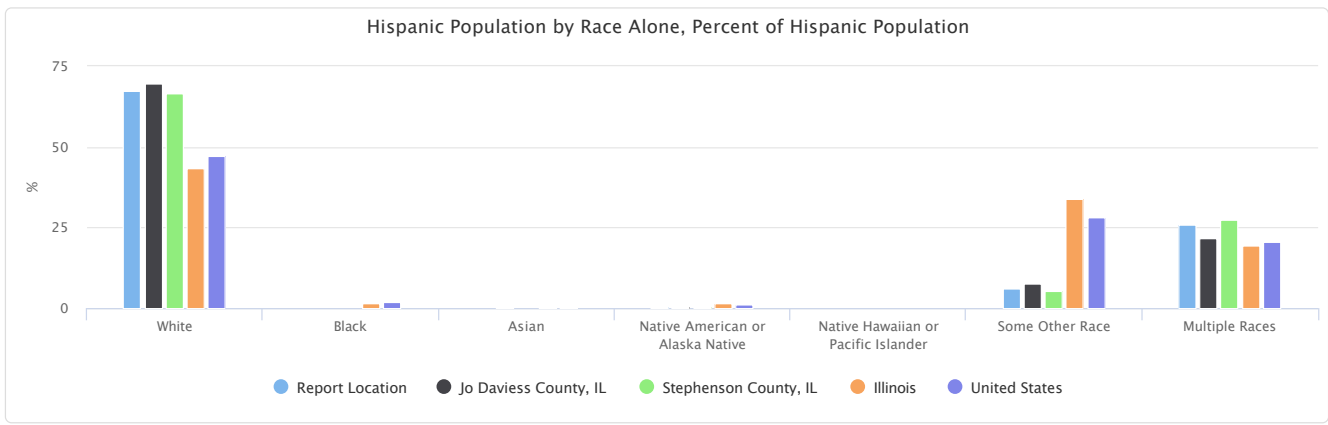

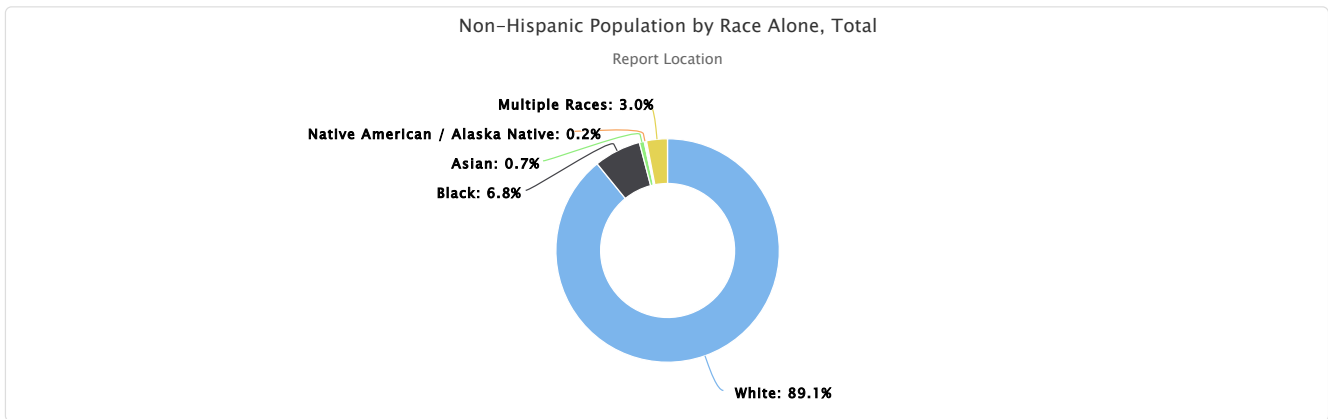

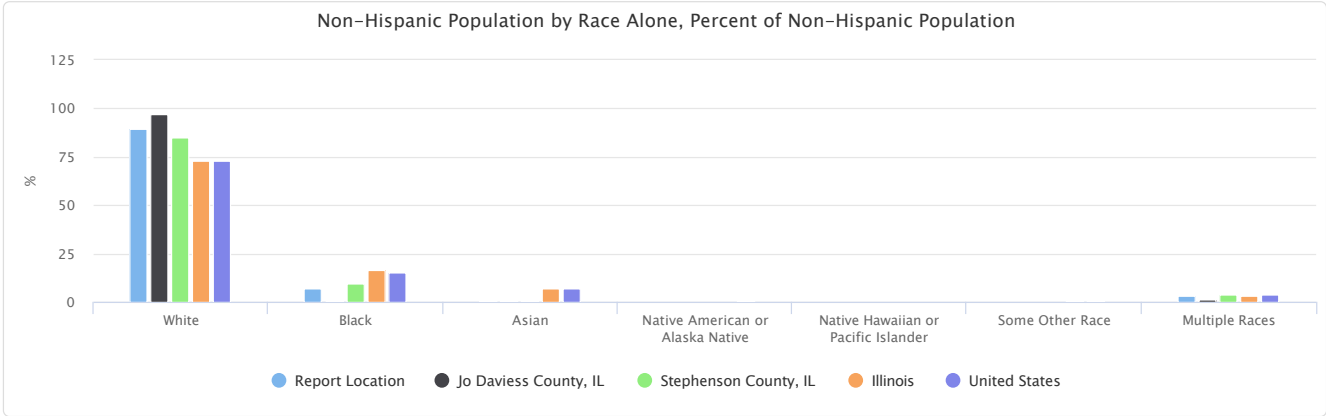

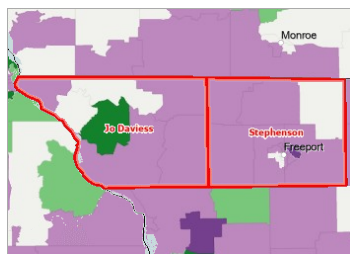
Total Population Change, 2010 - 2020

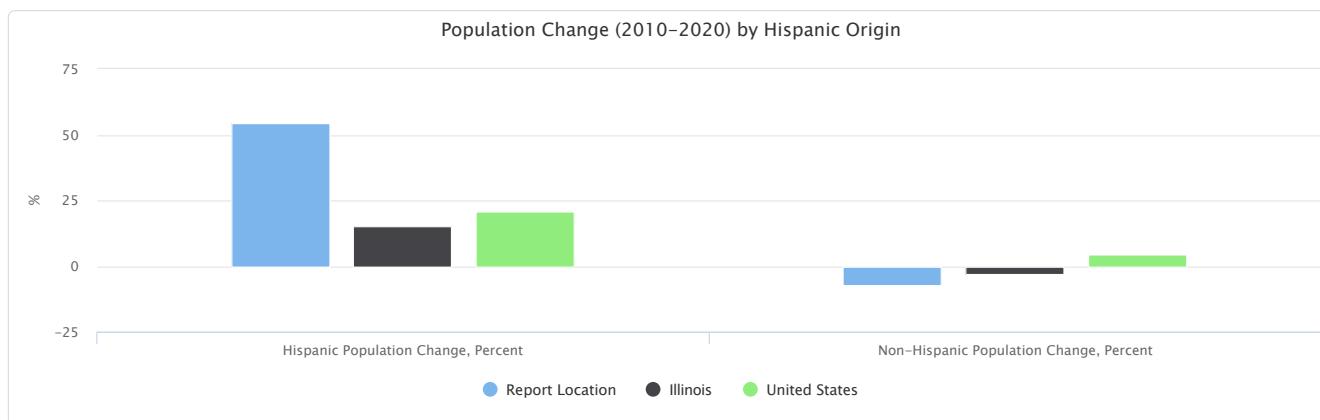

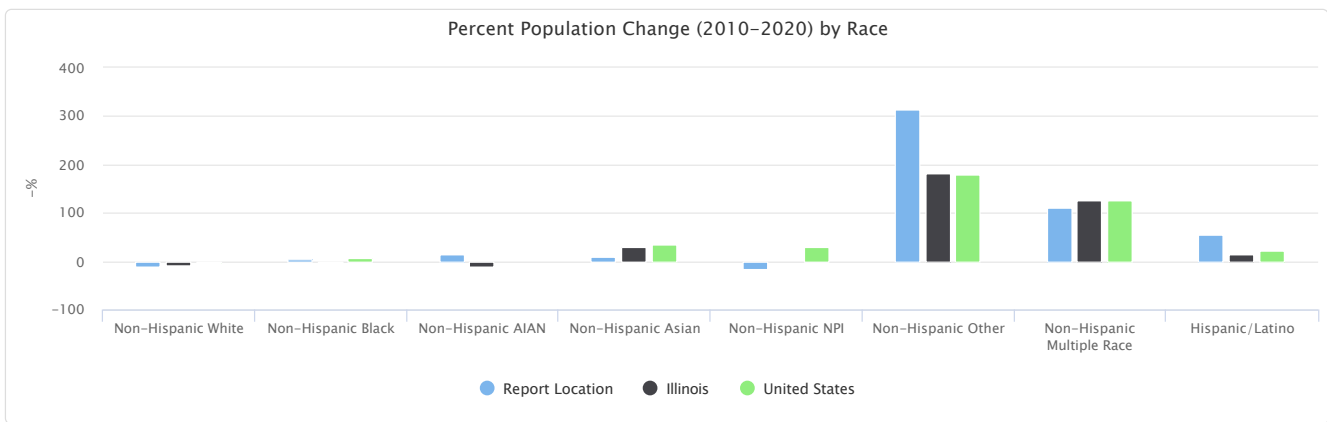

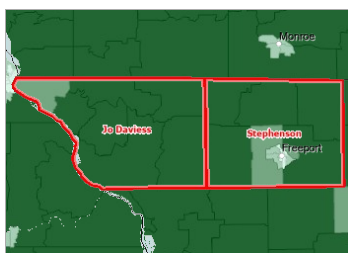


Urban and Rural Population

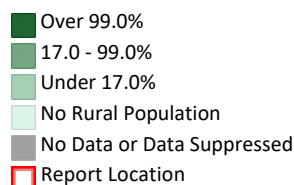

Population Living in Rural Areas, Percent by Tract, US Census Bureau 2020

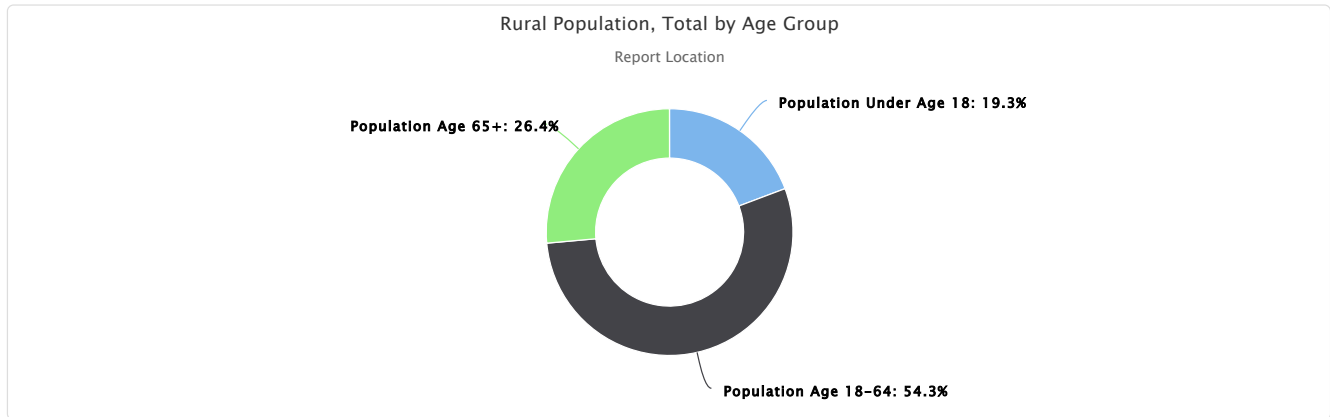

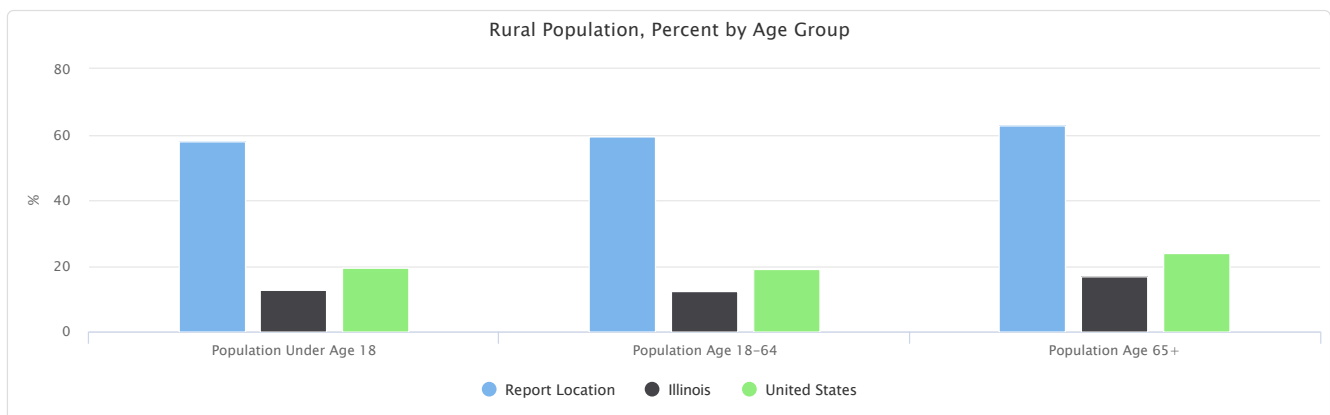

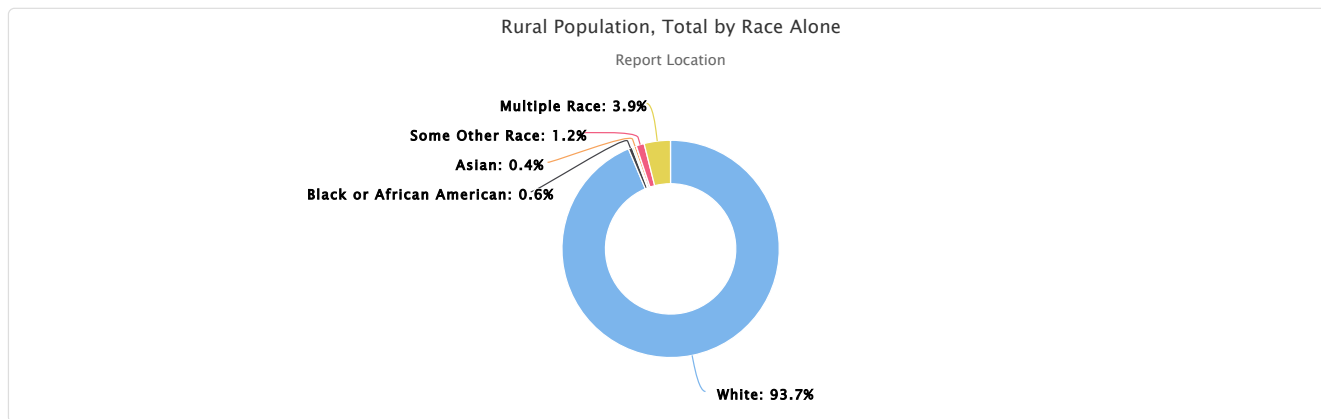

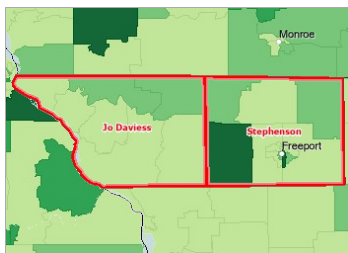


Families with Children

Households with Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

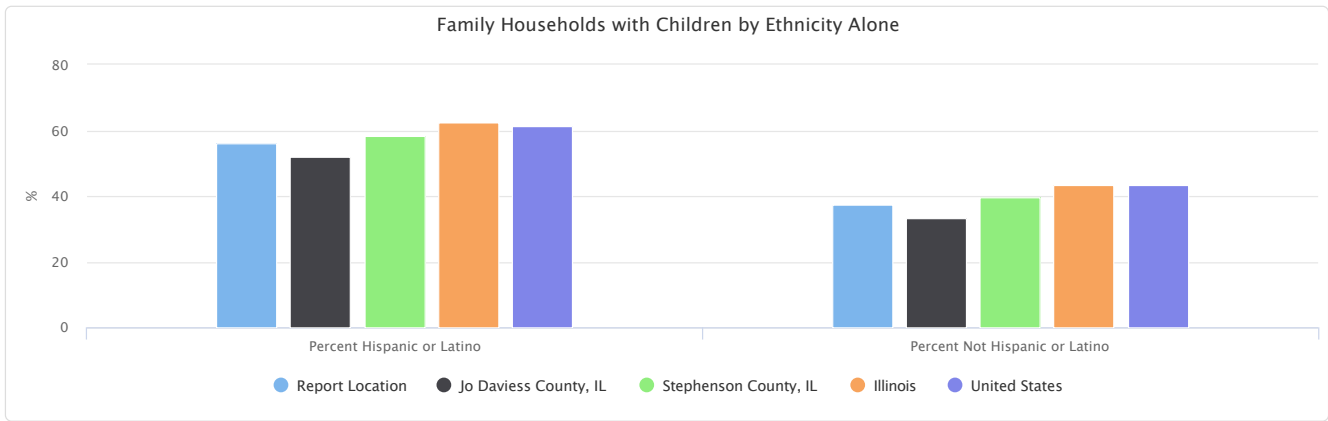

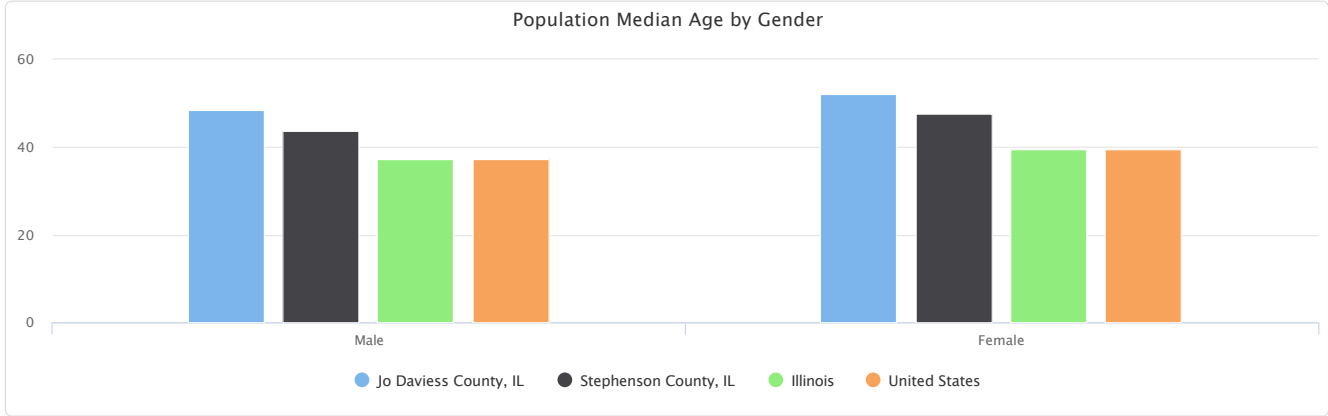

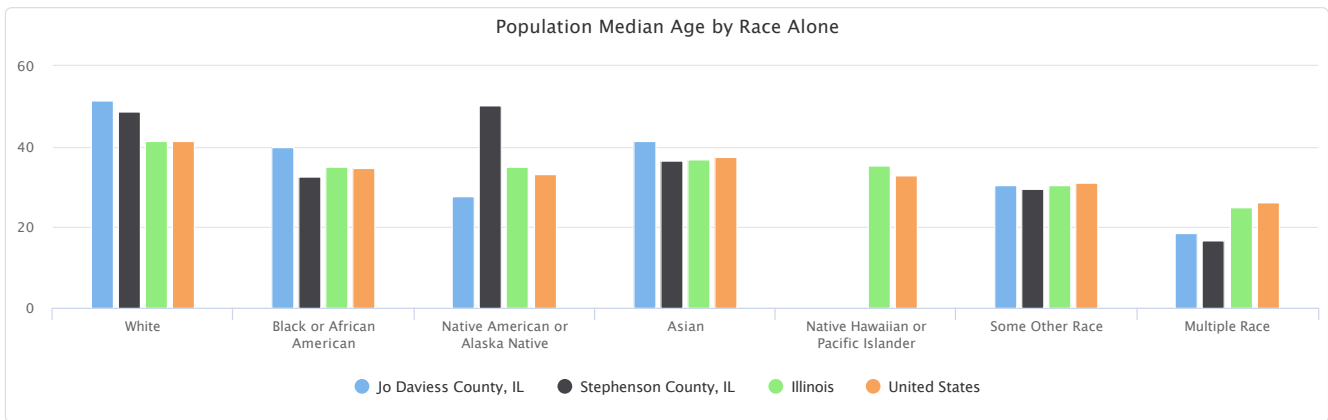

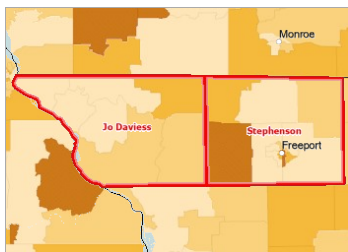

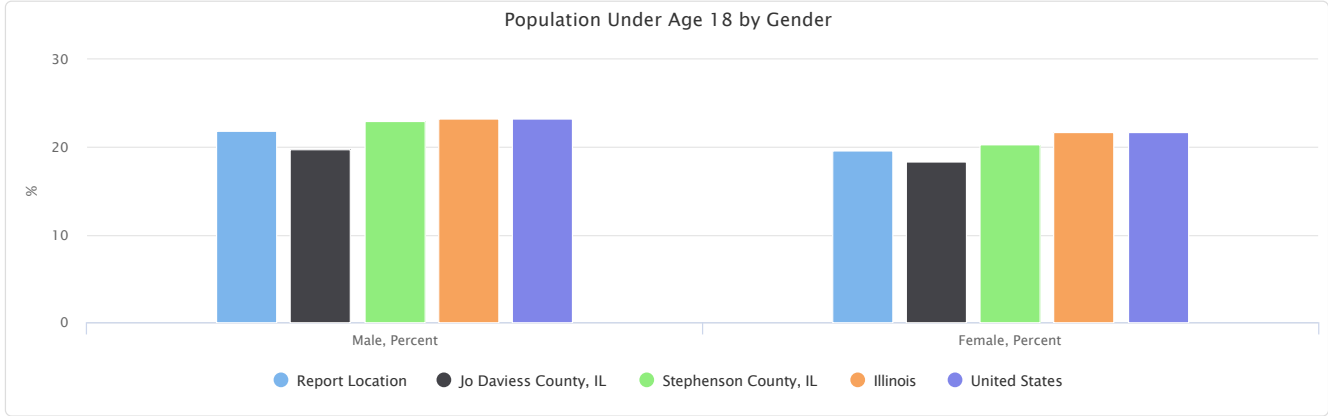

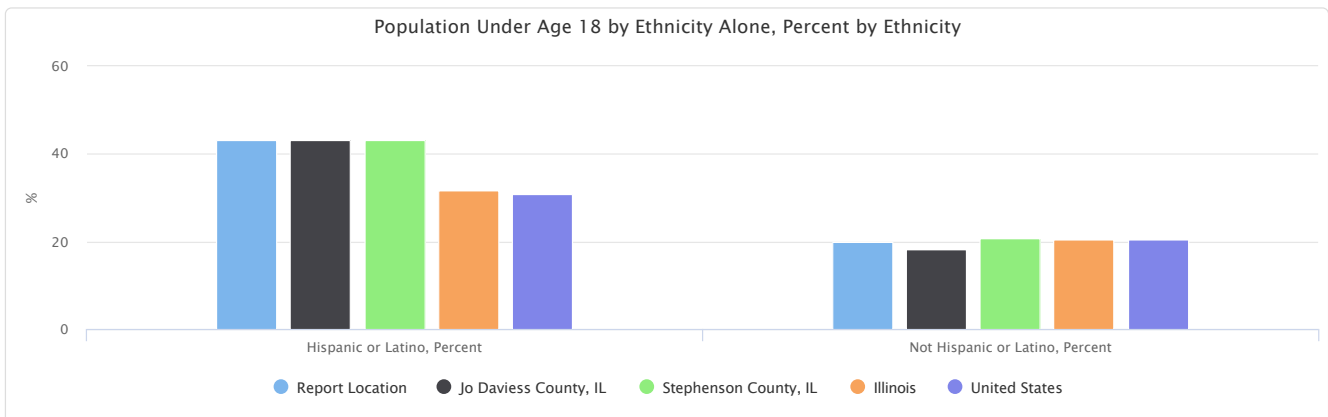

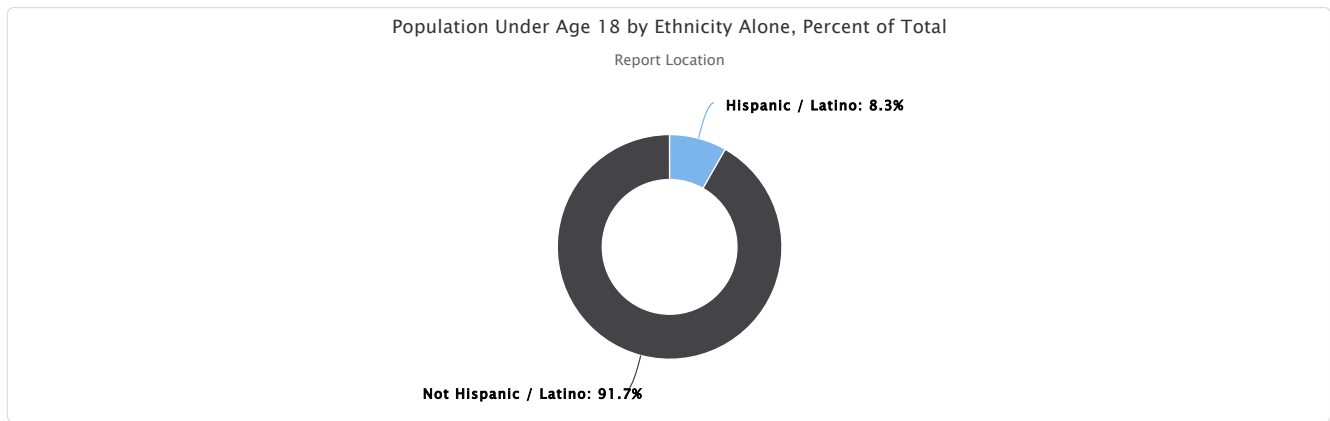

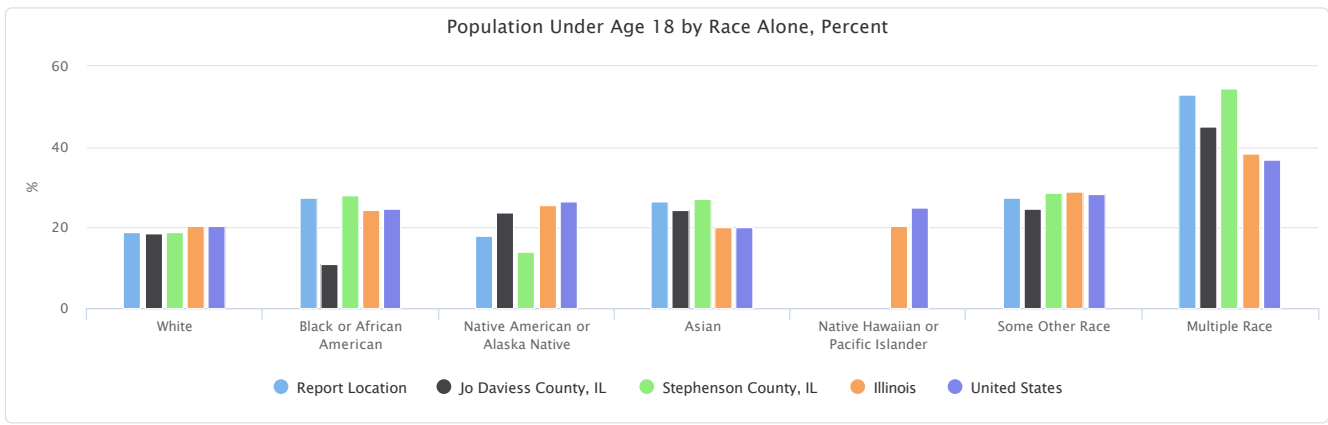

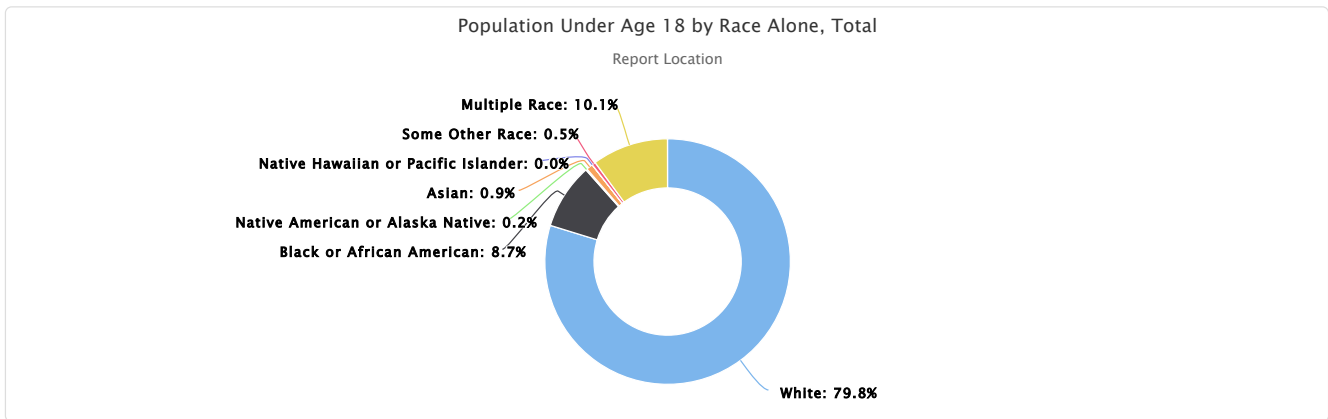

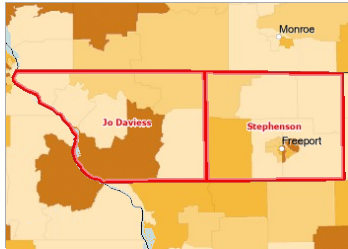

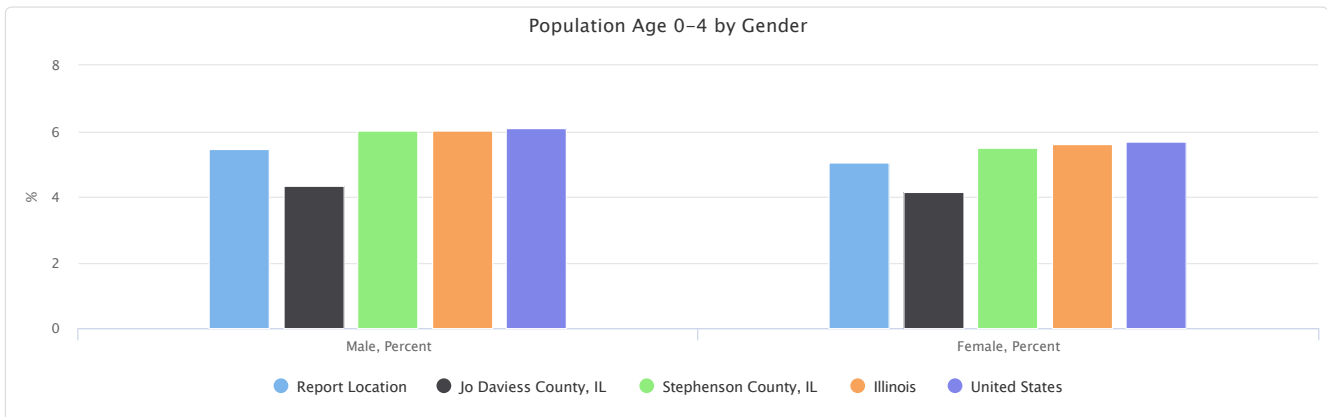

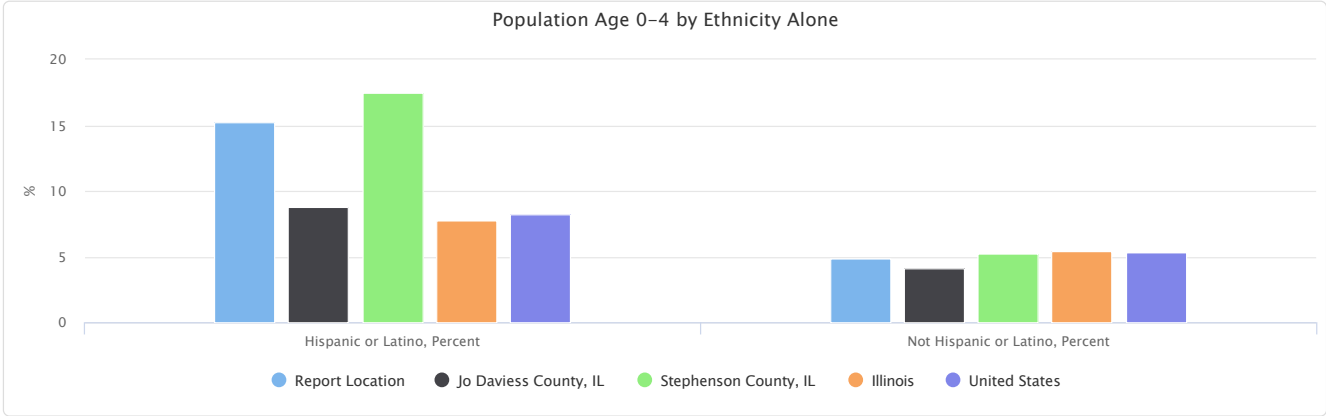

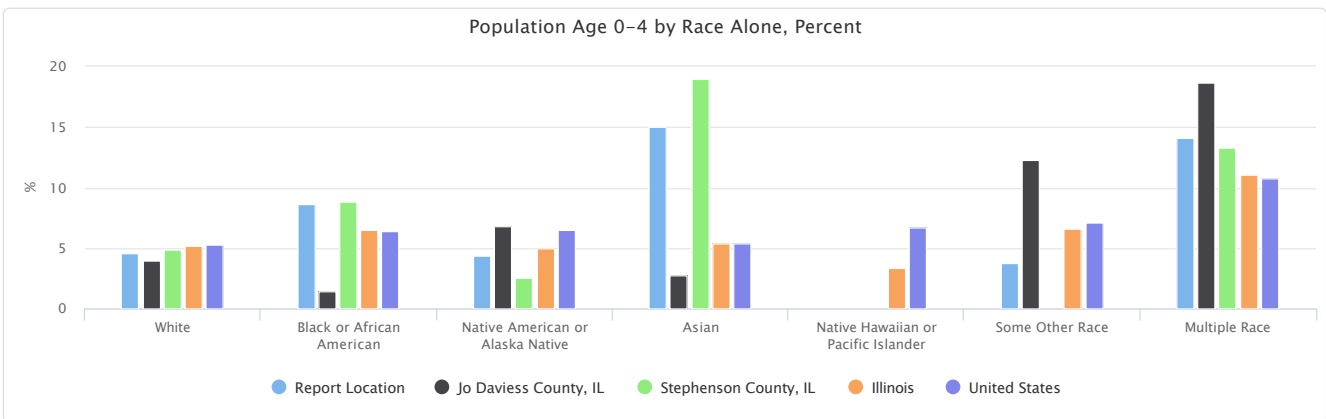

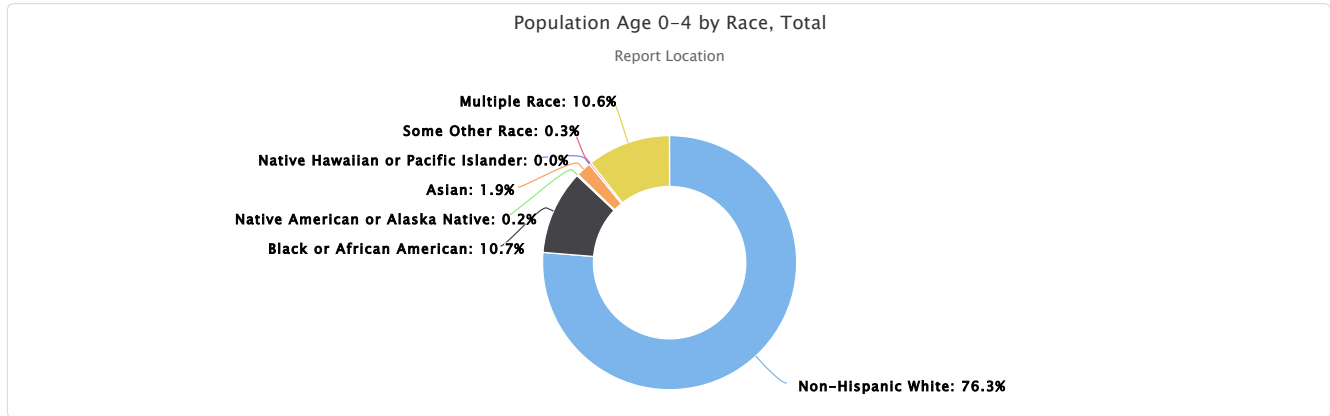

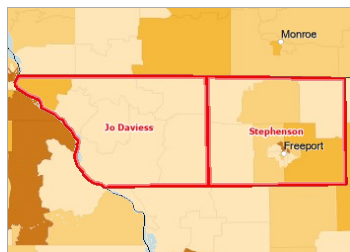

Population Age 18-64, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

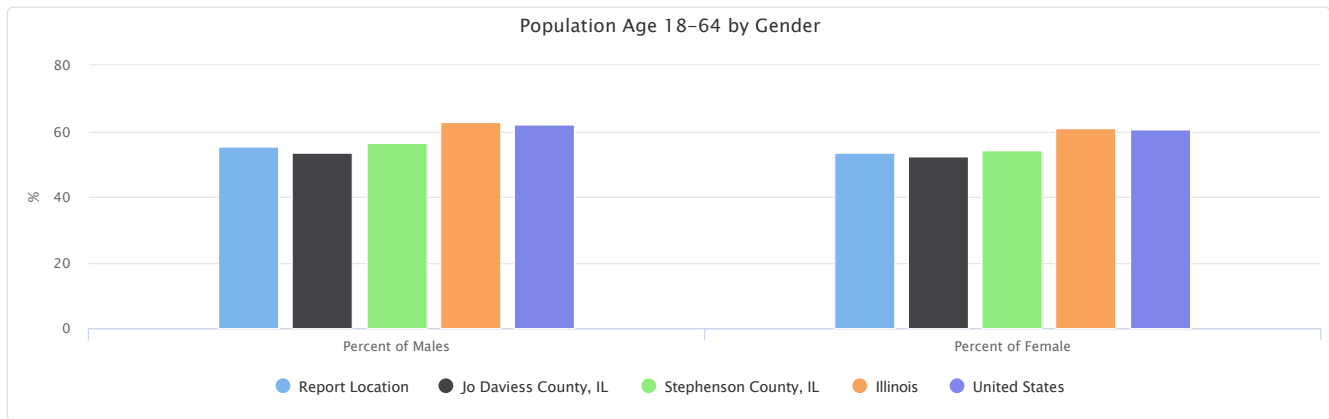

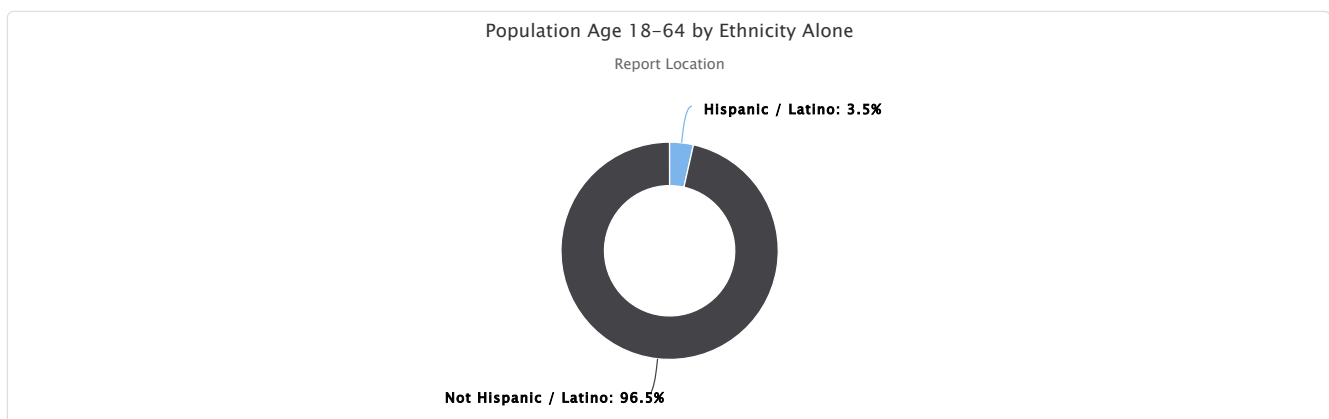

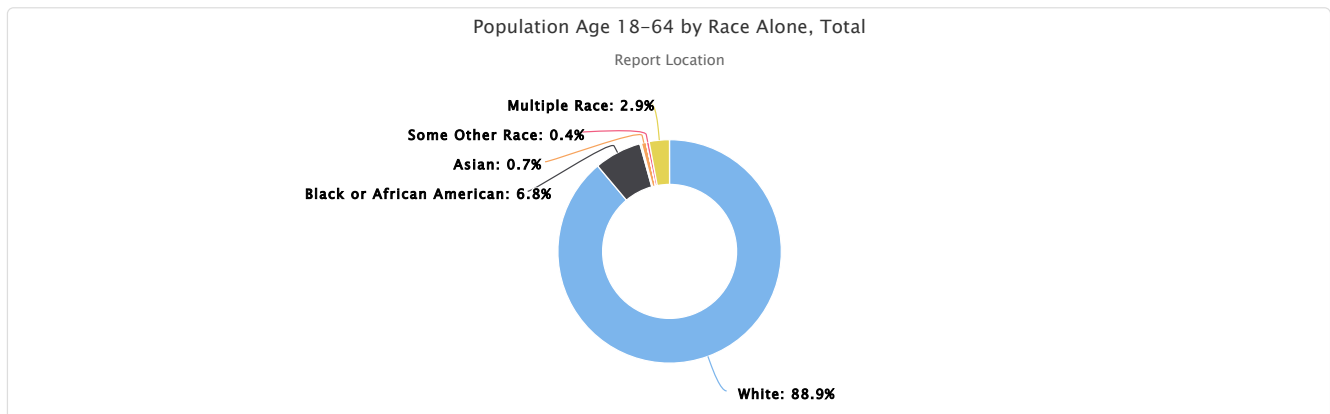

Population Age 18-24, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

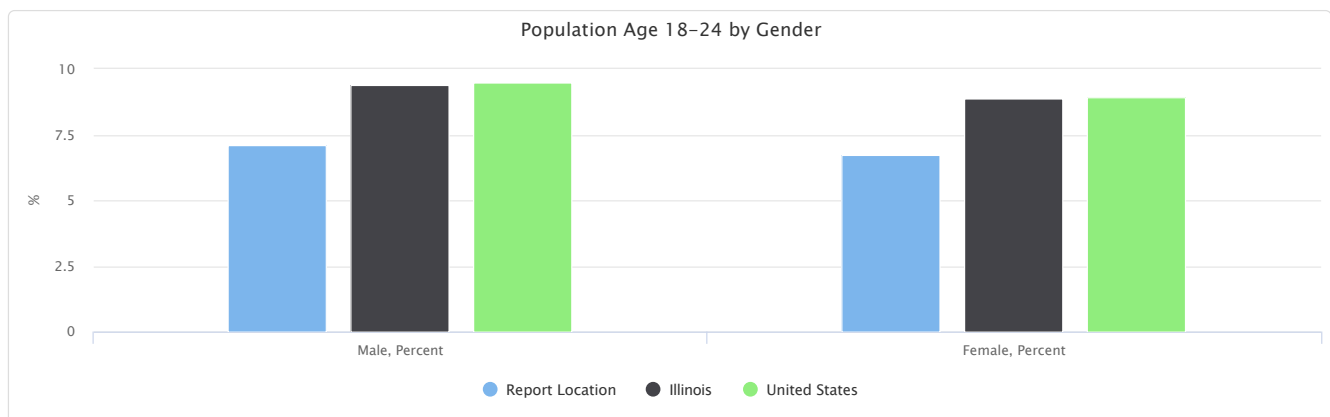

Population Age 55-64, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

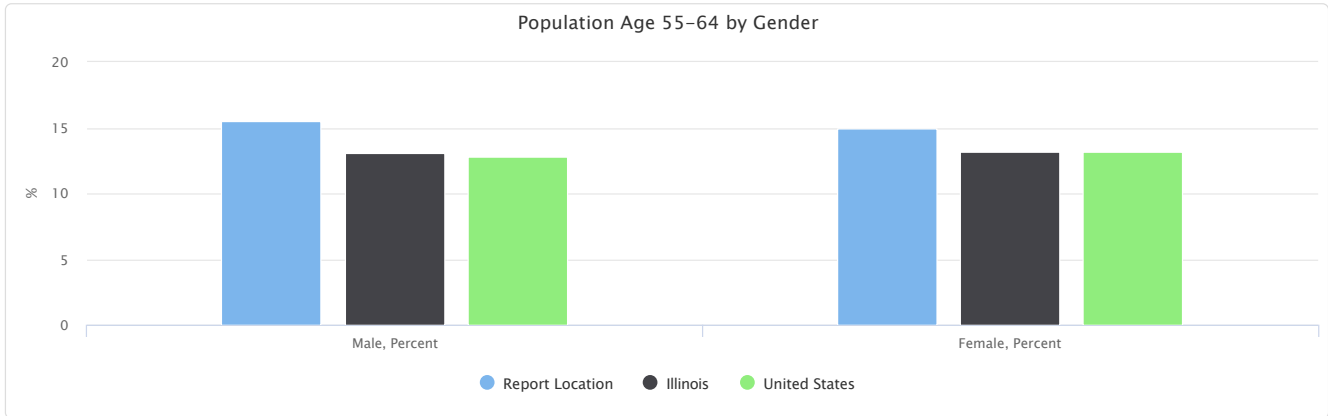

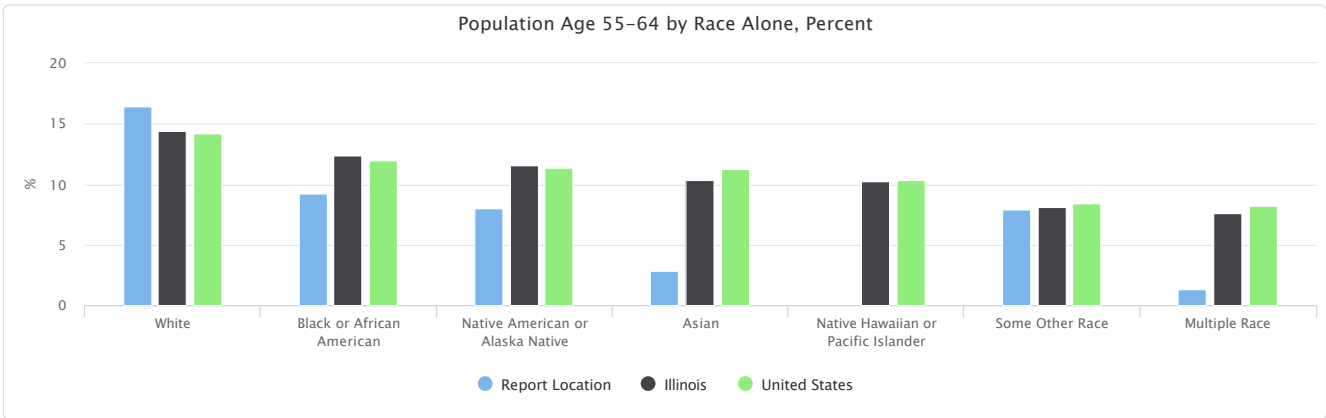

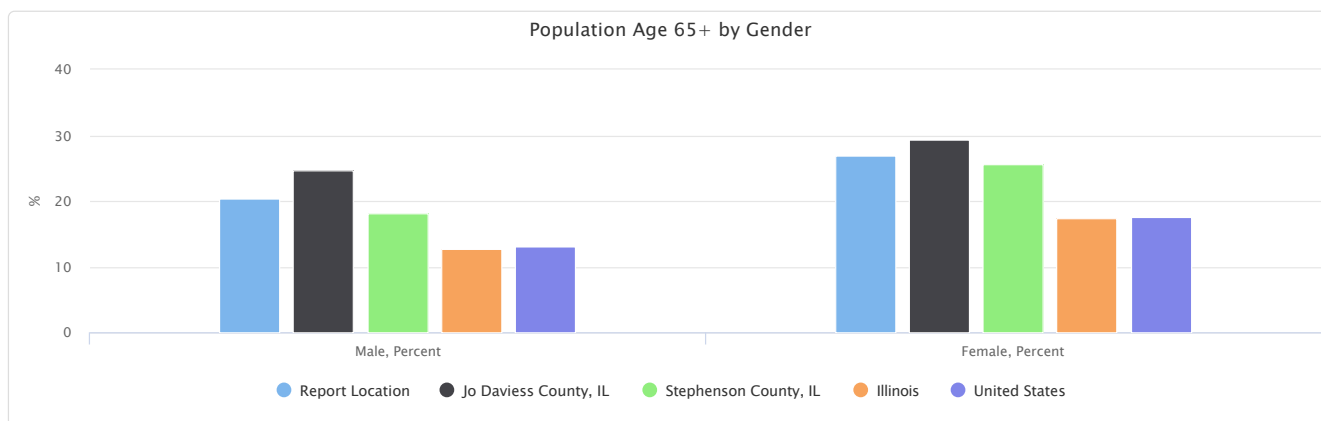

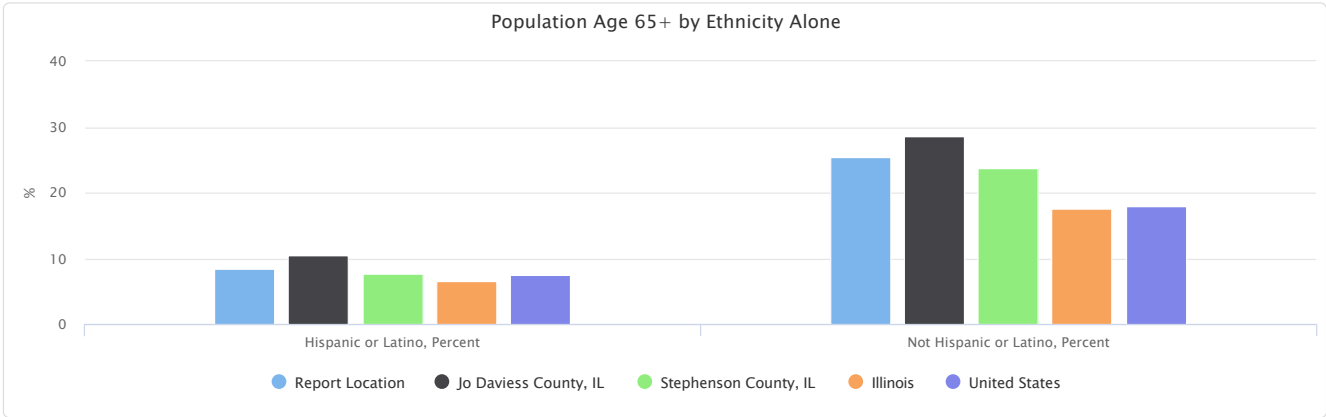

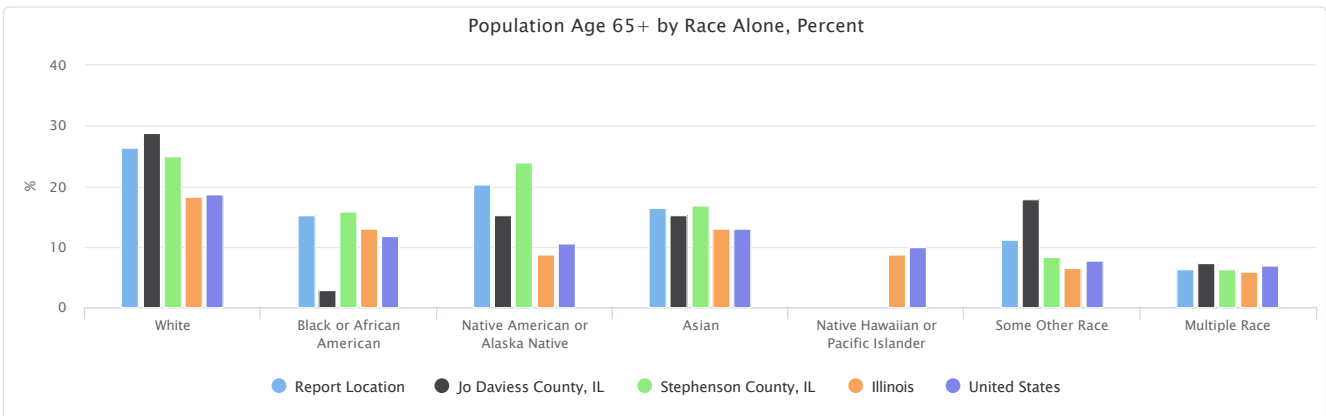

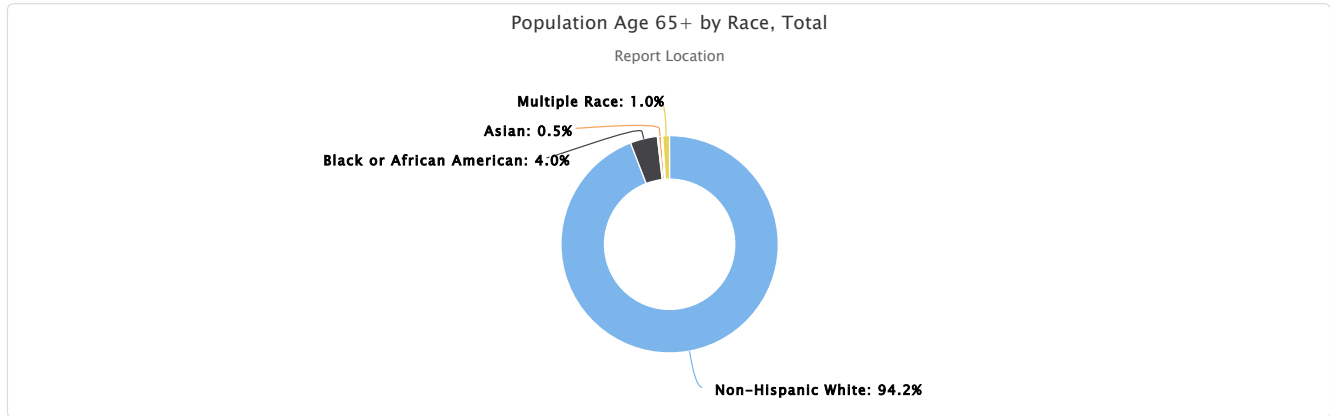

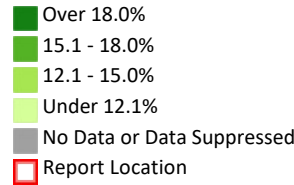

Disabled Population, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

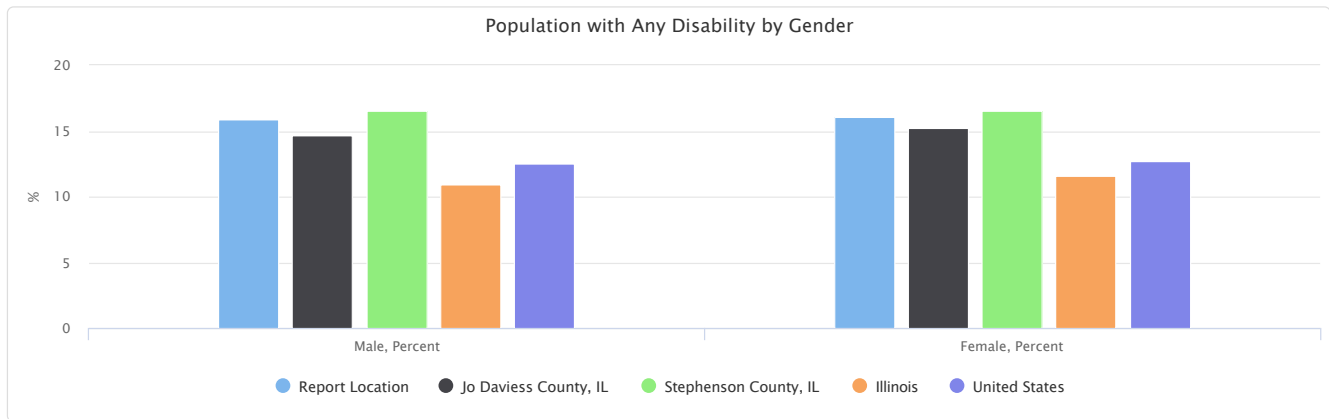

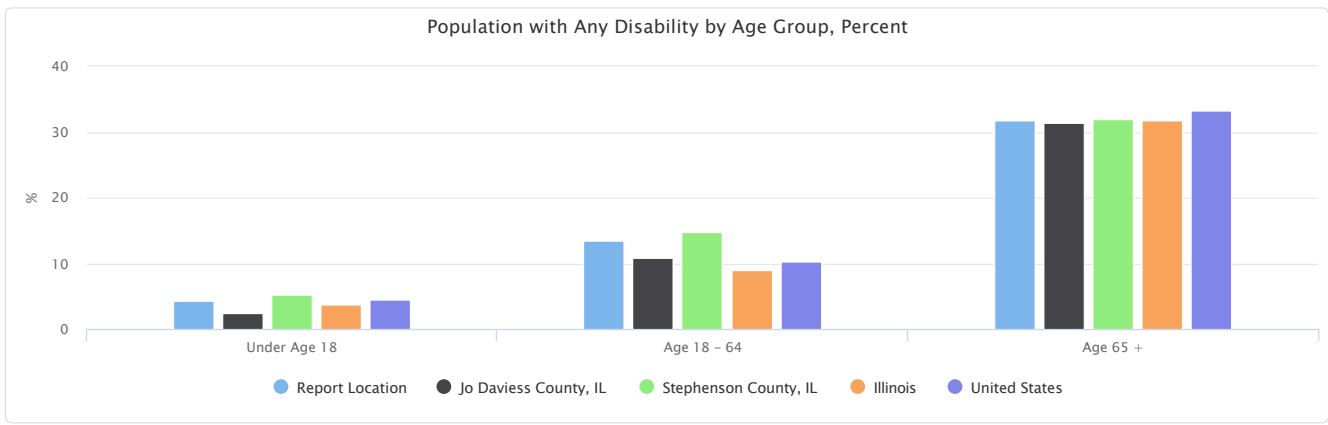

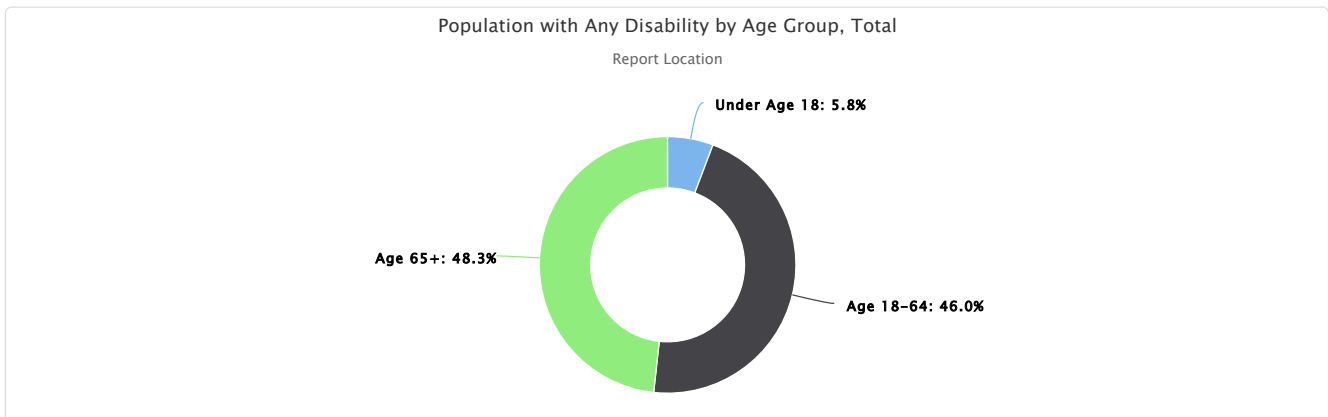

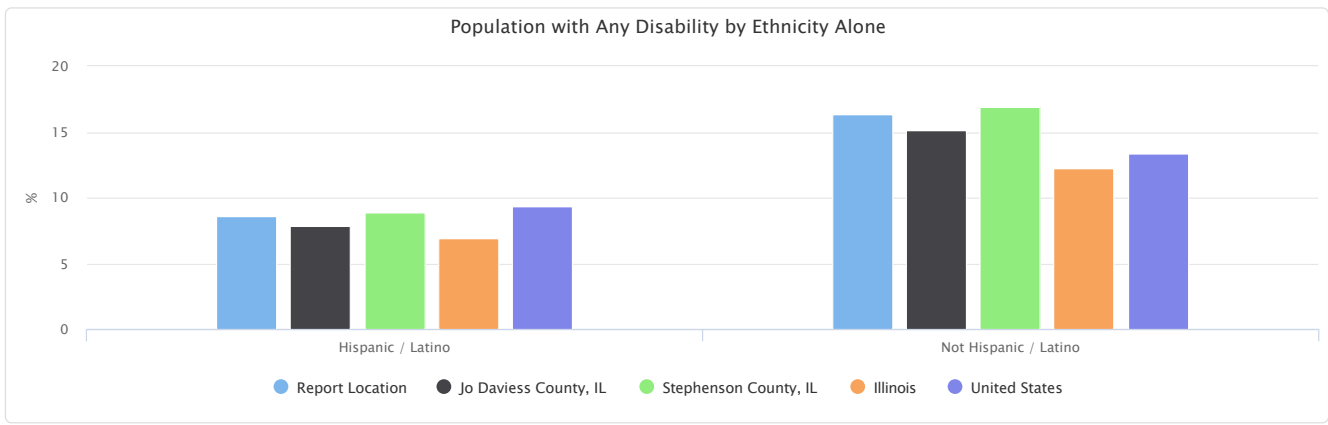

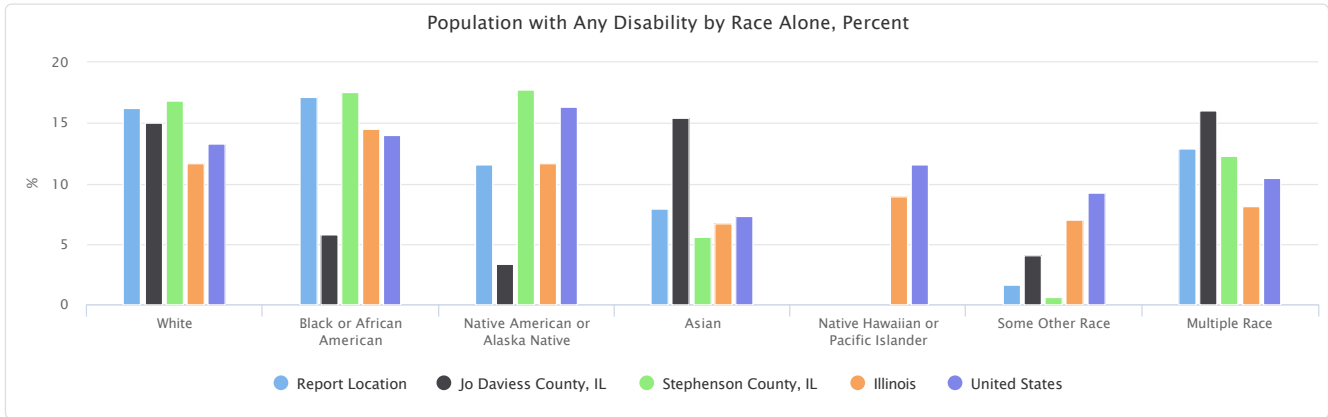

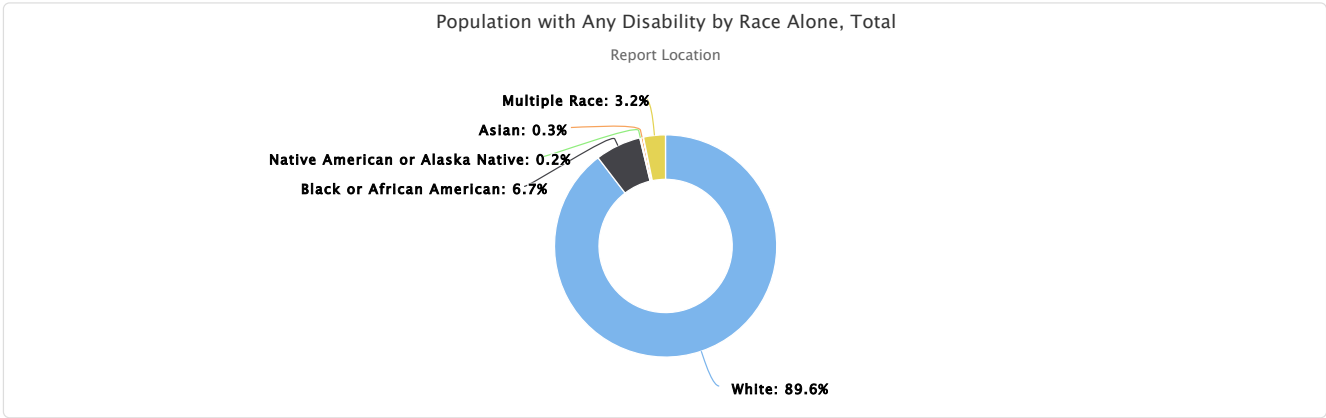

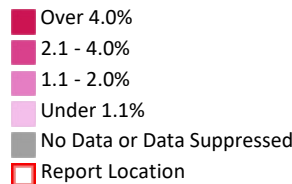

Population with Limited English Proficiency, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

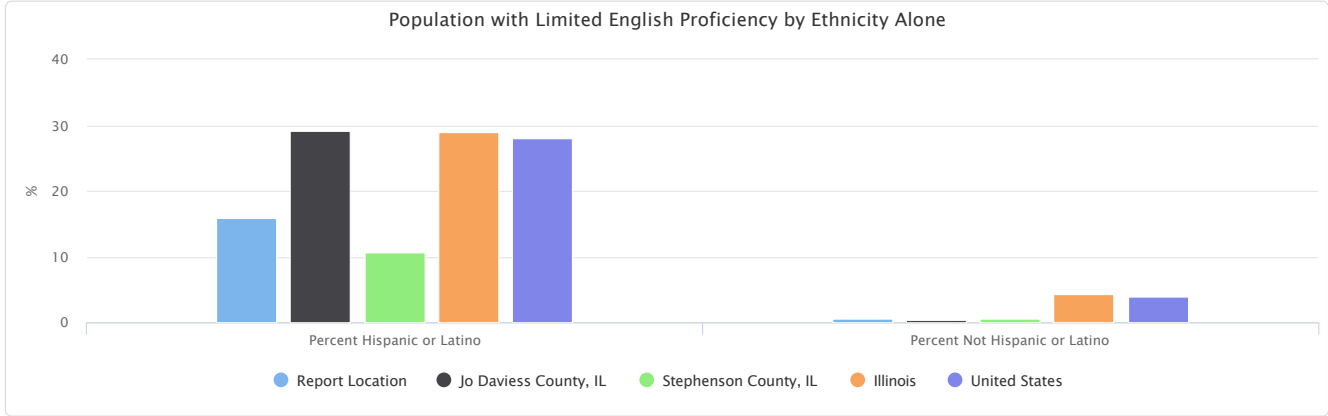

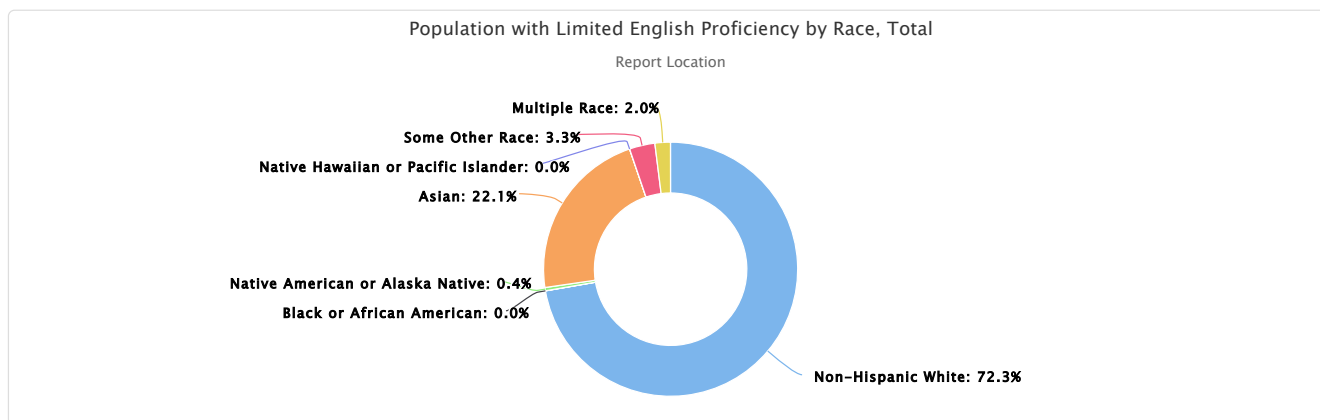

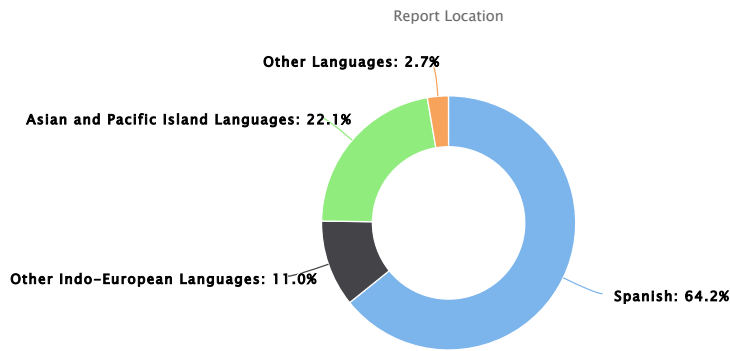

Population with Limited English Proficiency by Language Spoken at Home

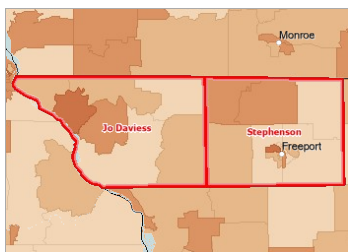

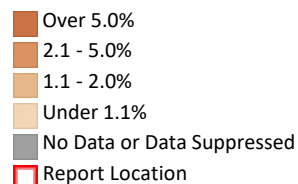

Foreign-Born Population (Non-Citizen or Naturalized), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

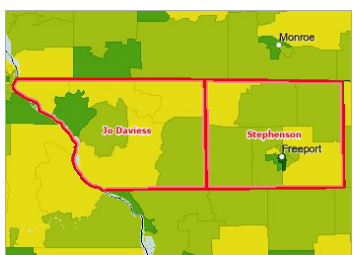

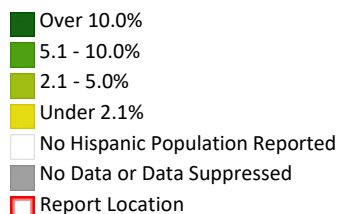

Population, Hispanic or Latino, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

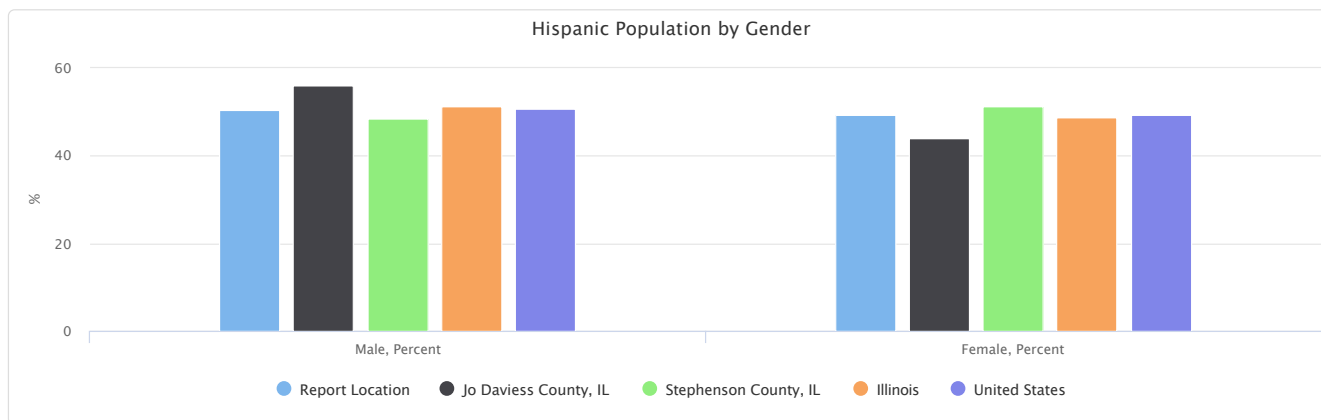

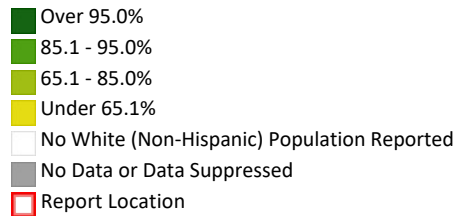

Population, White (Non-Hispanic), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

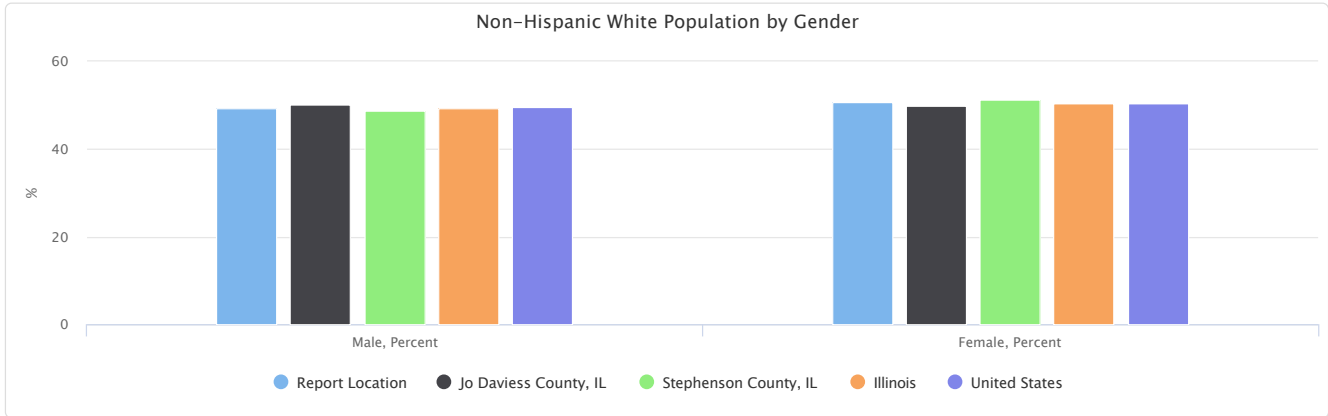

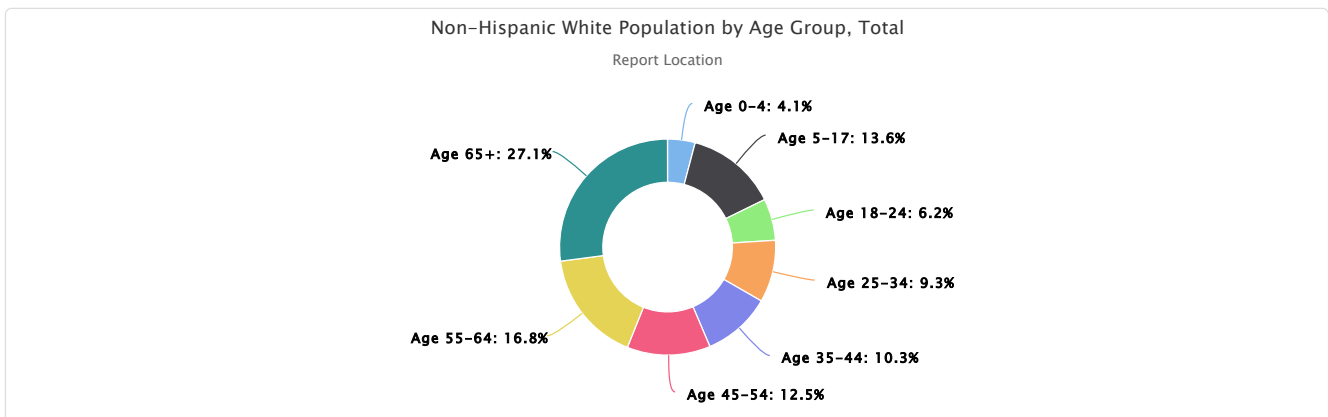

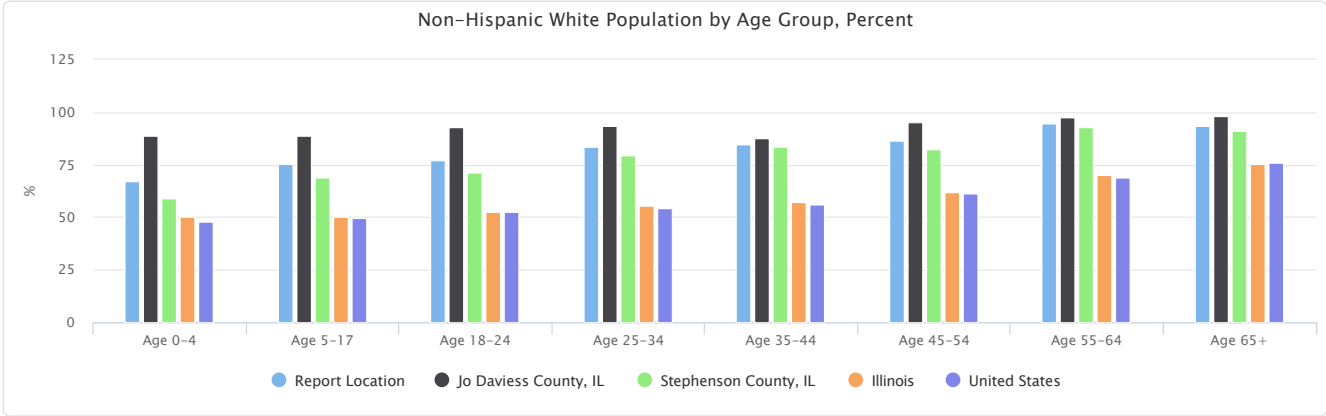

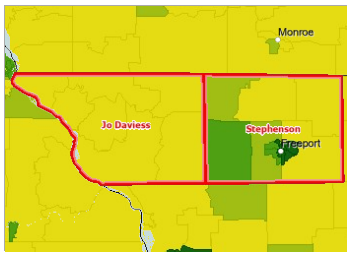

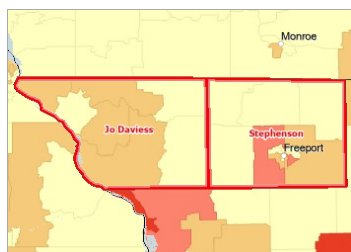

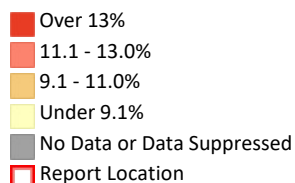

Veterans, Percent of Total Population by Tract, ACS 2017-21



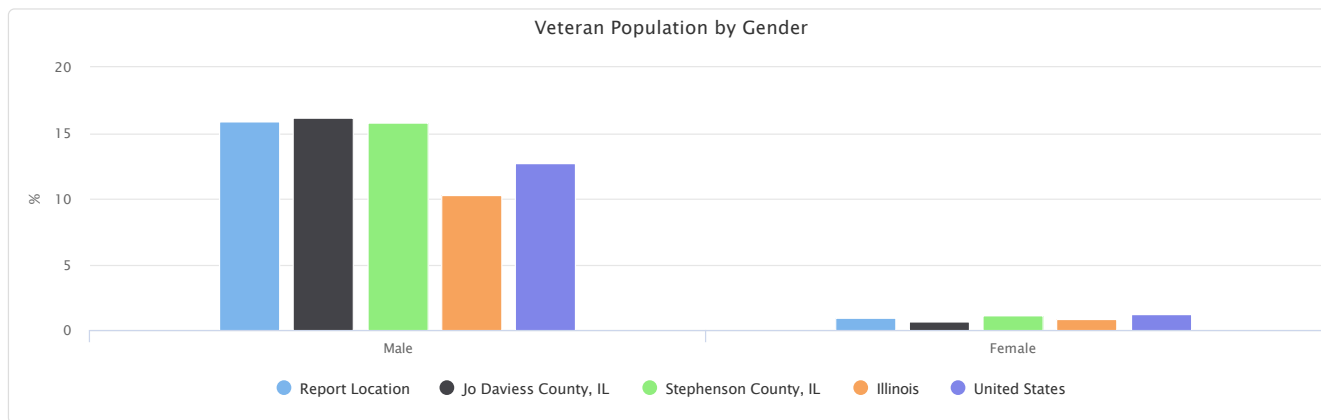

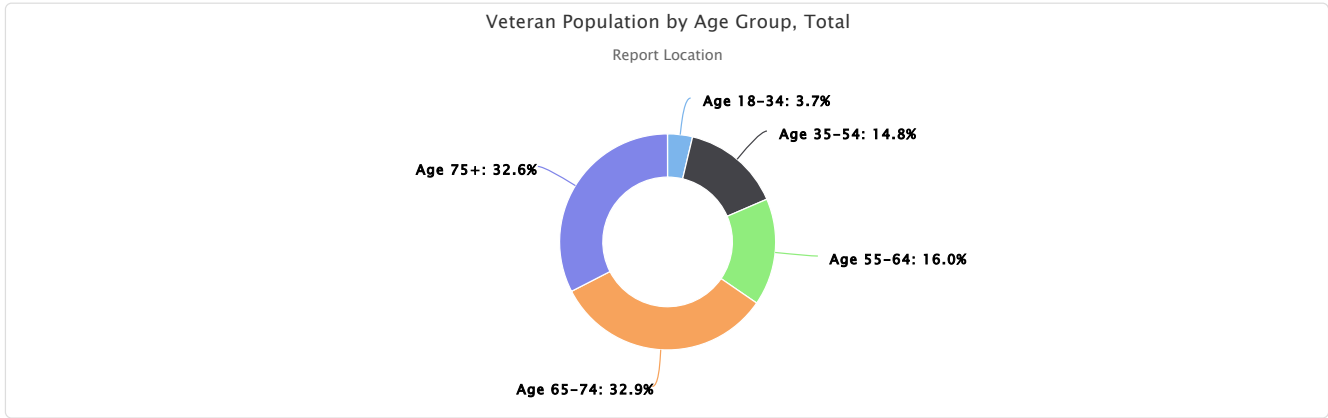

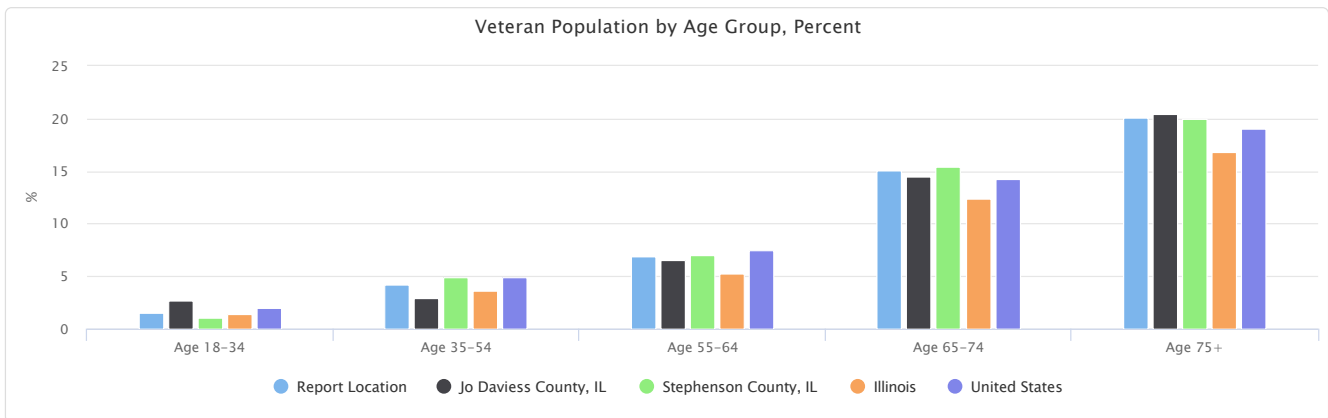

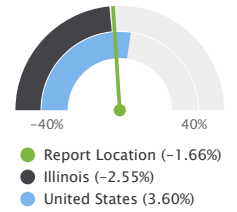

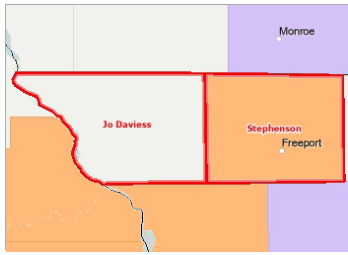

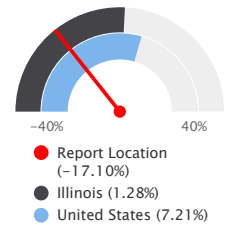

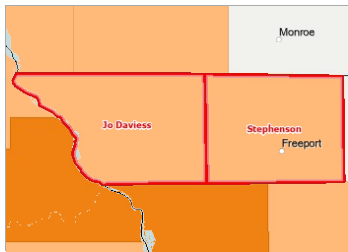

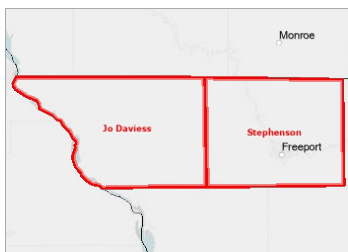

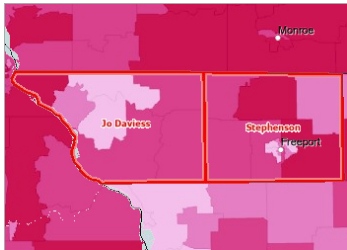

Labor Force Participation Rate

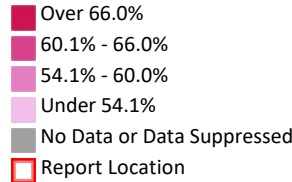

Labor Force, Participation Rate by Tract, ACS 2017-21

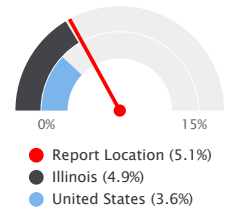

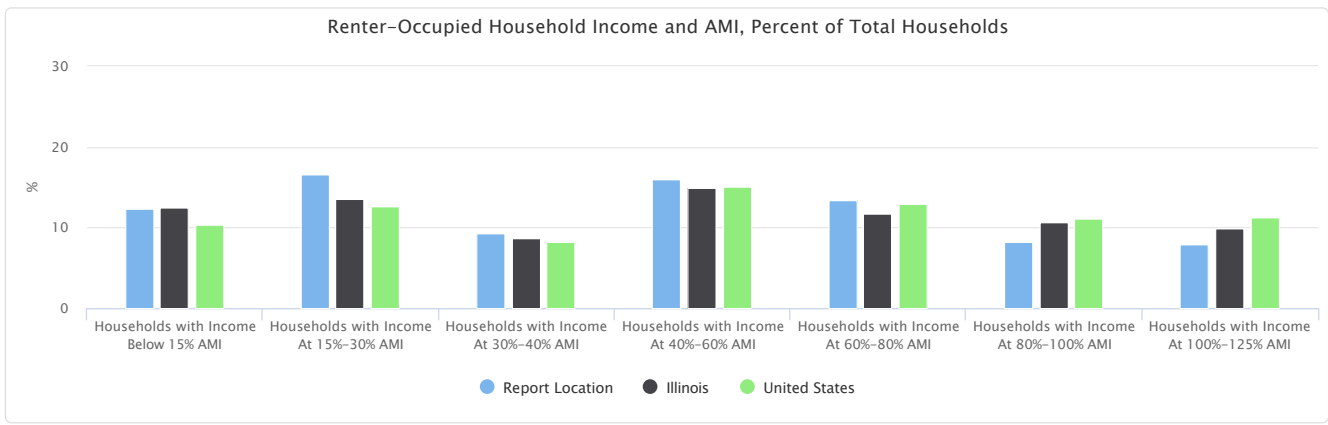

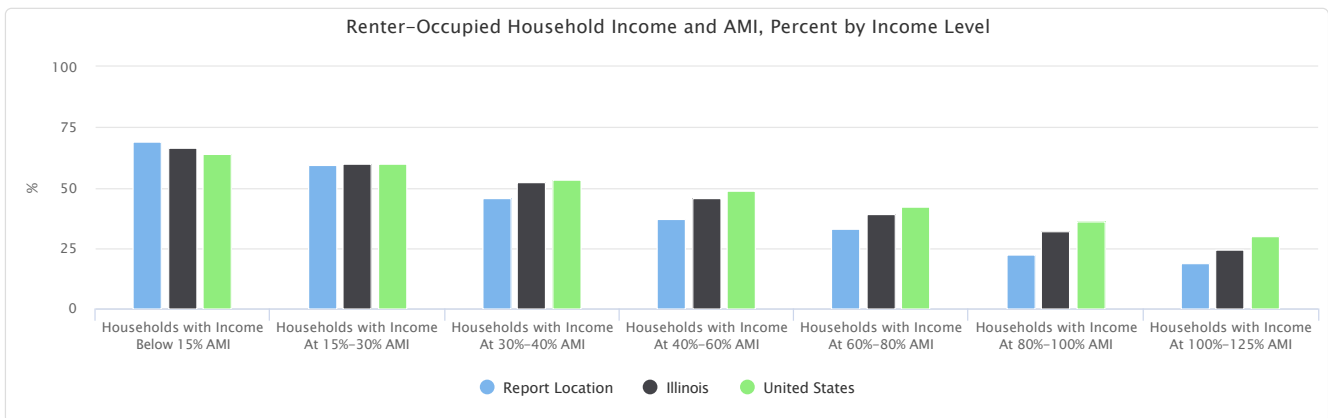

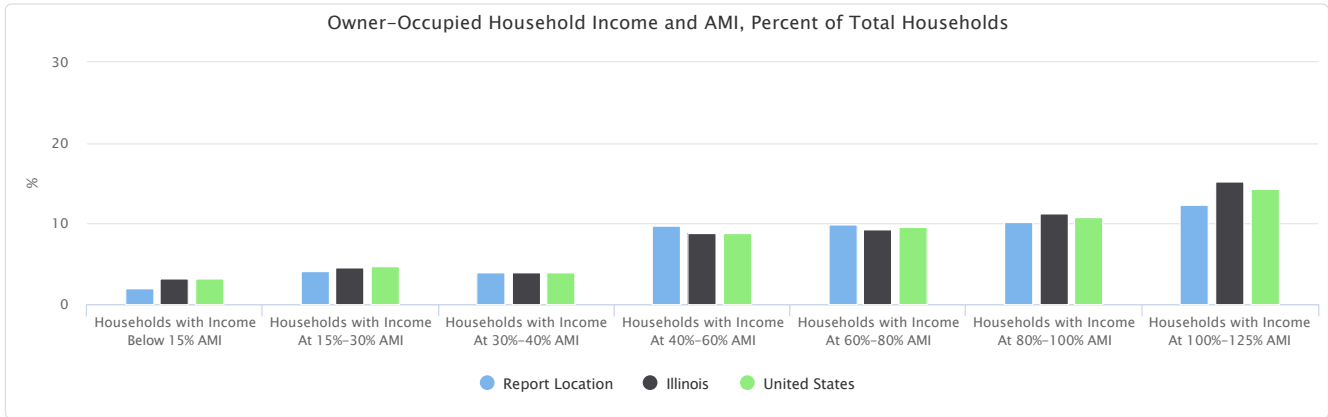

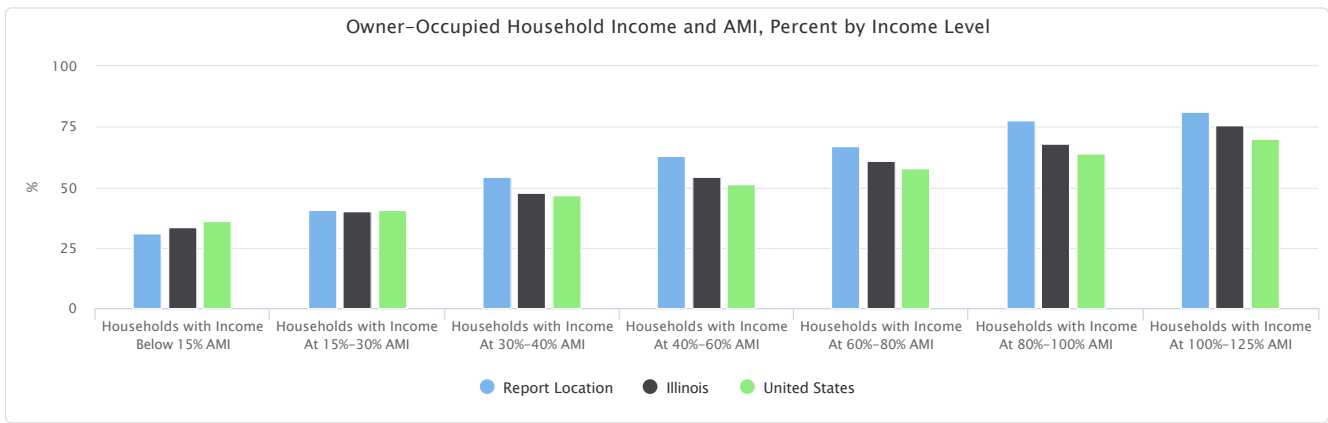

Median Household Income by Tract, ACS 2017-21

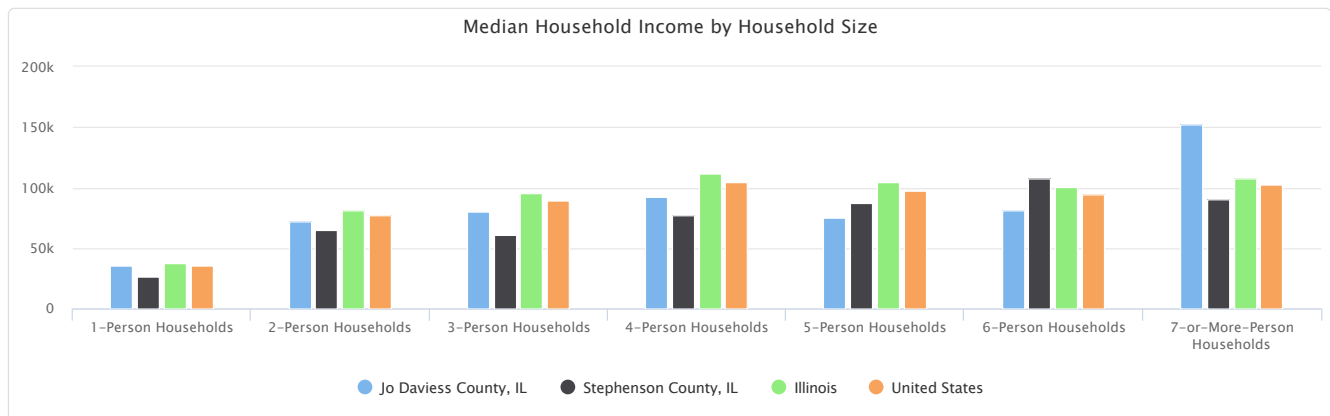

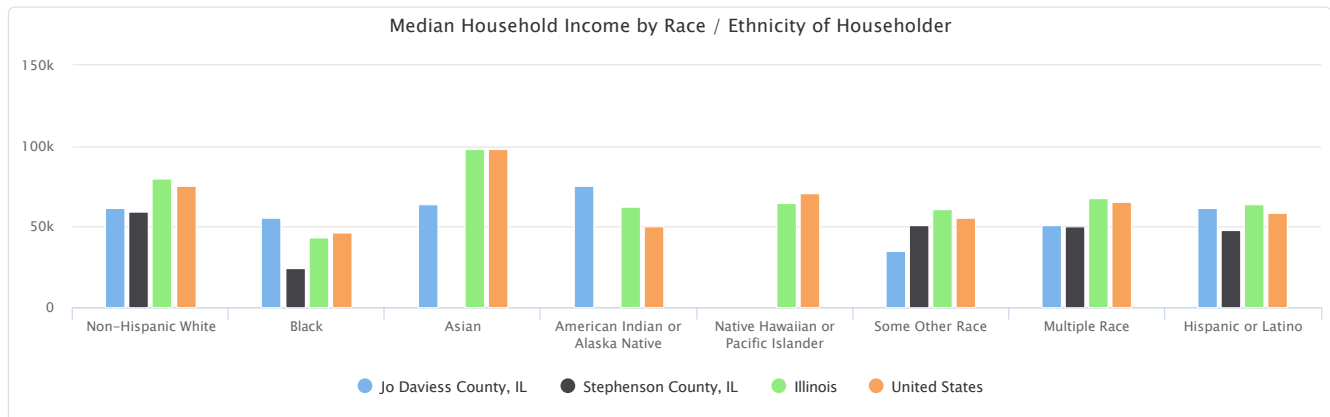

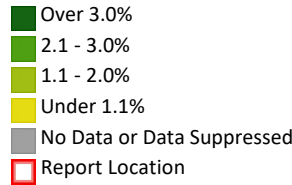

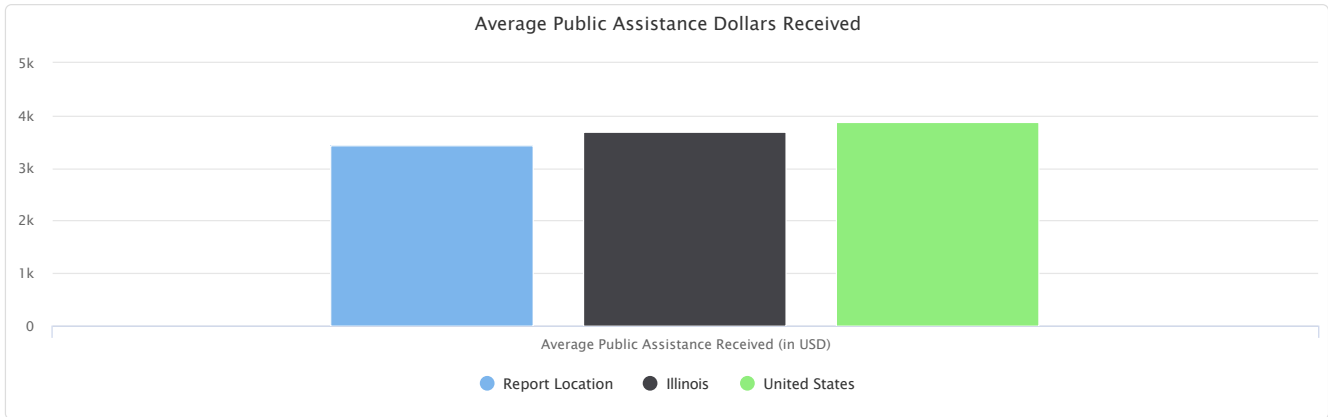

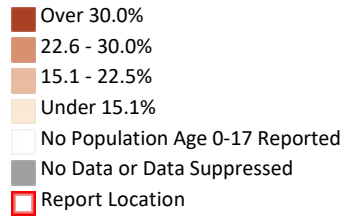

Population Below the Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

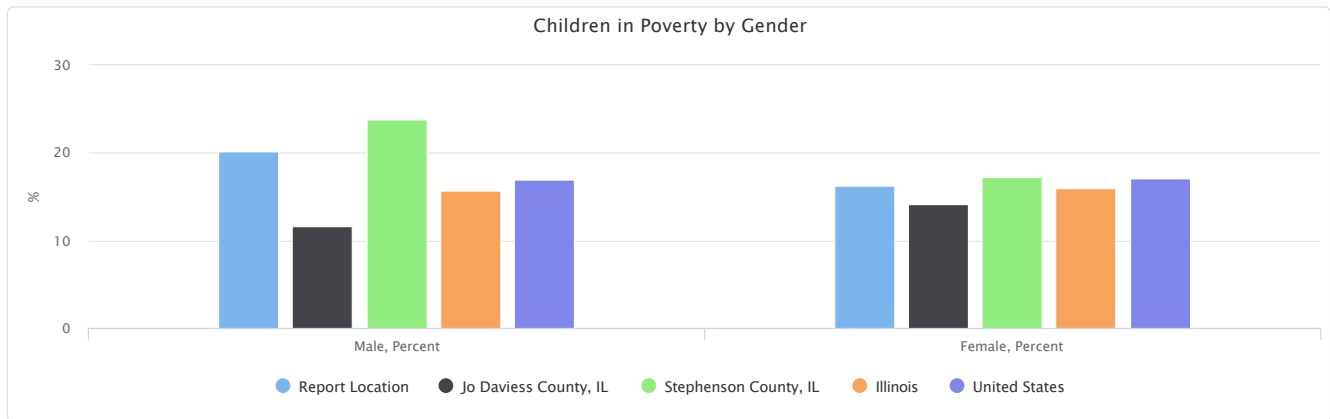

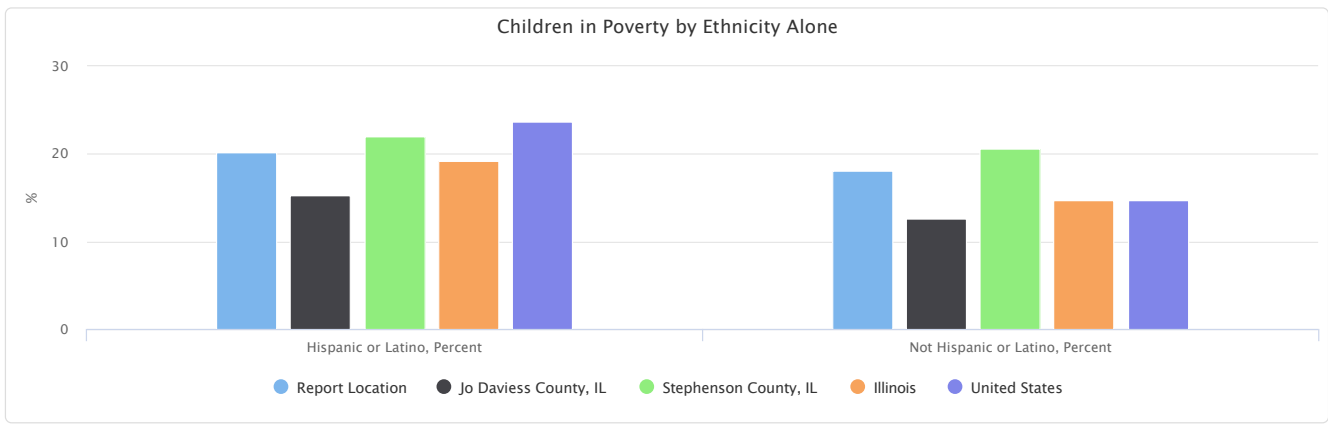

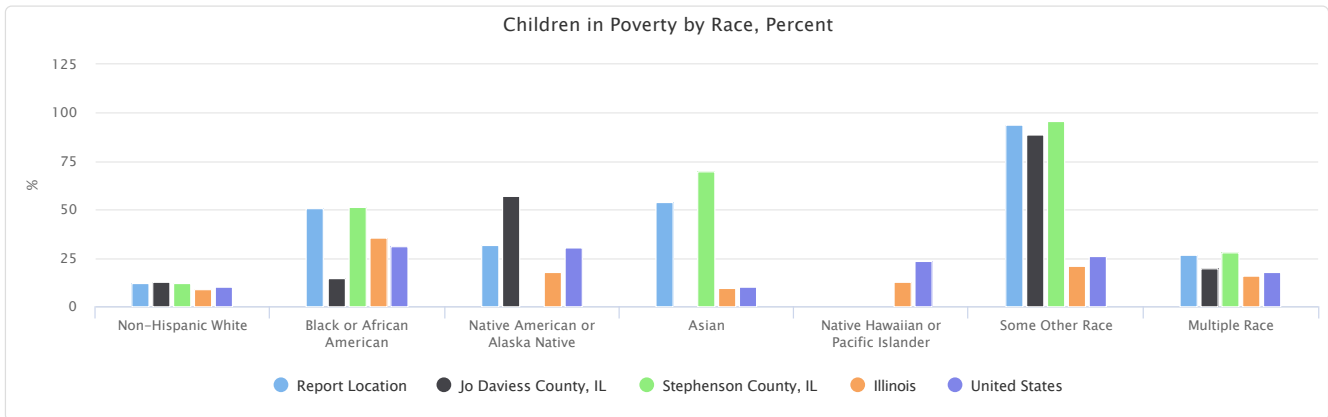

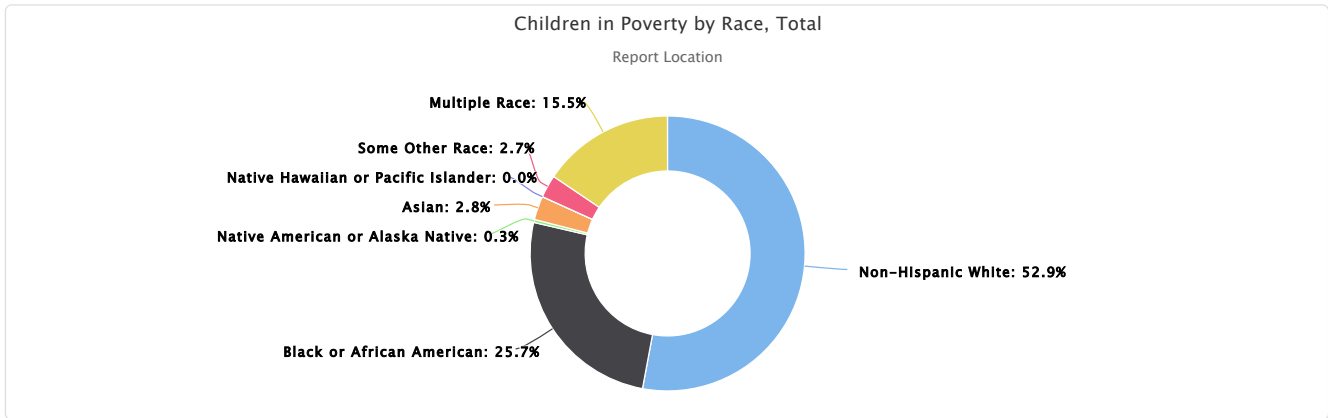

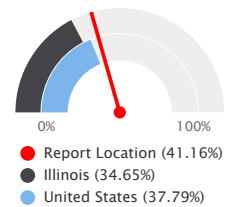

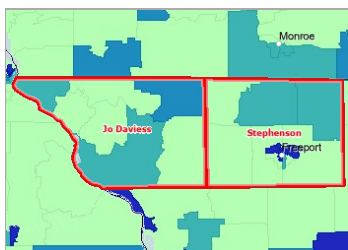

Population Below 200% Poverty Level, Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

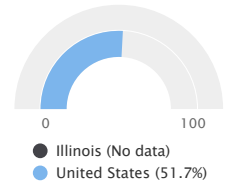

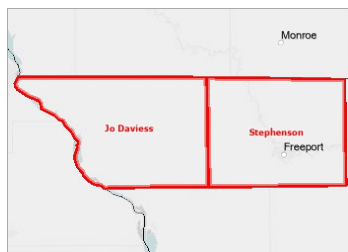

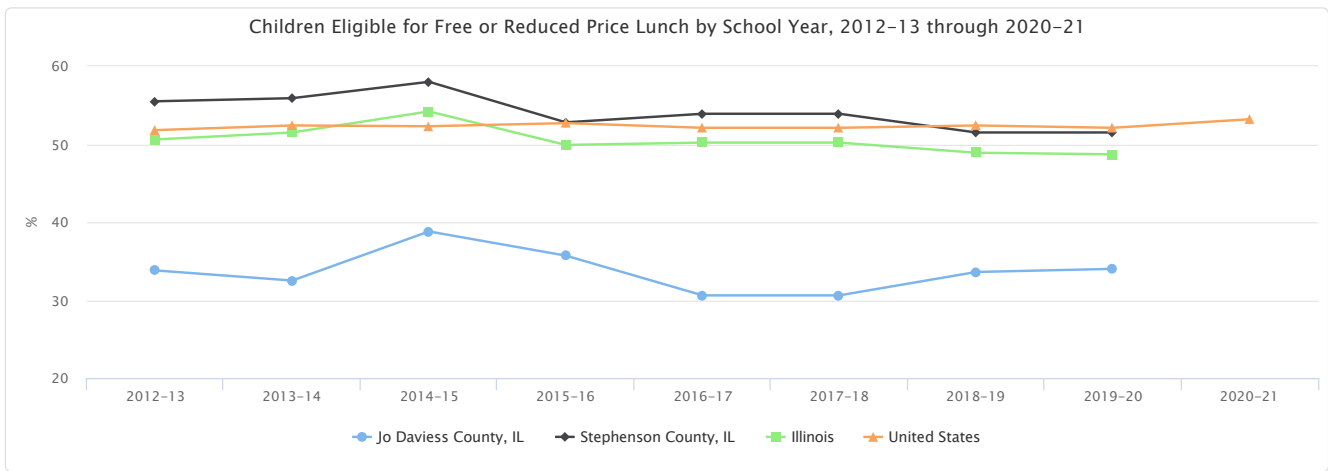

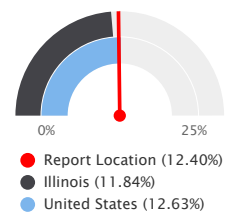

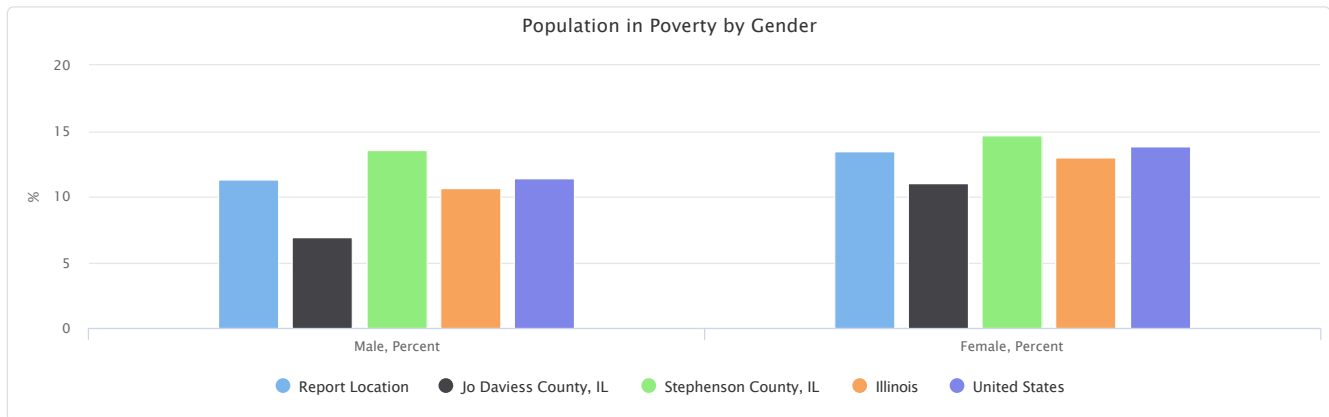

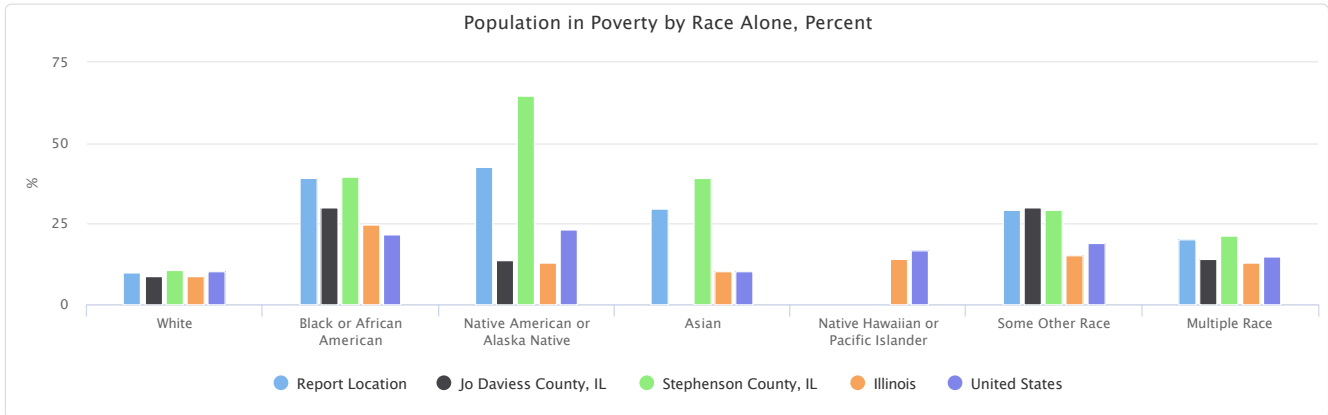

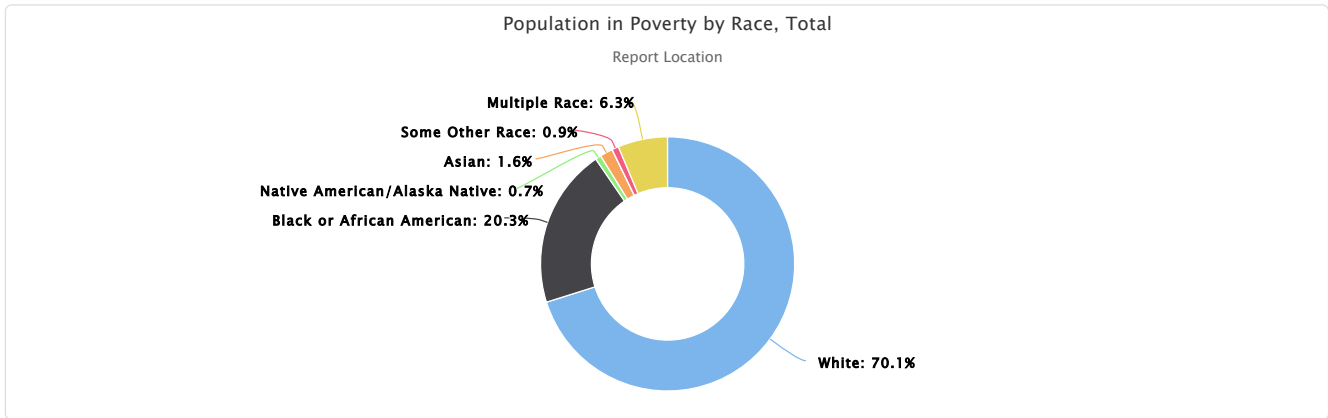

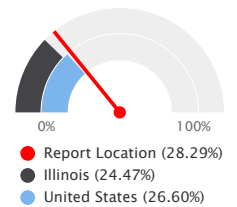

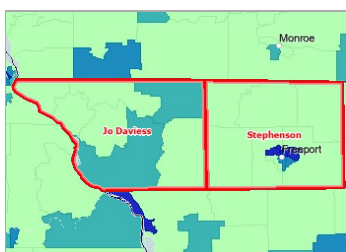

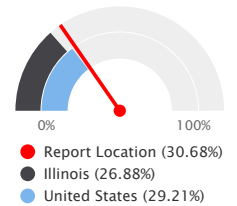

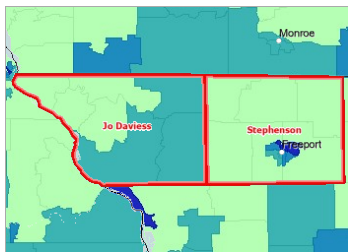

Percent Population with Income at or Below 200% FPL



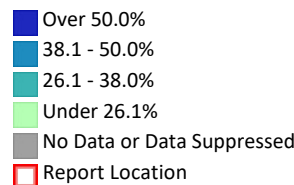

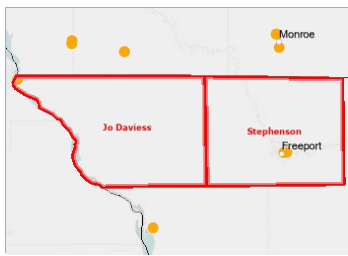

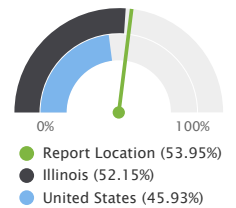

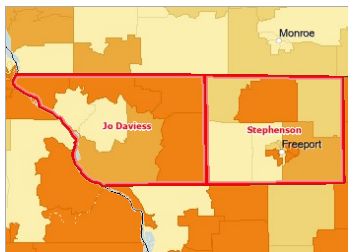

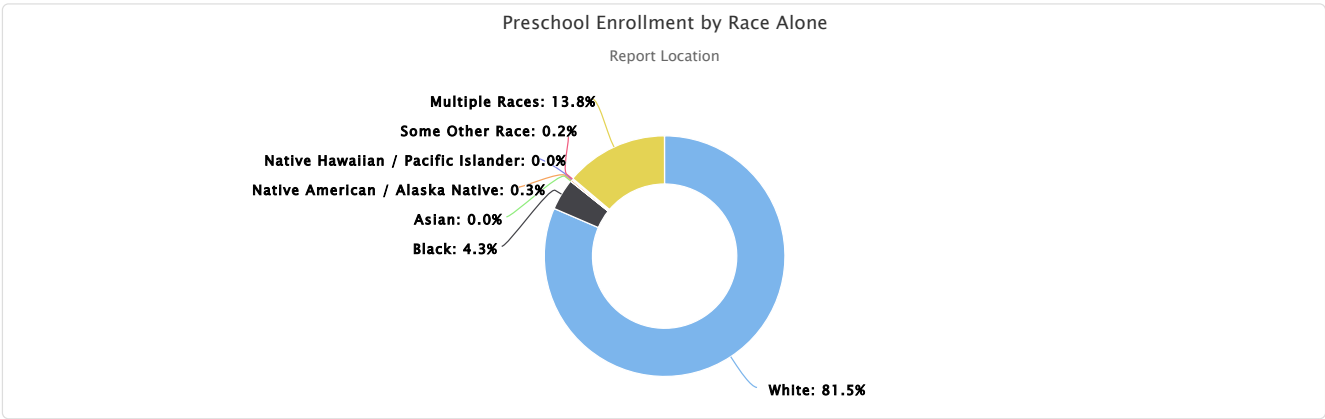

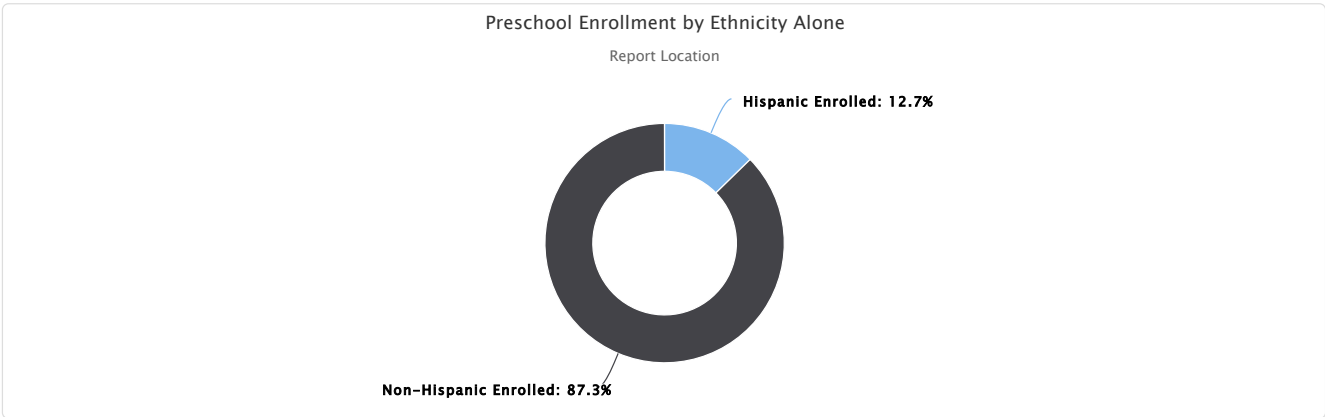

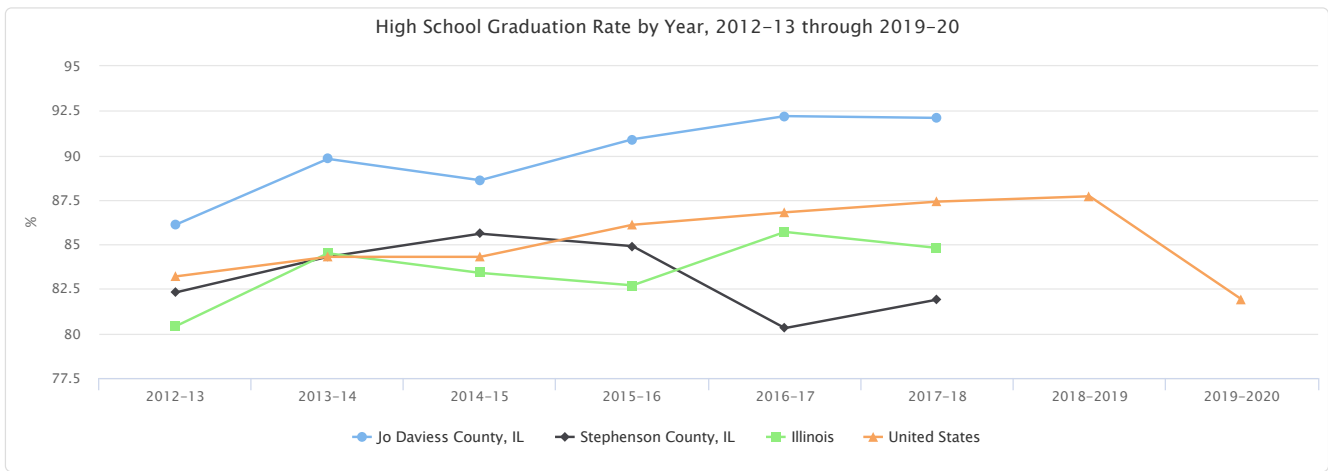

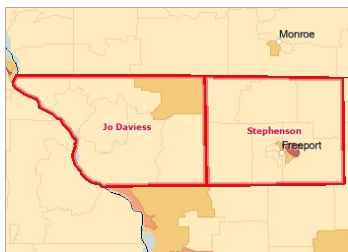

Population Age 25+ with No High School Diploma, Percent

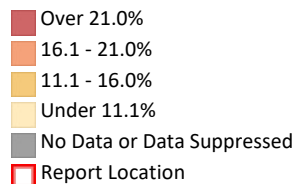

Population with No High School Diploma (Age 25+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

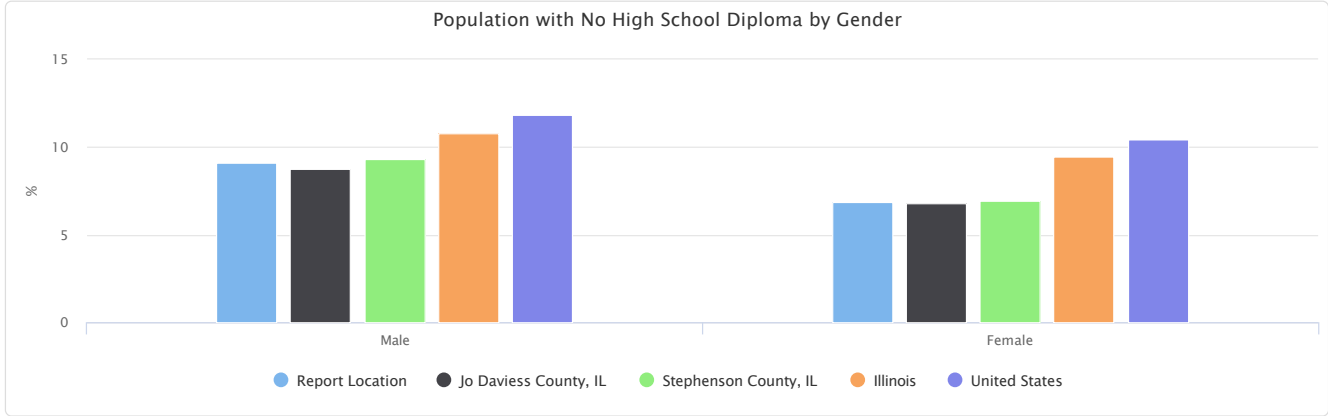

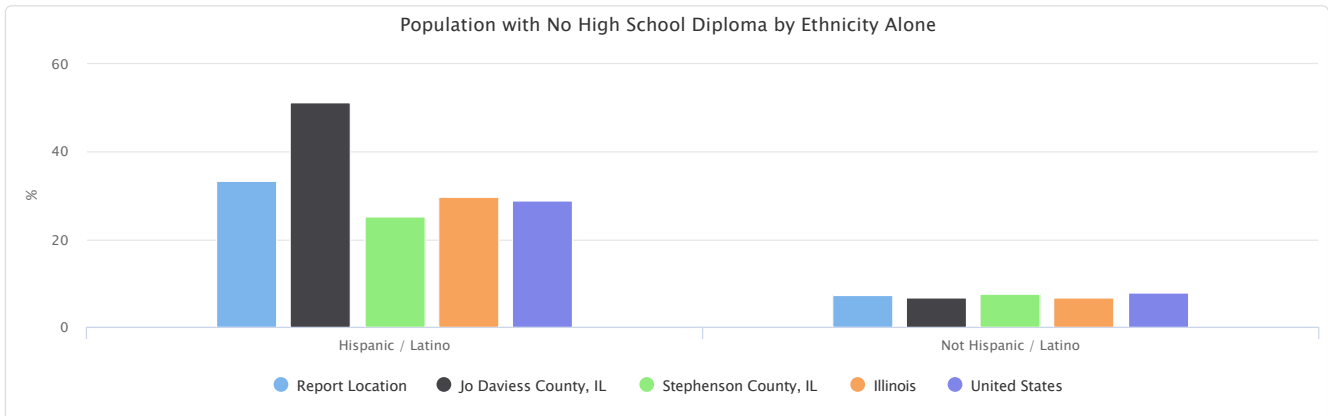

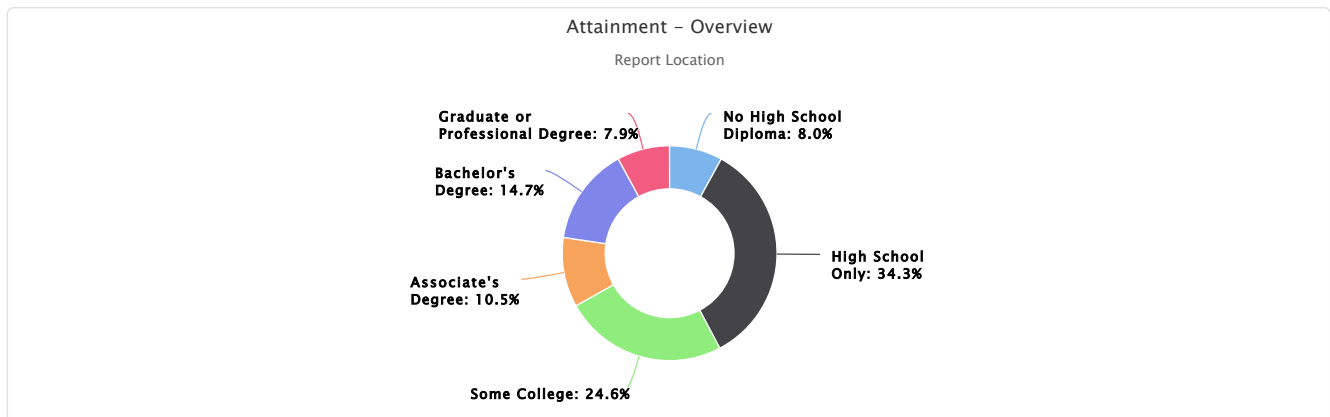

Population with No High School Diploma (Age 25+), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

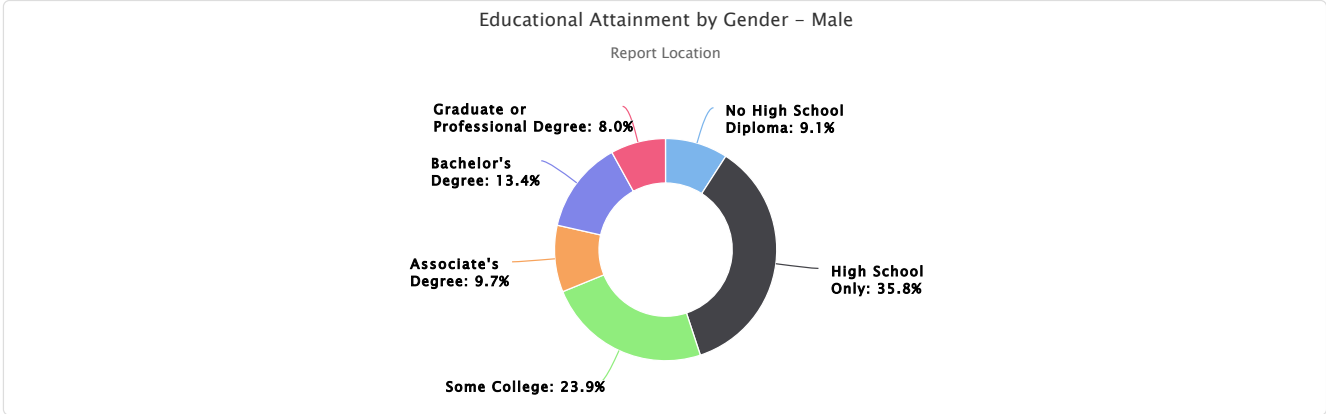

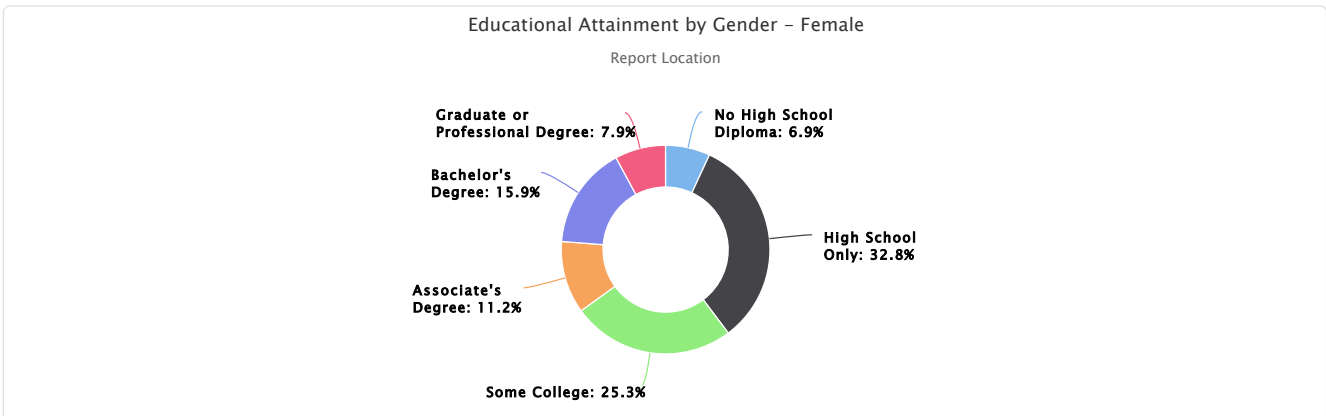

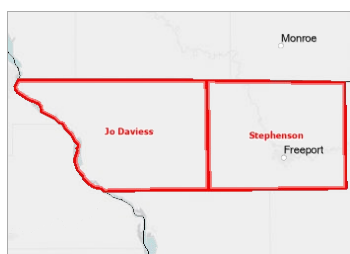

Childcare Centers, Rate per 1,000 population under 5 years old by County, HIFLD 2010-2022

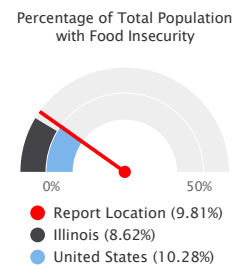

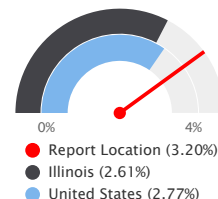

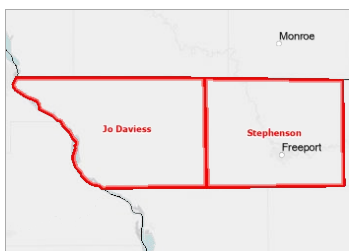

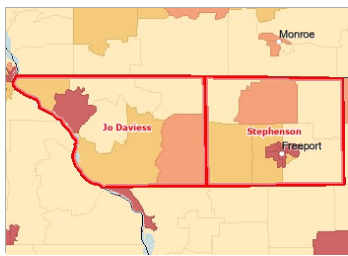

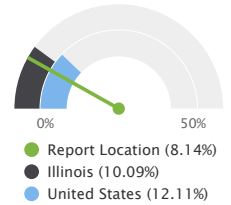

Percent Population Age 18-64 Without Medical Insurance

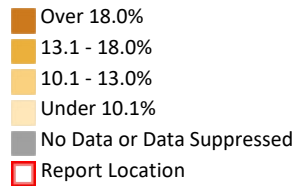

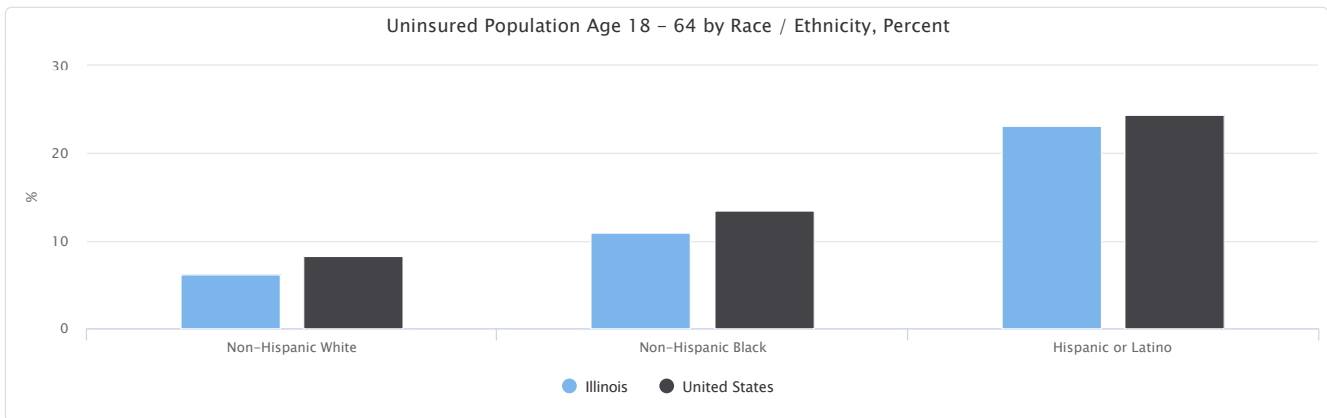

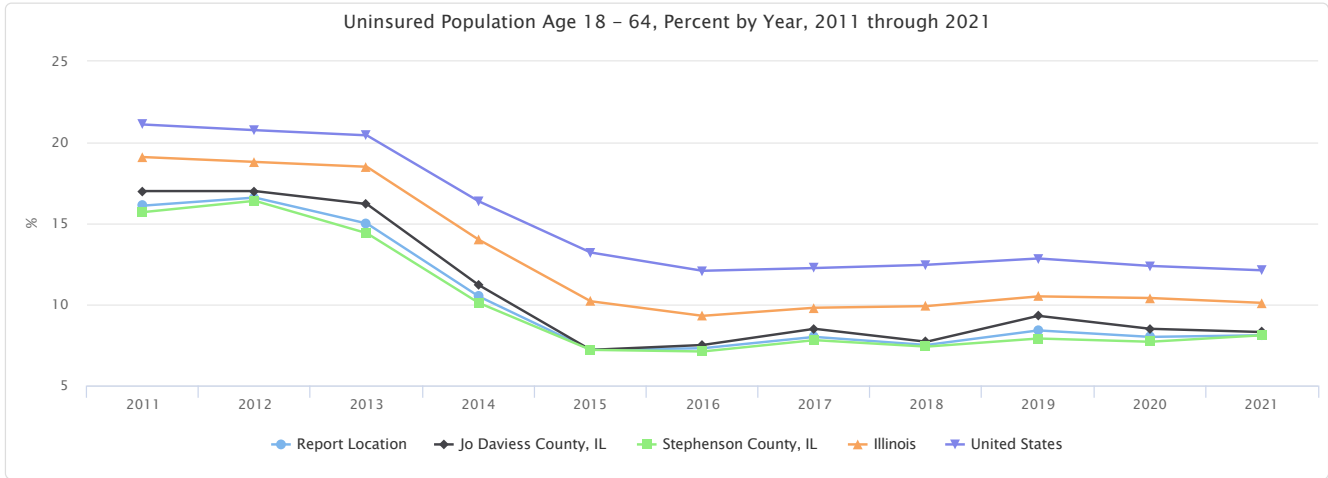

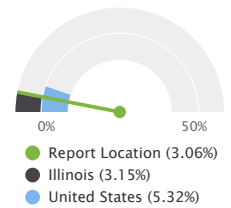

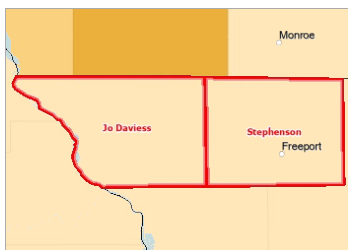

Percent Population Under Age 19 Without Medical Insurance



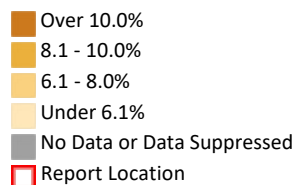

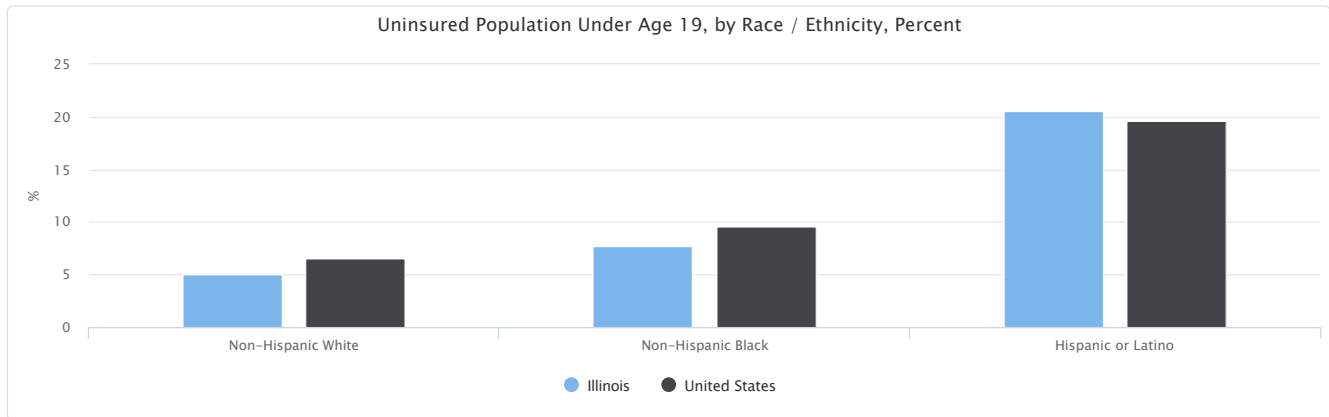

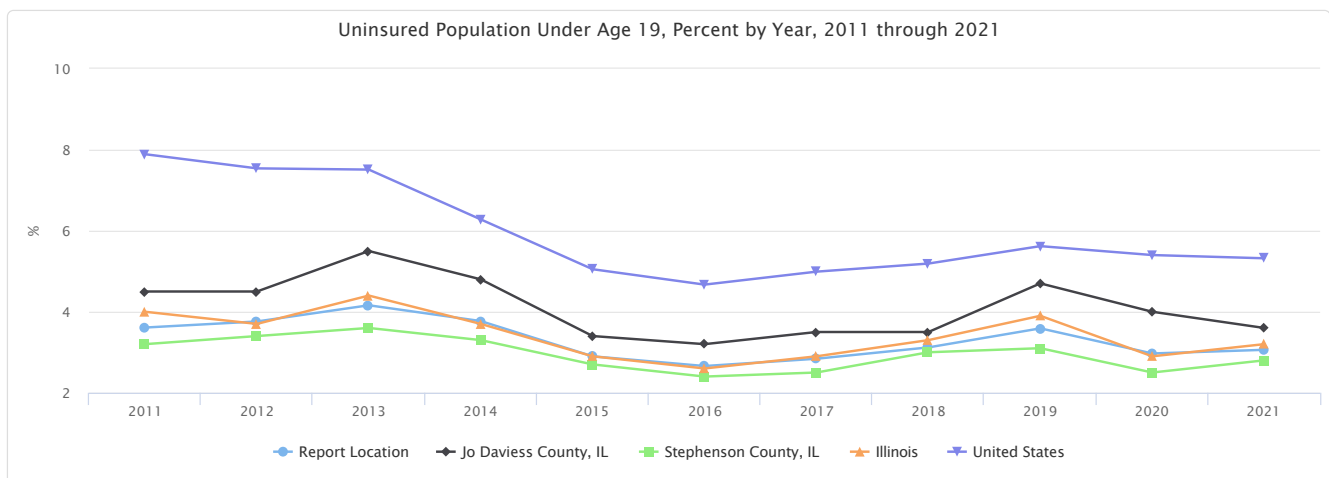

Uninsured Population Under Age 19, Percent by Year, 2011 through 2021

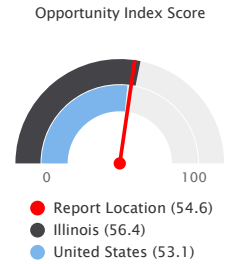

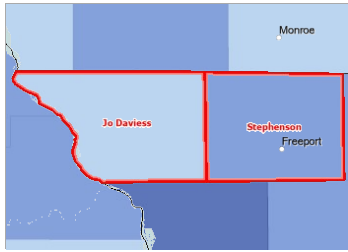

Racial Segregation (Theil Index) by County, US Census Bureau 2020

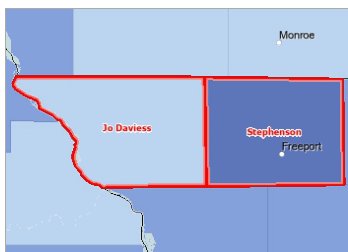

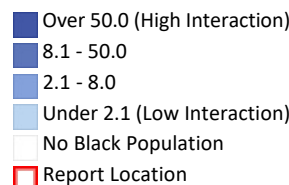

Racial Segregation (Interaction Index), White - Black by County, US Census Bureau 2010

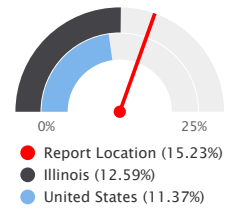

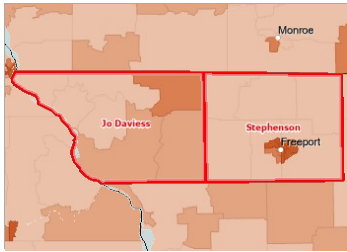

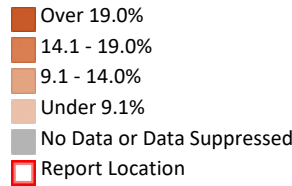

Households Receiving SNAP Benefits, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

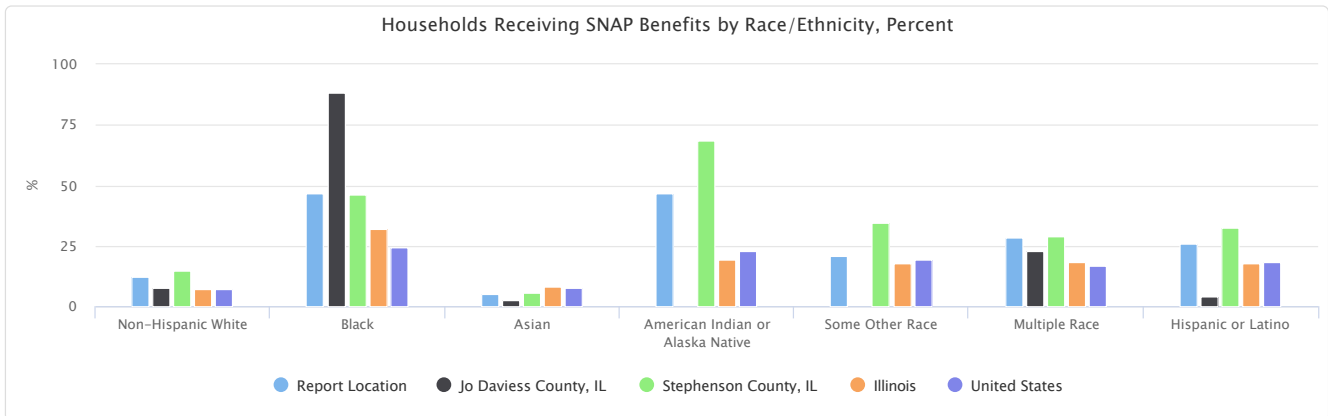

Women that Gave Birth, Age 15-19, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

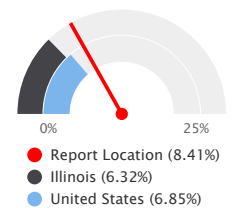

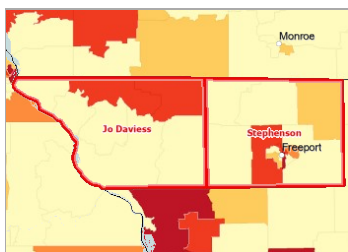

Population Age 16-19 Not in School and Not Employed, Percent

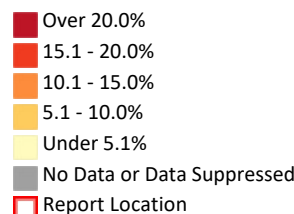

Youths Not Enrolled in School and Not Employed, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21



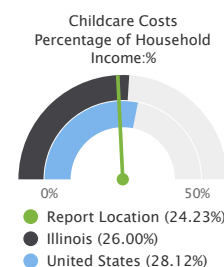

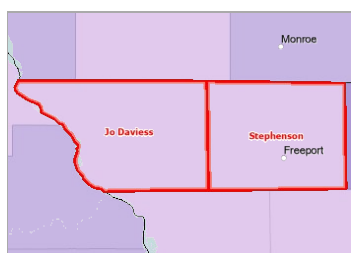

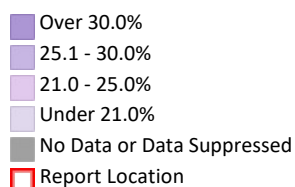

Childcare Cost Burden, Percent of Median Household Income by County, US Census LWC 2021-2022



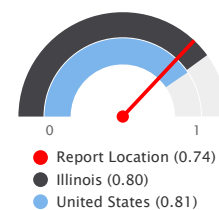

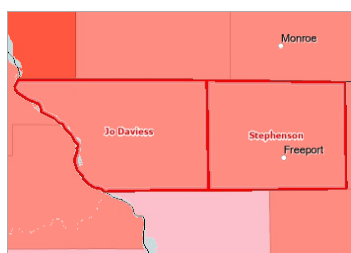

Ratio of Female vs. Male Median Earnings

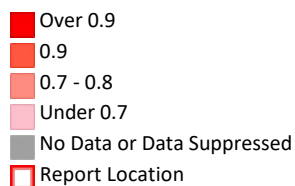

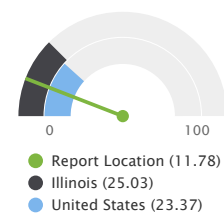
The FEMA National Risk Index provides a holistic view of community-level risk nationwide by combining multiple hazards with socioeconomic and built environment factors. It calculates a baseline relative risk measurement for each United States county and census tract for 18 natural hazard types as a composite score from the summation of all 18 hazard types (as shown in the main table) as well as individual scores for each hazard type (as shown in the breakout tables).

This indicator displays the composite FEMA National Risk Index score and the scores of the three components - Expected Annual Loss, Social Vulnerability, and Community Resilience. All the scores are constrained into a scale ranging from 0 (lowest risk) to 100 (highest risk) describing a community's relative position among all other communities. 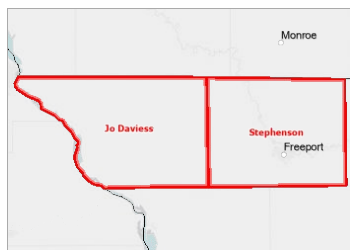

National Risk Index Score



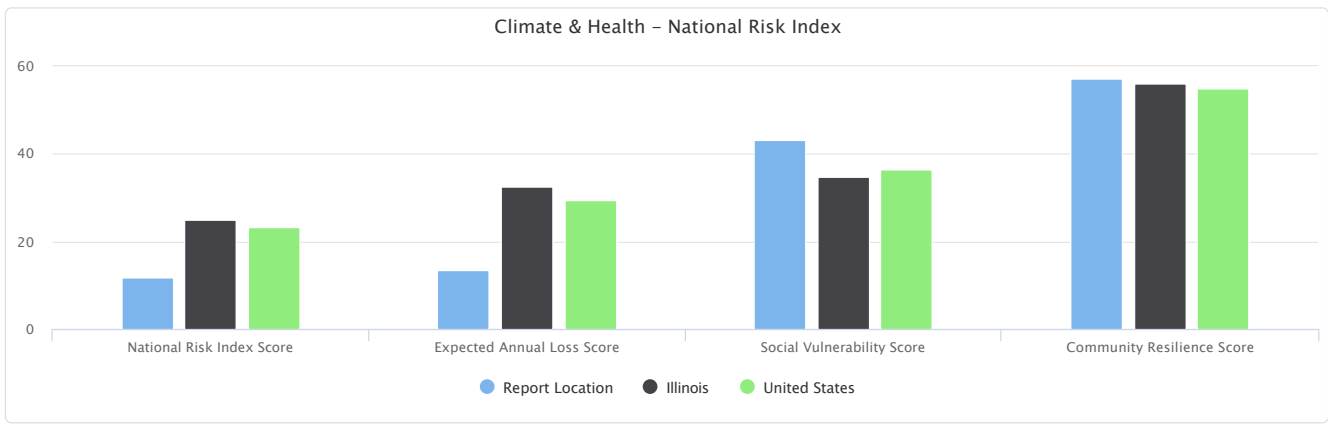

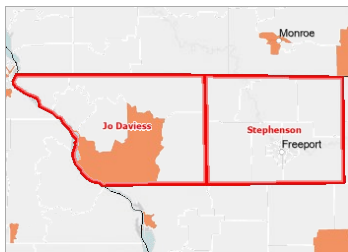

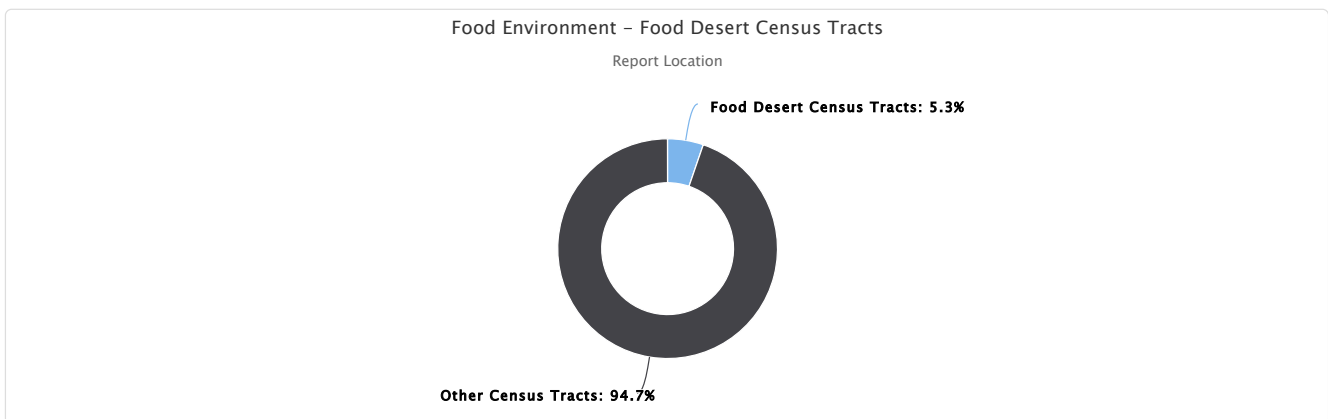

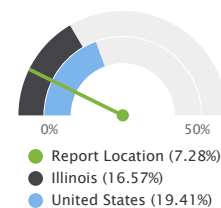

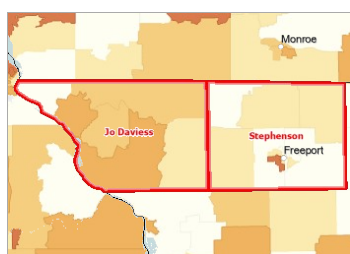

Percent Low Income Population with Low Food Access



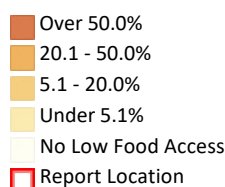

Population with Limited Food Access, Low Income, Percent by Tract, USDA - FARA 2019

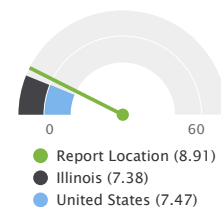

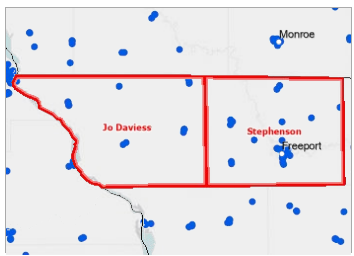

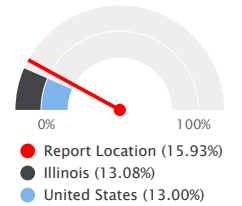

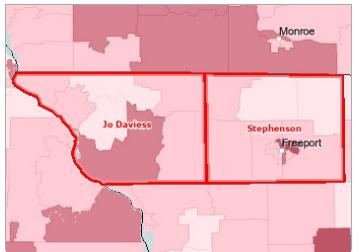

Households with No or Slow Internet, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

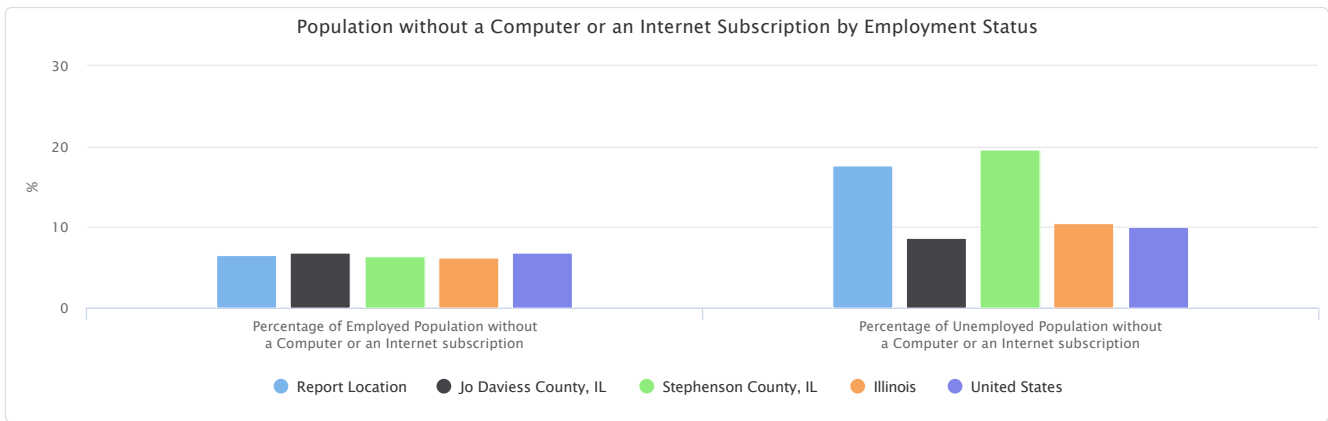

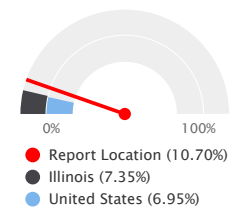

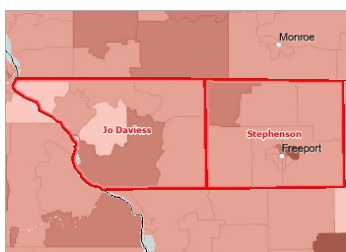

Percentage of Households with No Computer



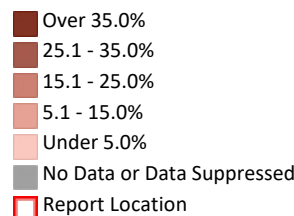

Households with No Computer, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

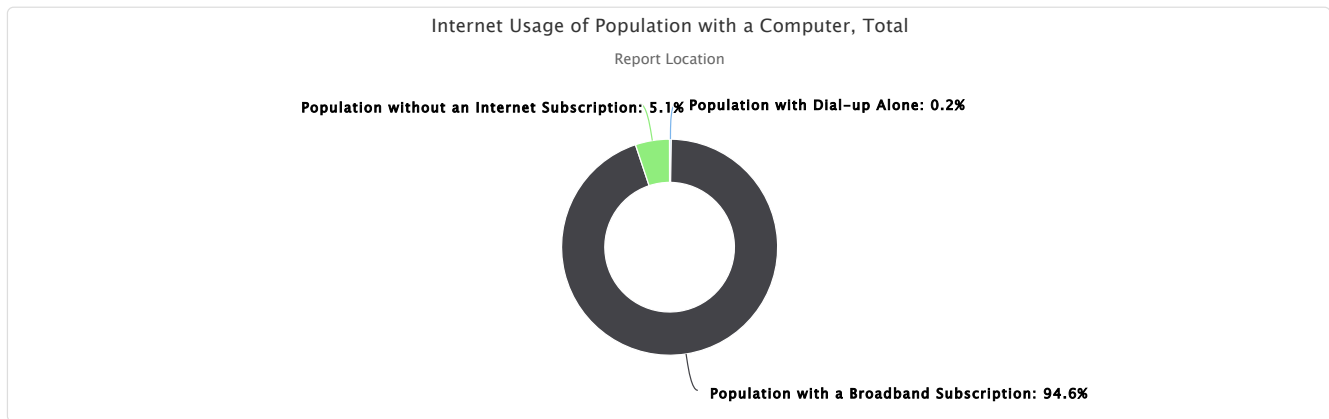

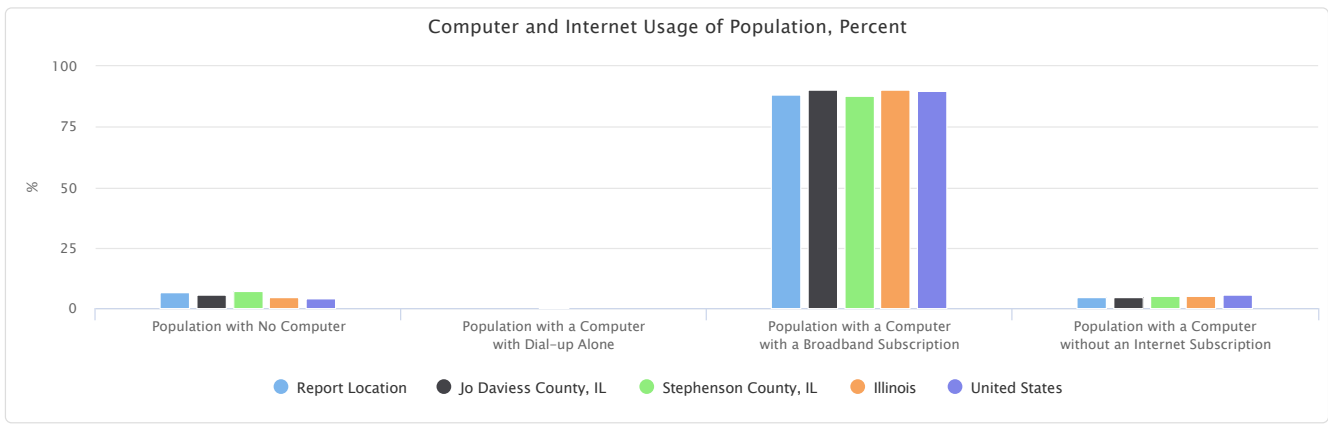

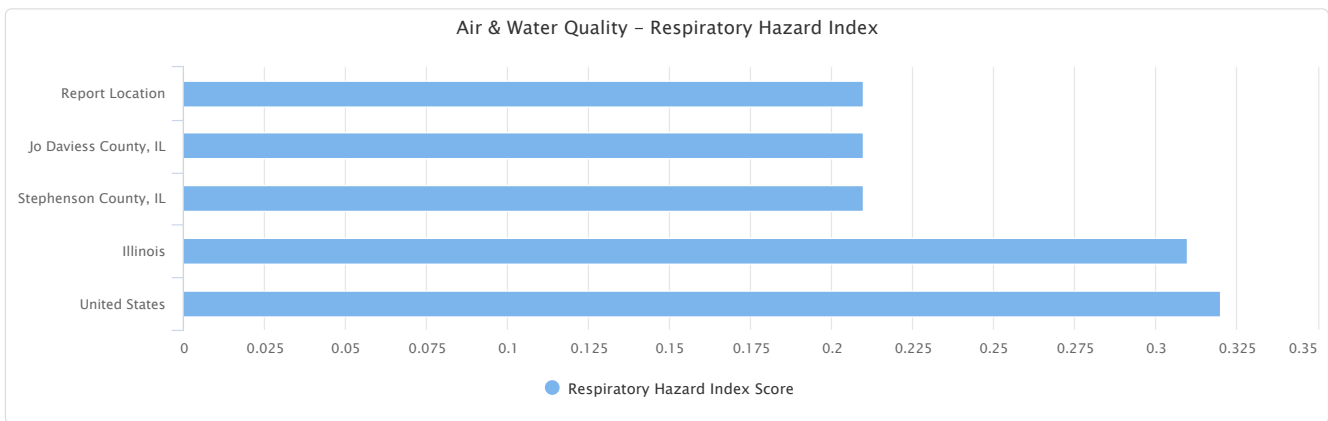

Single Parent Households with Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21



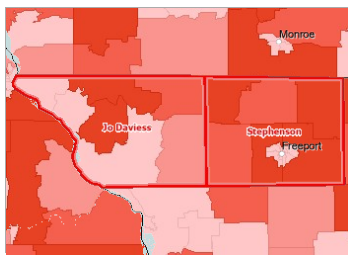

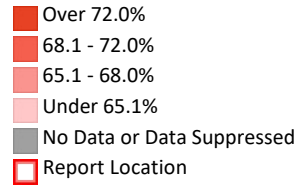

Family Households, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

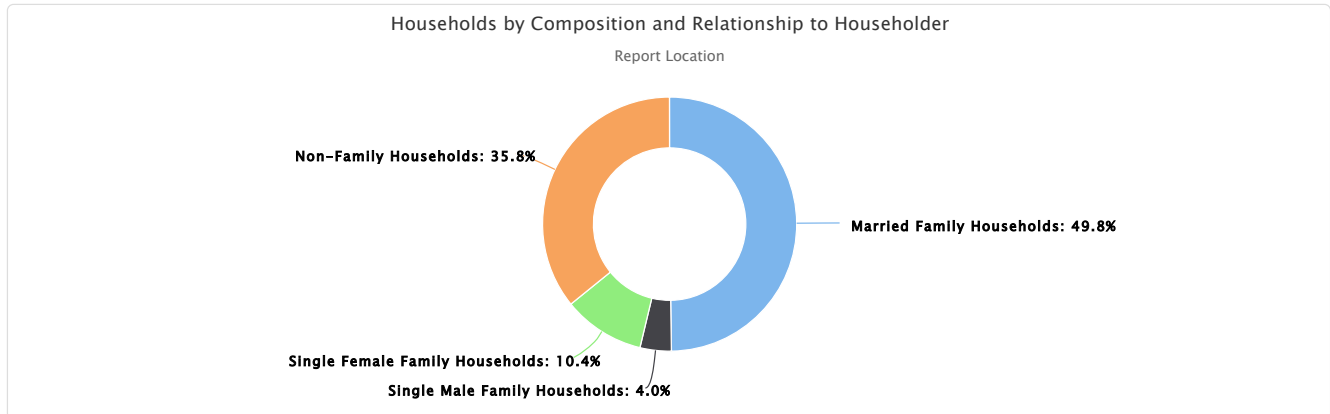

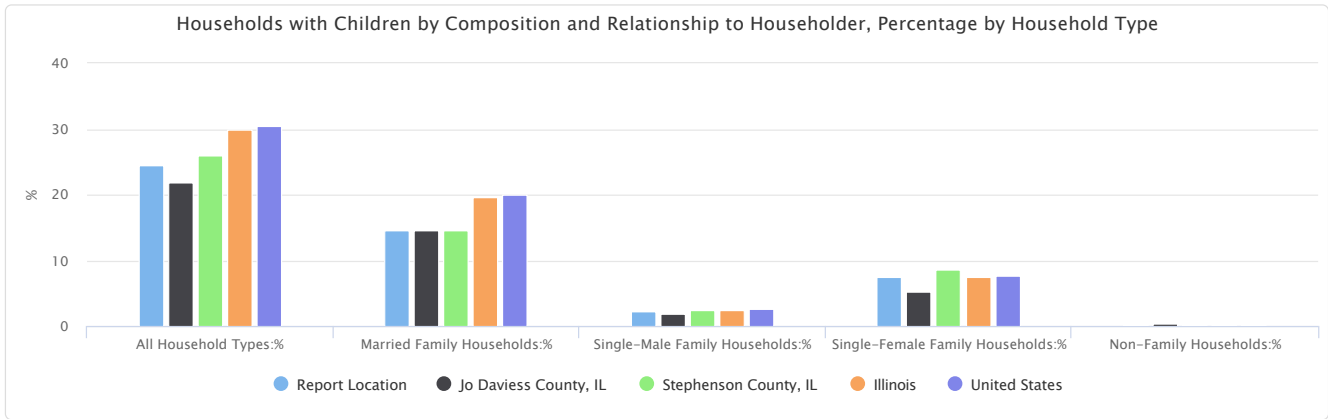

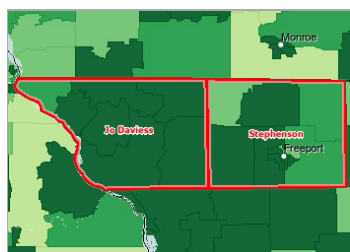

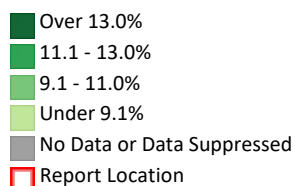

Households with Seniors (Age 65+) Living Alone, Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

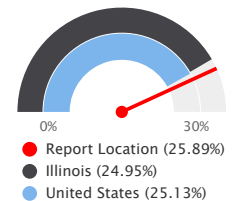

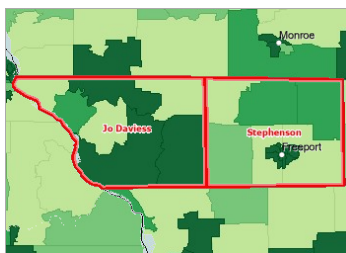

Percentage of children that live in a household headed by single parent

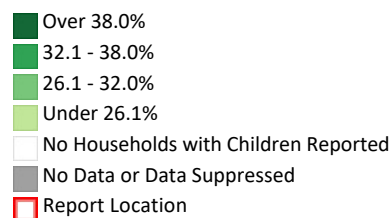

Single Parent Households with Children (Age 0-17), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

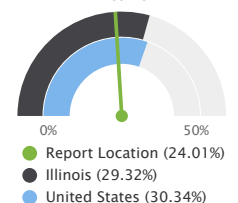

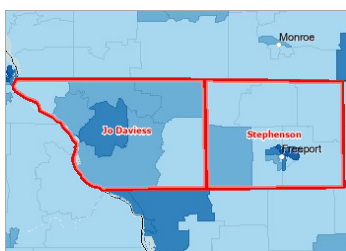

Percentage of Households where Housing Costs Exceed 30% of Income

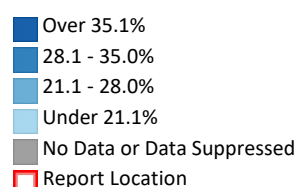

Cost Burdened Households (Housing Costs Exceed 30% of Household Income), Percent by Tract, ACS 2017-21

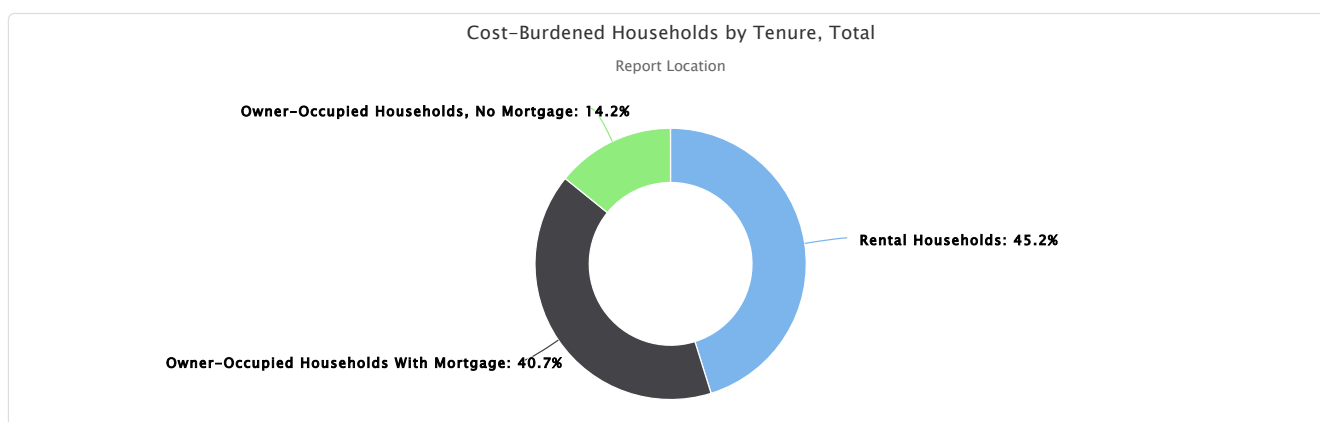

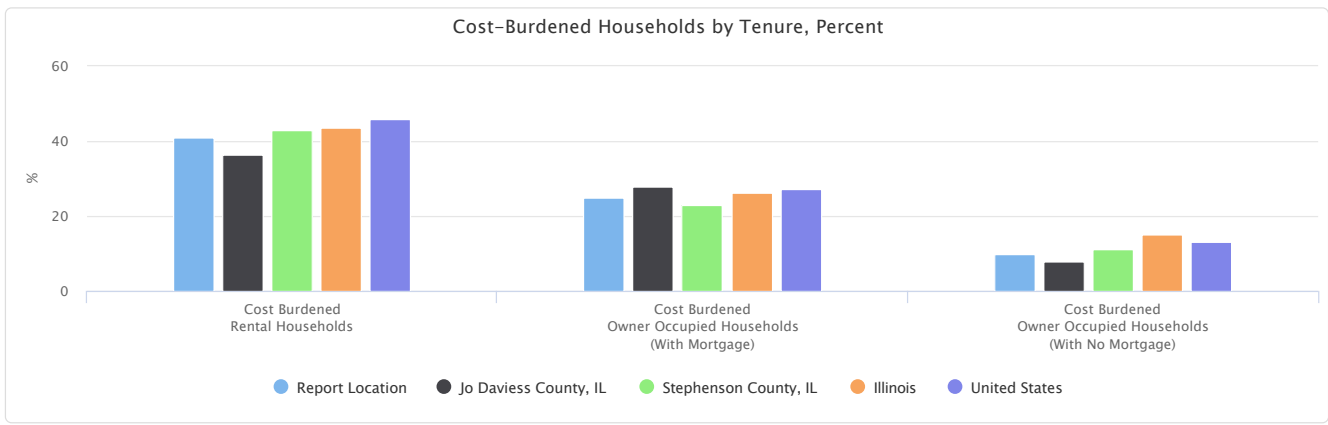

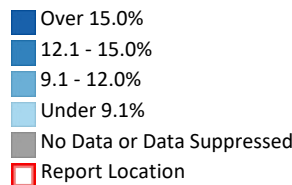

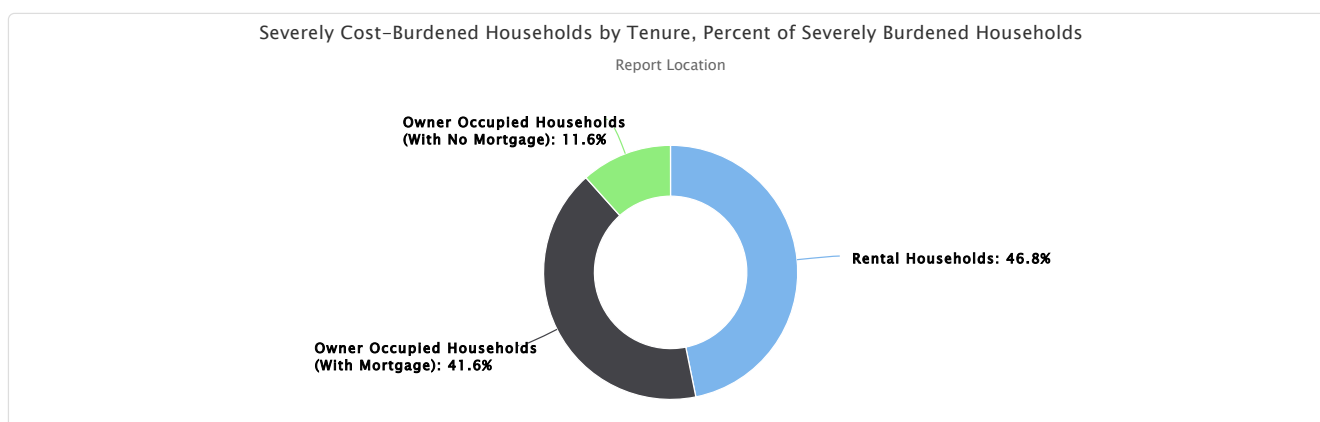

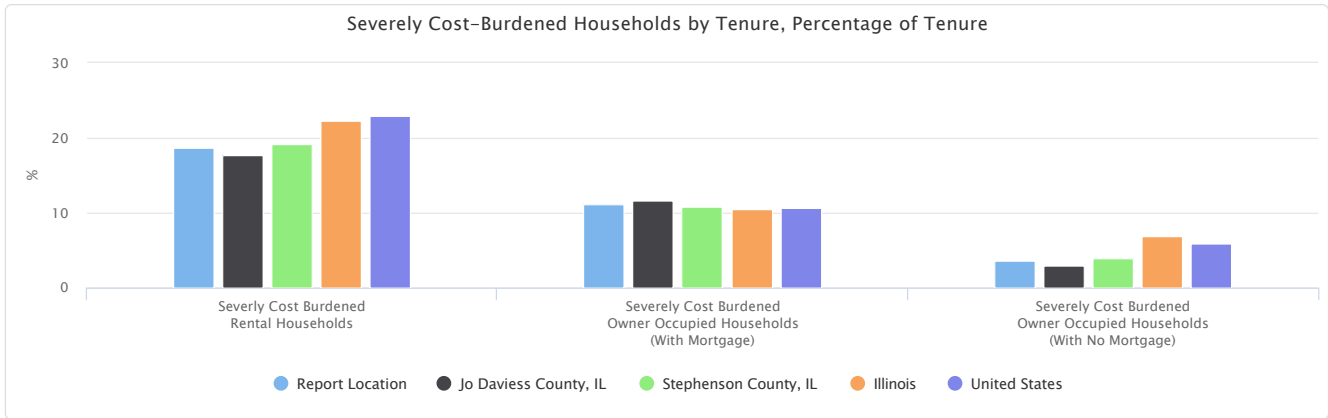

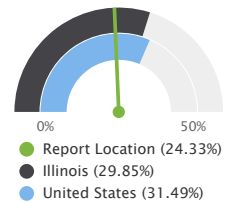

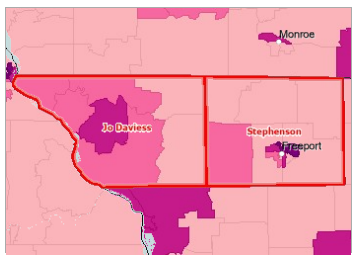

Occupied Housing Units with One or More Substandard Conditions, Percent



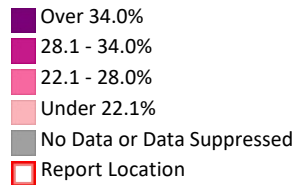

Substandard Housing Units, Percent of Total by Tract, ACS 2017-21

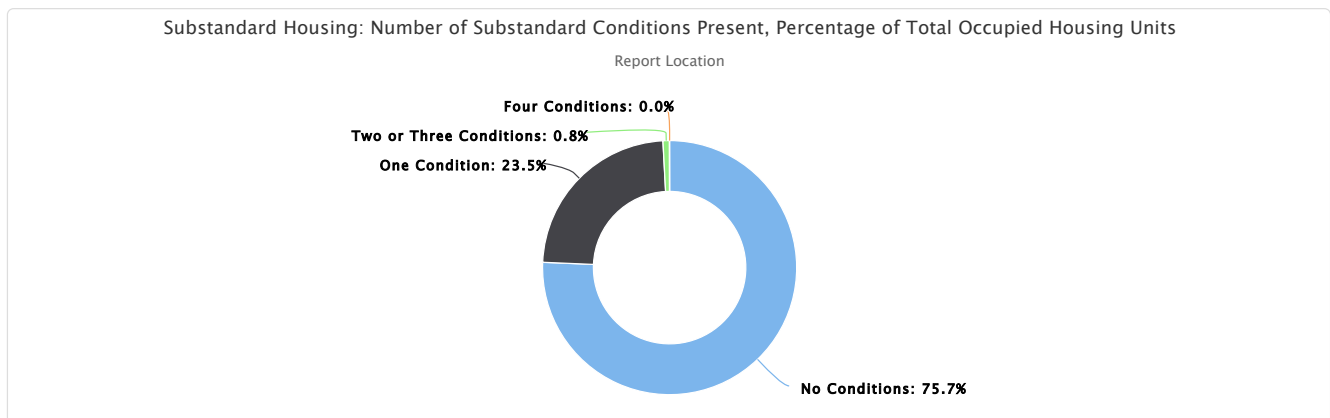

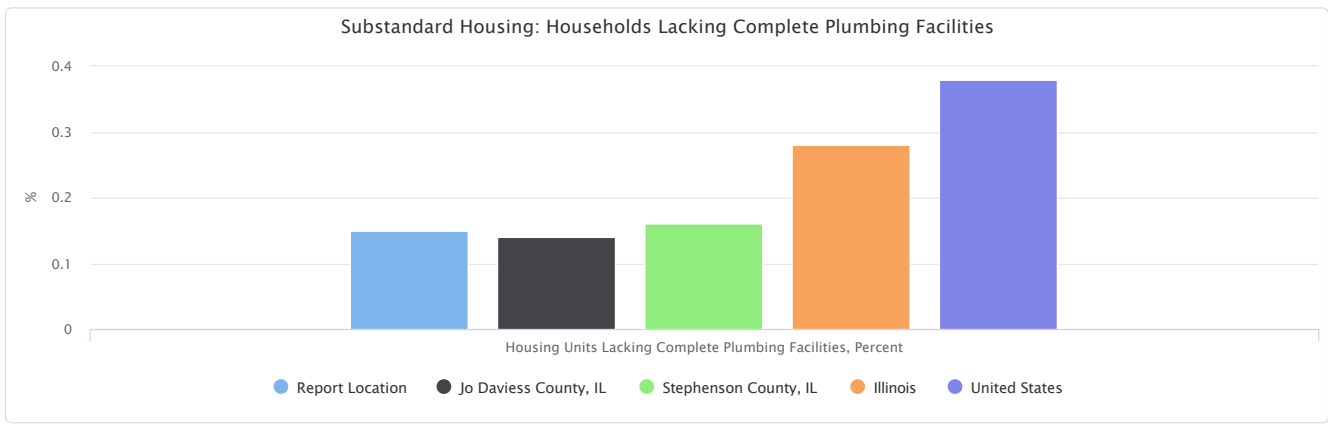

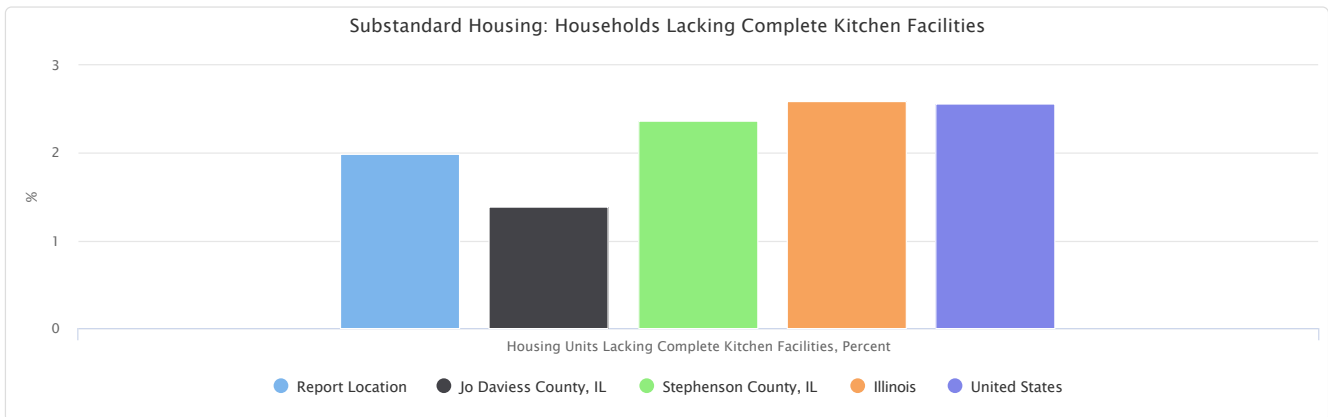

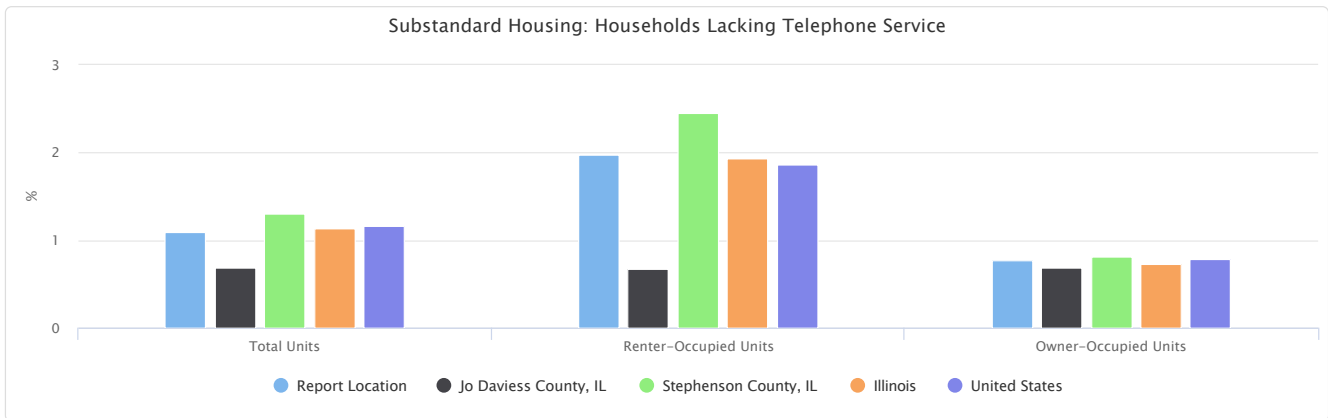

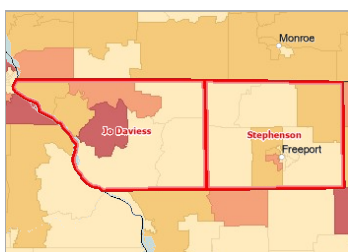

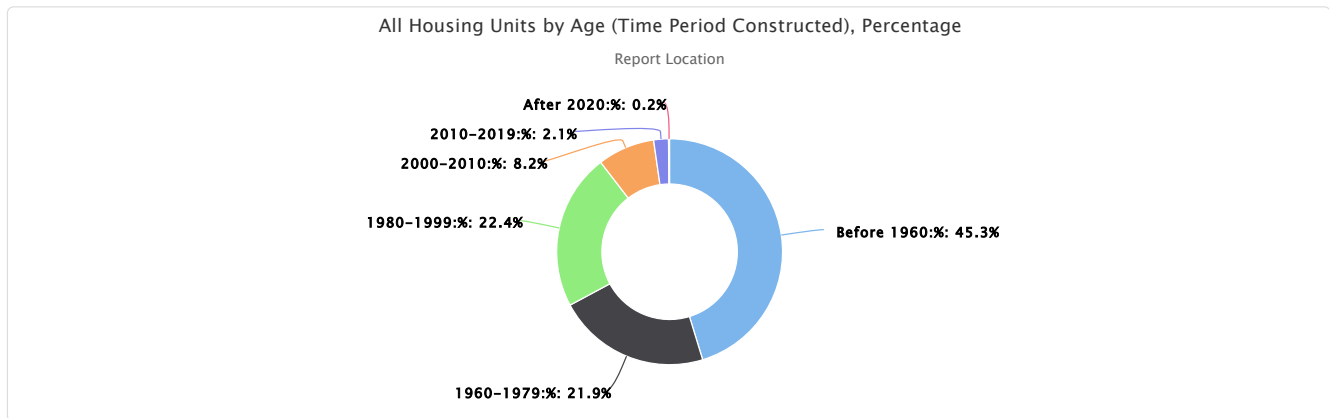

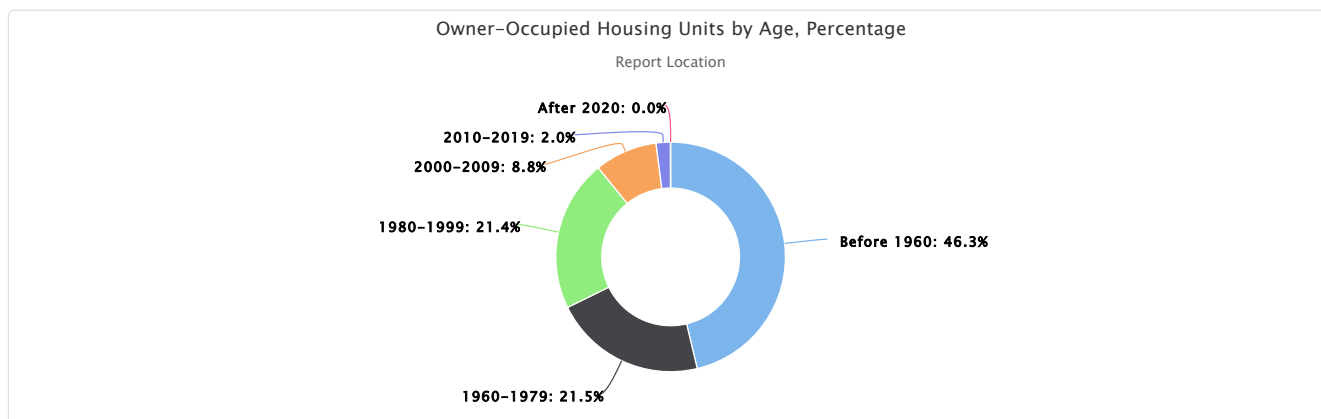

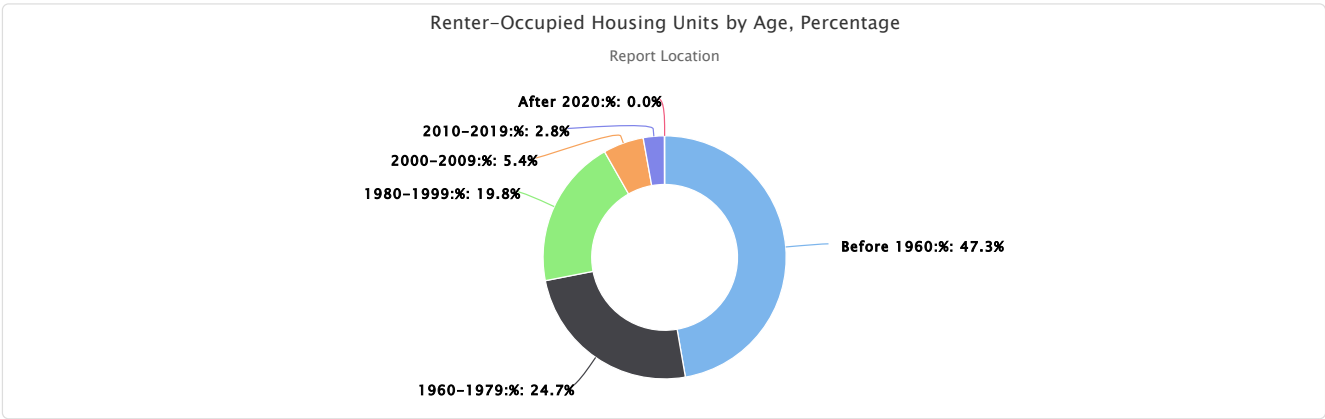

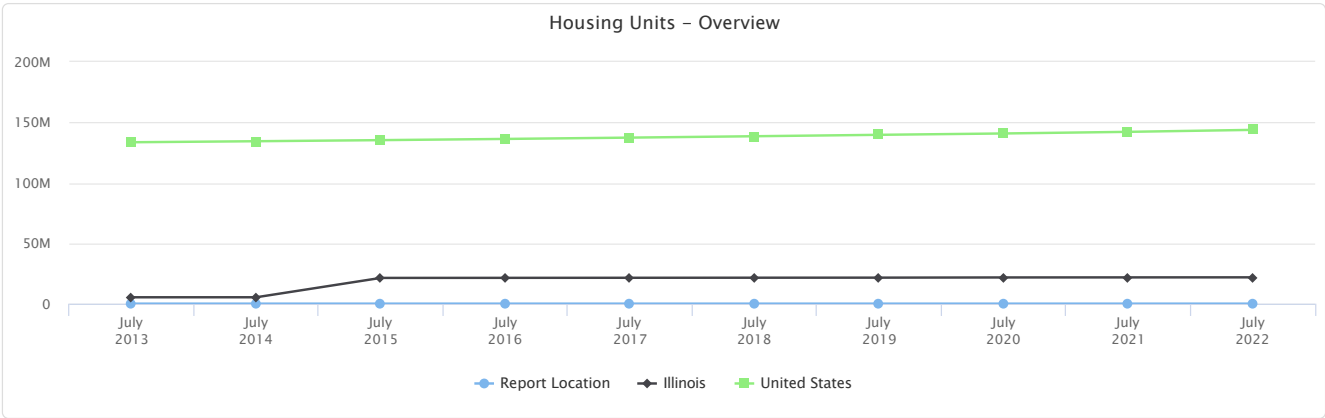

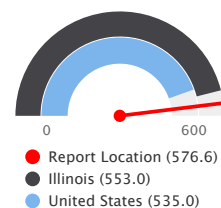

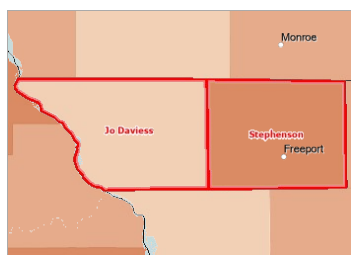

Emergency Room (ER) Visits, Rate per 1,000 Medicare Beneficiaries

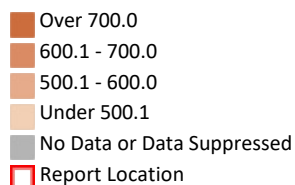

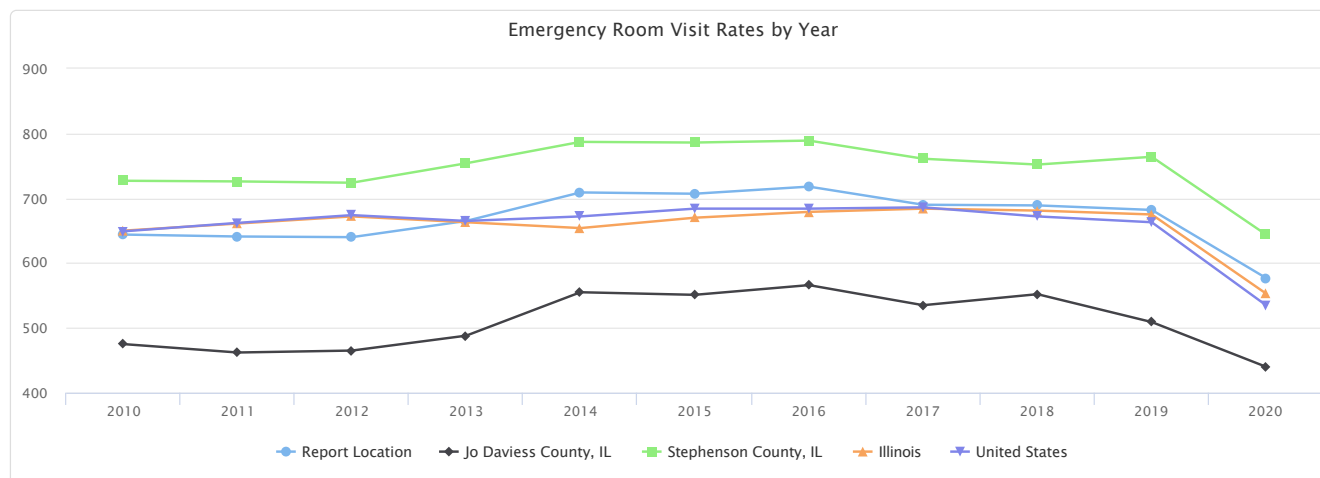
Emergency Room Visits, ER Visits, Rate per 1,000 Beneficiaries by County, CMS 2020

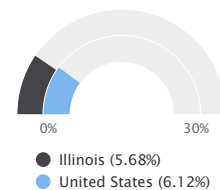

Percentage of Pregnant Women with Late or No Prenatal Care



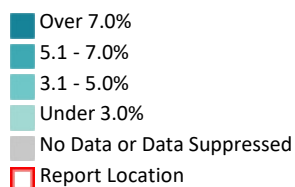

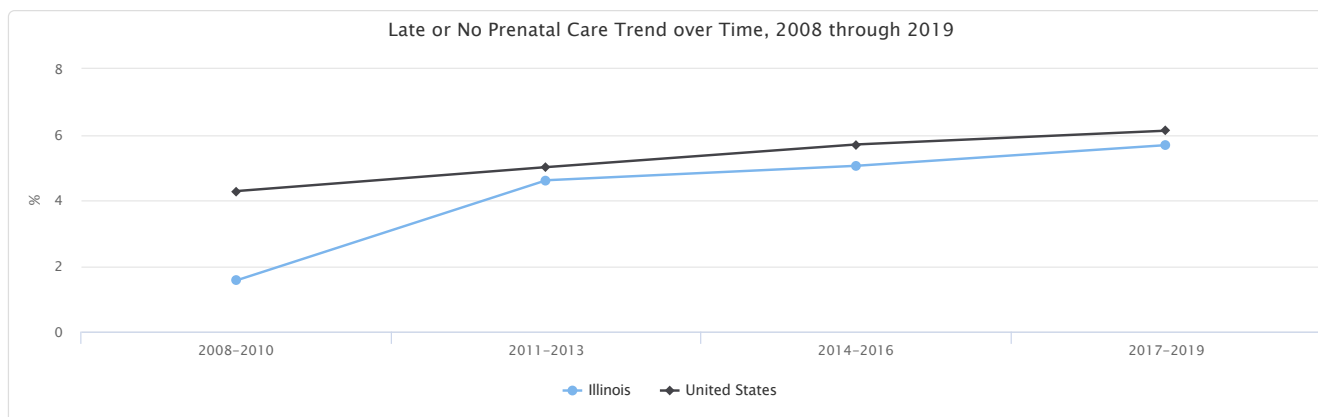
Mothers with Late or No Prenatal Care, Percent by County, CDC NVSS 2017-19

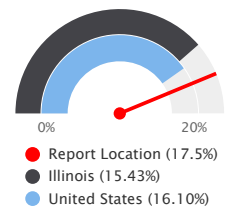

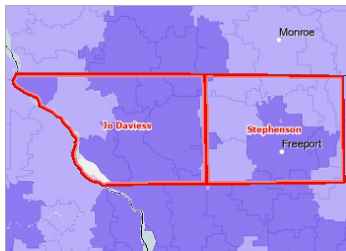

Percentage of Adults Age 18+ with Poor or Fair General Health

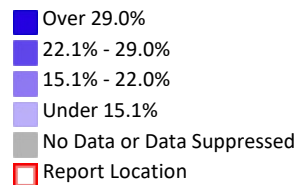

Poor or Fair Health, Prevalence Among Adults Age 18+ by ZCTA, CDC BRFSS PLACES Project 2021



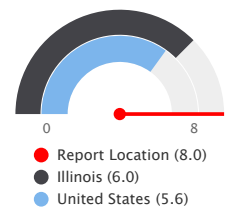

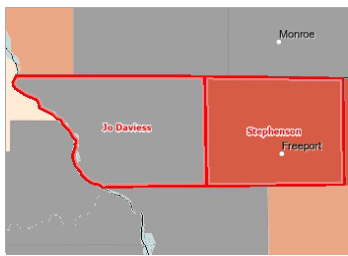

Infant Mortality Rate per 1,000 Births

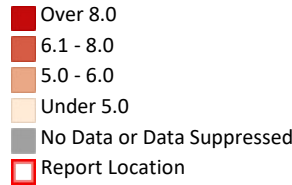

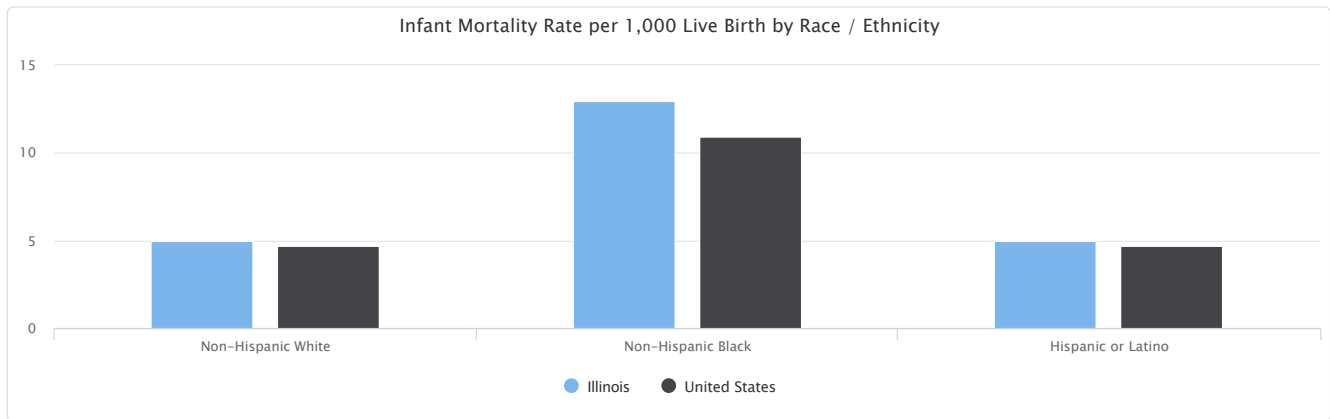
Infant Mortality, Rate per 1,000 Births by County, CDC NVSS 2014-2020

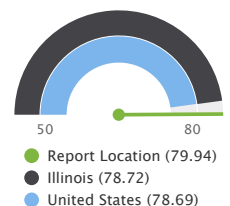

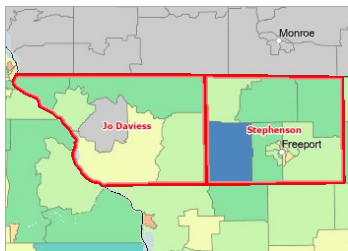

Life Expectancy at Birth, 2010-2015



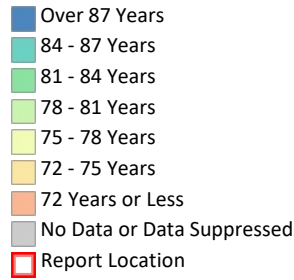

Life Expectancy At Birth, Years by Tract, CDC NCHS 2010-15



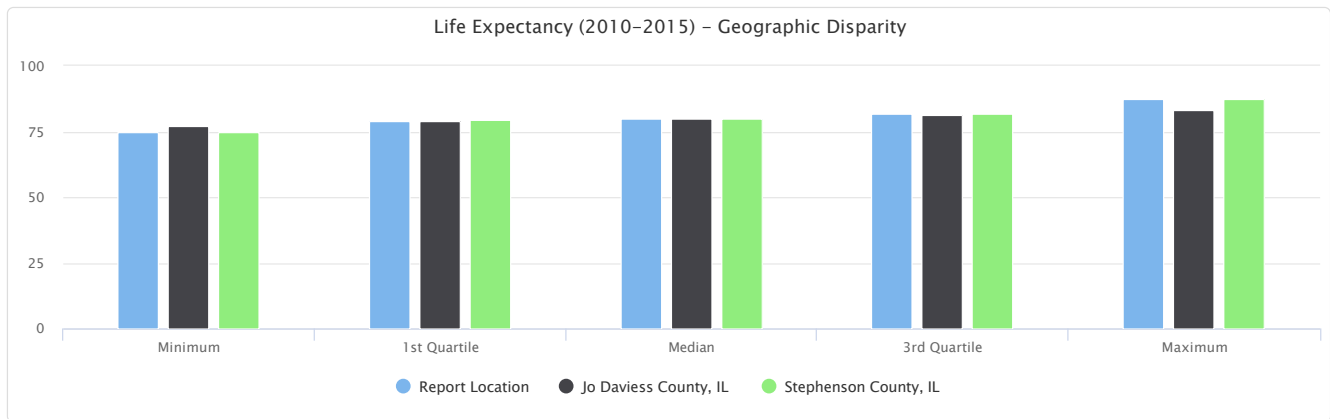

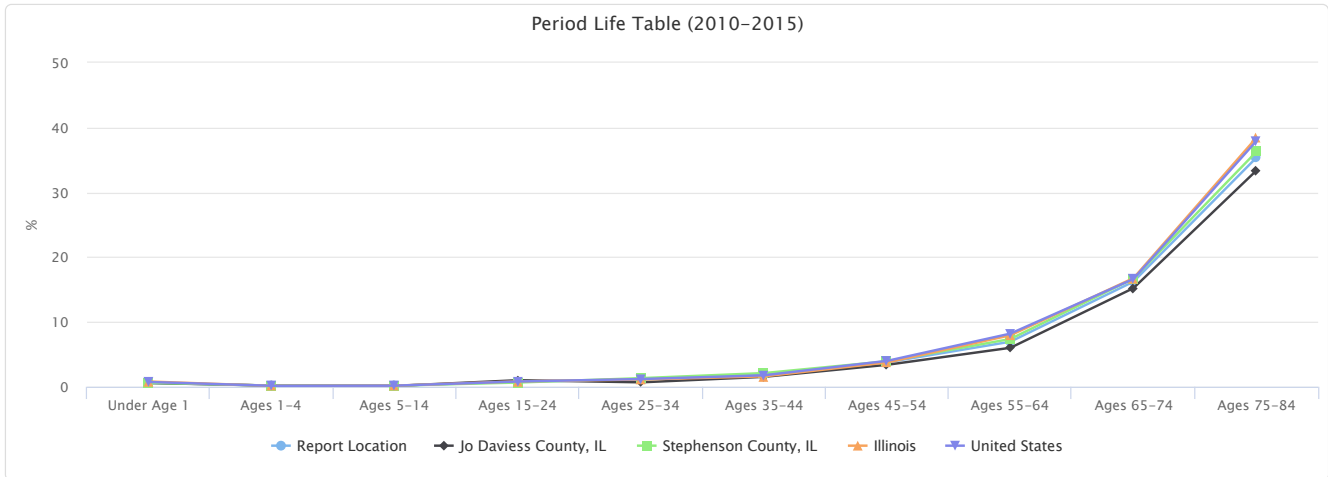

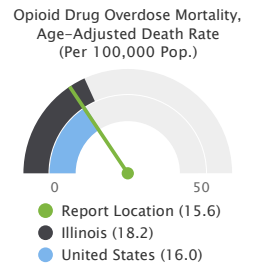

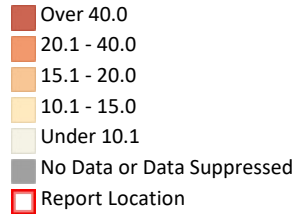

Opioid Overdose Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20

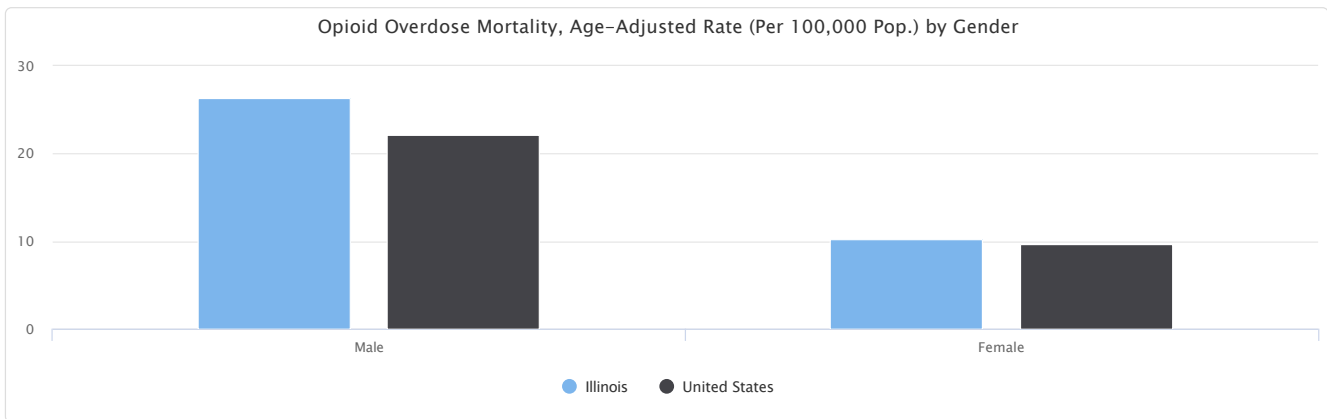

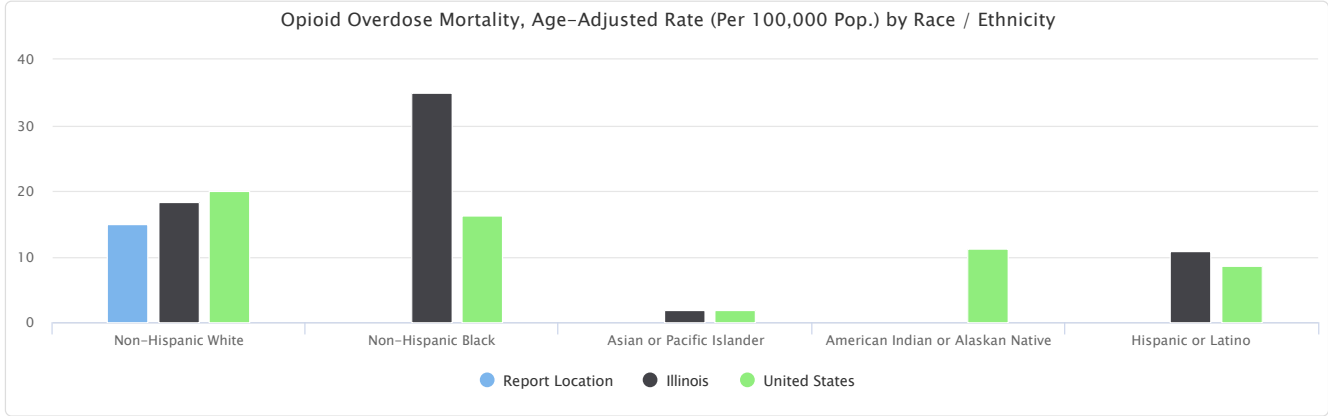

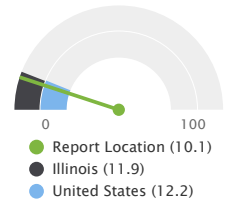

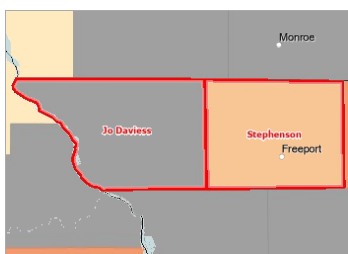

Firearm Mortality, Age-Adjusted Death Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.)



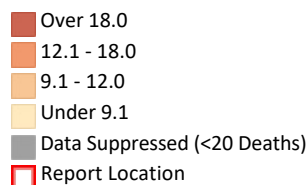

Firearm-related Injury Mortality, Age Adj. Rate (Per 100,000 Pop.) by County, CDC NVSS 2016-20

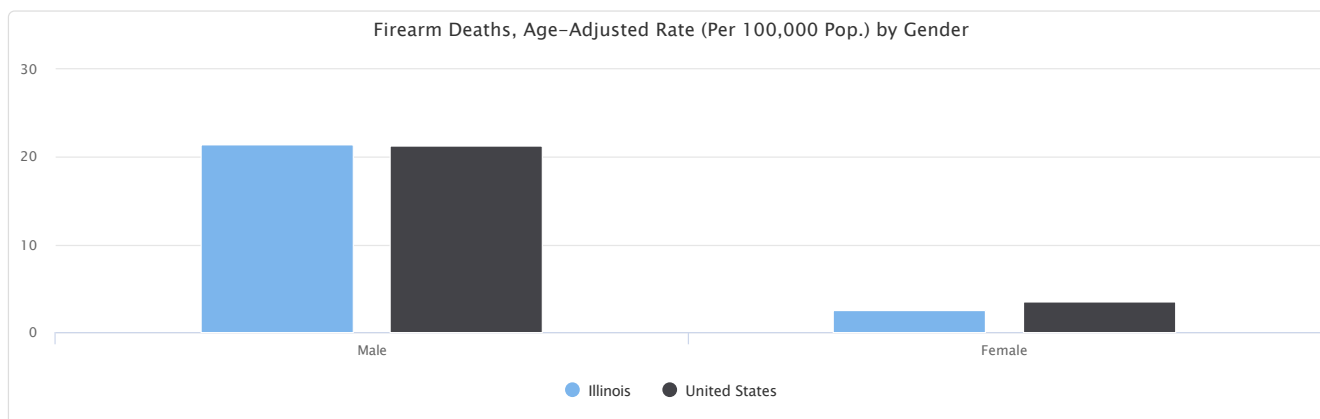

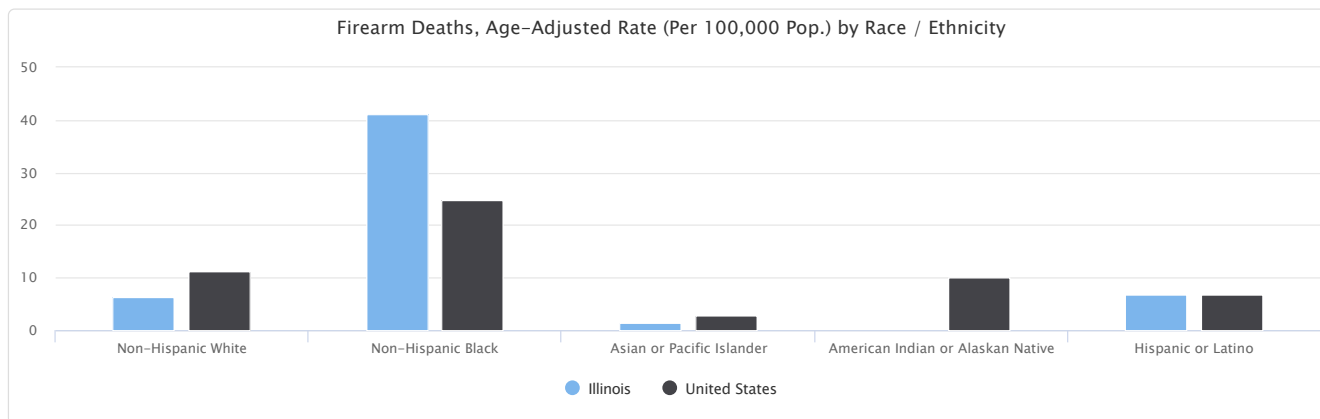

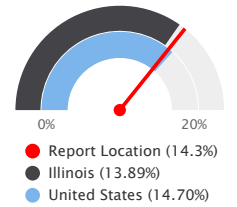

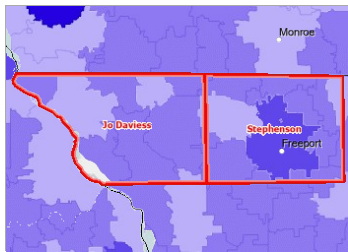

Percentage of Adults Age 18+ with Poor Mental Health

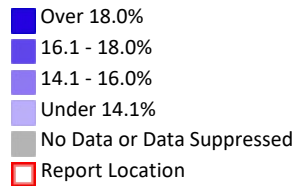

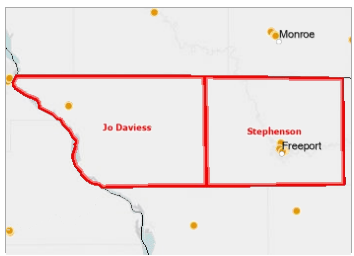

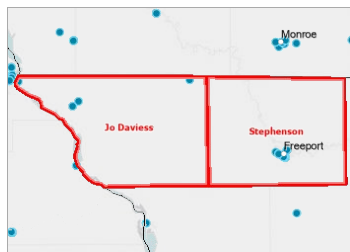

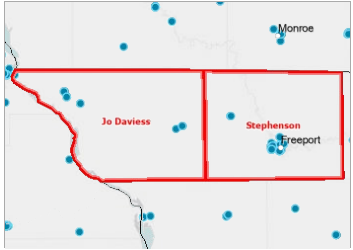

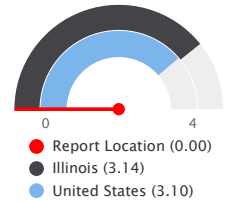

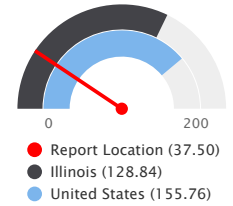

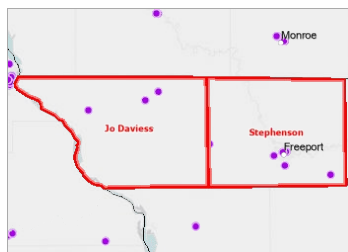

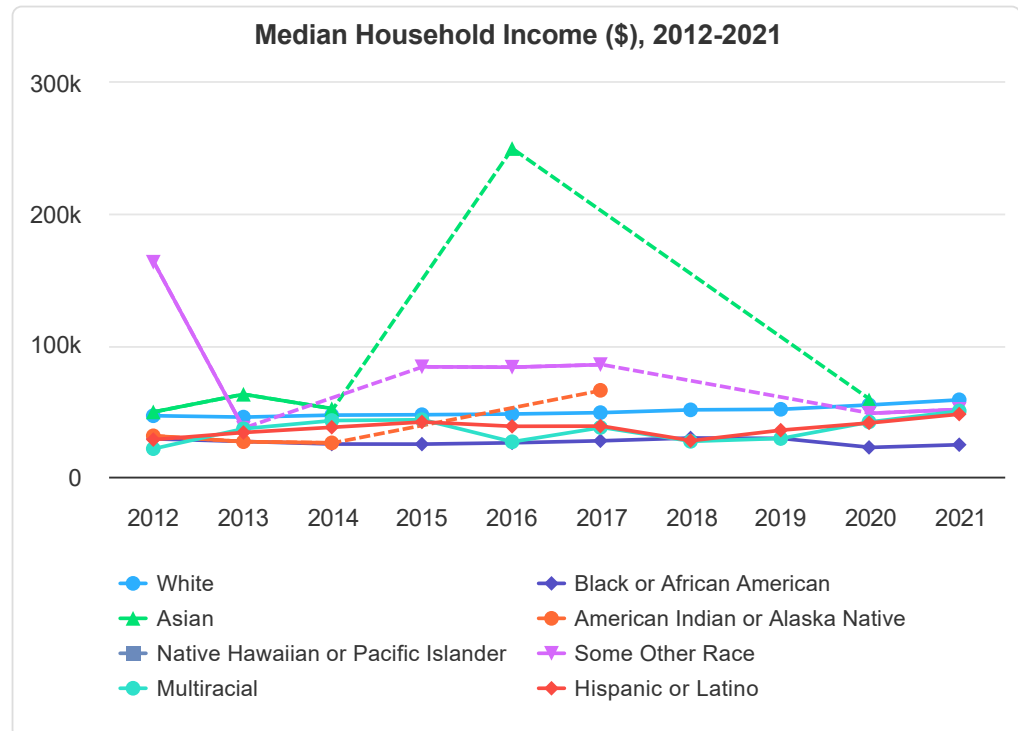
